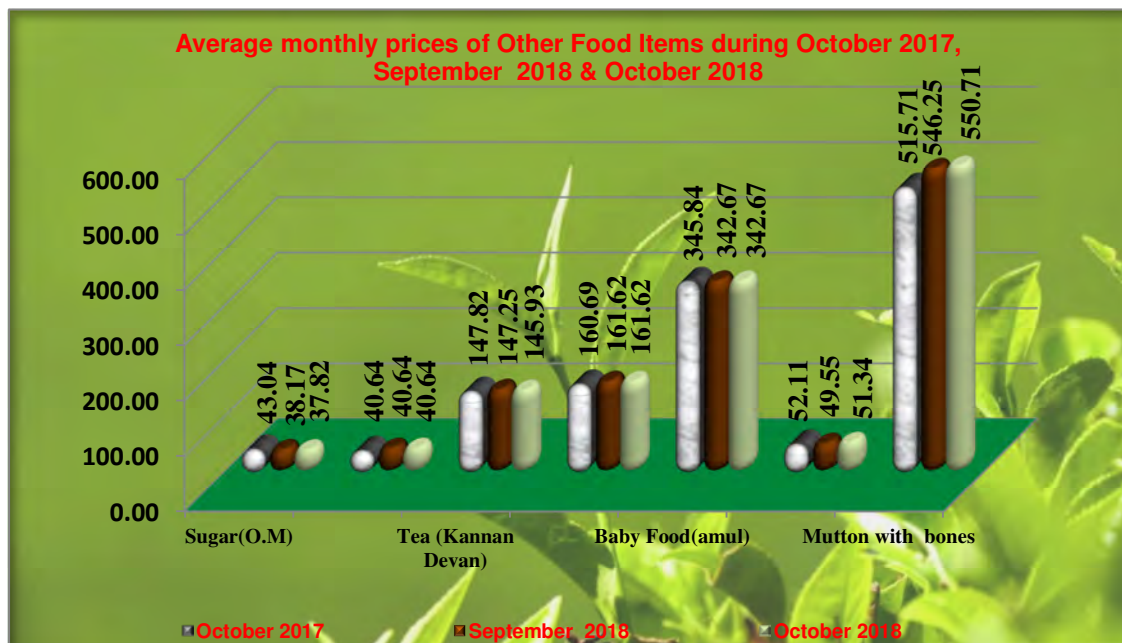

PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance in the context of a growing economy. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and Civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary,, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumerfed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

OCTOBER 2018

INTRODUCTION

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of October 2018. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last month as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of October of the previous year 2017, previous month September 2018 and current month of October 2018 are attached and the percentage of variation over the previous month and the current month of the previous year are attached. Groupwise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice

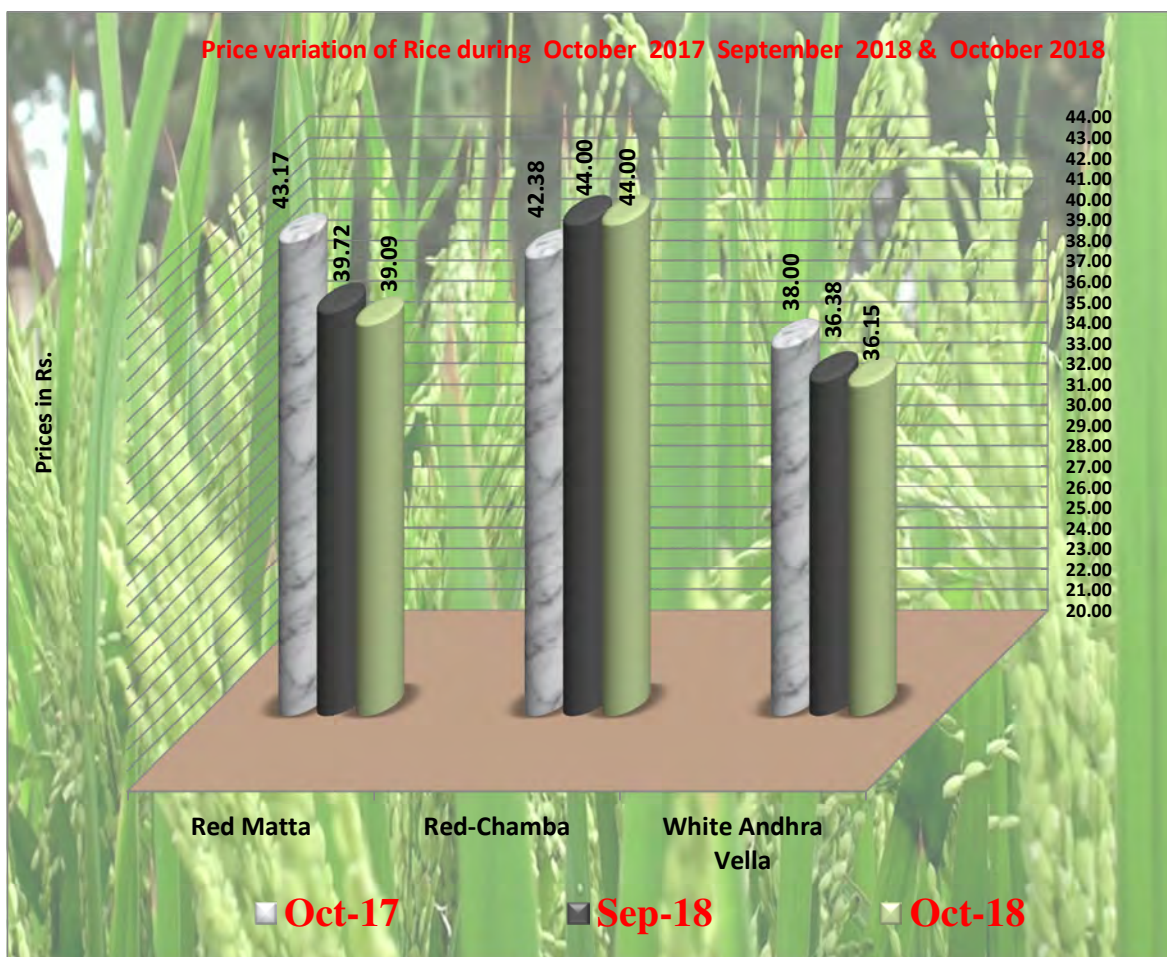
During this period a decreasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Rice except Red Chamba when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The State average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andhra Vella showed a slight decrease and Red Chamba remains stable when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andhra Vella showed a downward trend up to 9.45% ,while the price of Red Chamba increased by about 4% when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. The following table and diagram represent the prices and percentage of variation over month and year of Rice.

2. PULSES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.

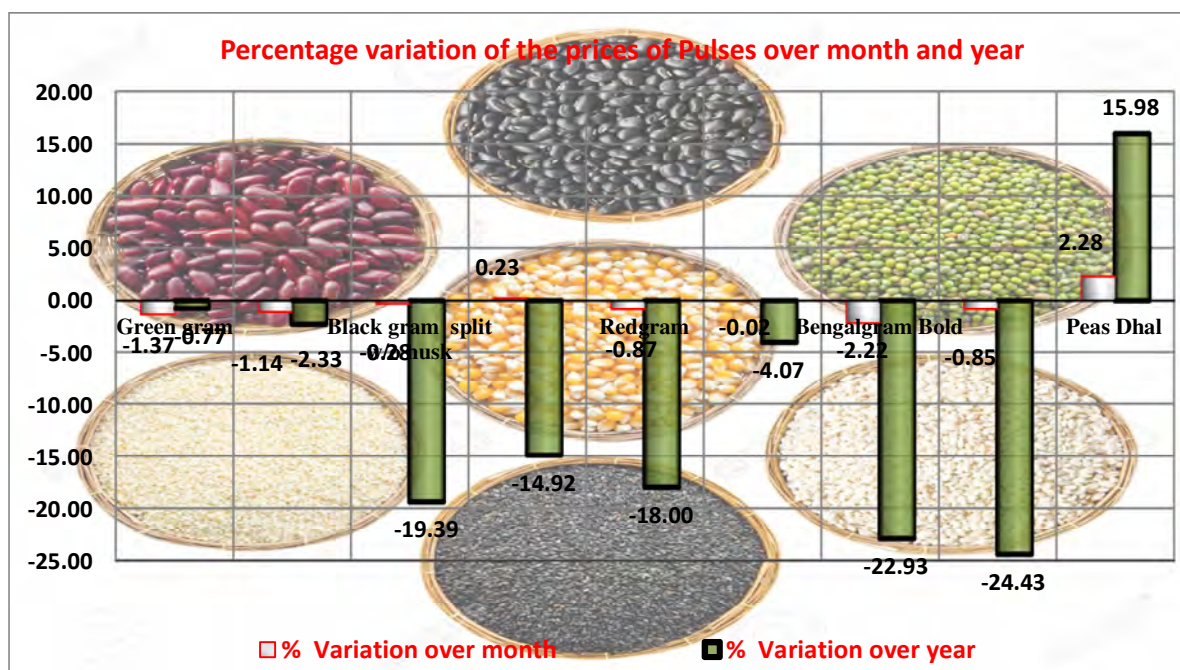
During this period a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The State average retail price of Black gram split with husk and Peas Dhall showed an upward trend up to 2.28% while the price of all other items of pulses showed a downward trend up to 2.22% when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items of pulses except Peas Dhall showed a downward trend up to 24.43%. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Blackgram split w/o husk (19.39%), Blackgram split with husk (14.92%), Redgram (18%), Bengalgram Bold (22.93%) and Bengalgram Small (24.43%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. The following table and diagram represent the prices and percentage of variation over month and year of pulses.

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.

During this period a mixed trend was noticed in the state average retail price of other food items when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The State average retail prices of Sugar (O.M) and Tea(Kannan Devan) showed a nominal decrease and the price of Egg Hen(White Lagon) and Mutton with Bones rose to 3.62% and 0.82% respectively, while the price of all other items of other food items remain unchanged when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Sugar (O.M),Tea(Kannan Devan),Baby Food (amul)and Egg Hen(White Lagon) showed a downward trend up to 12.12% and Milk(cow's) showed no change while the price of all other items of other food items showed an upward trend up to 6.79% when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

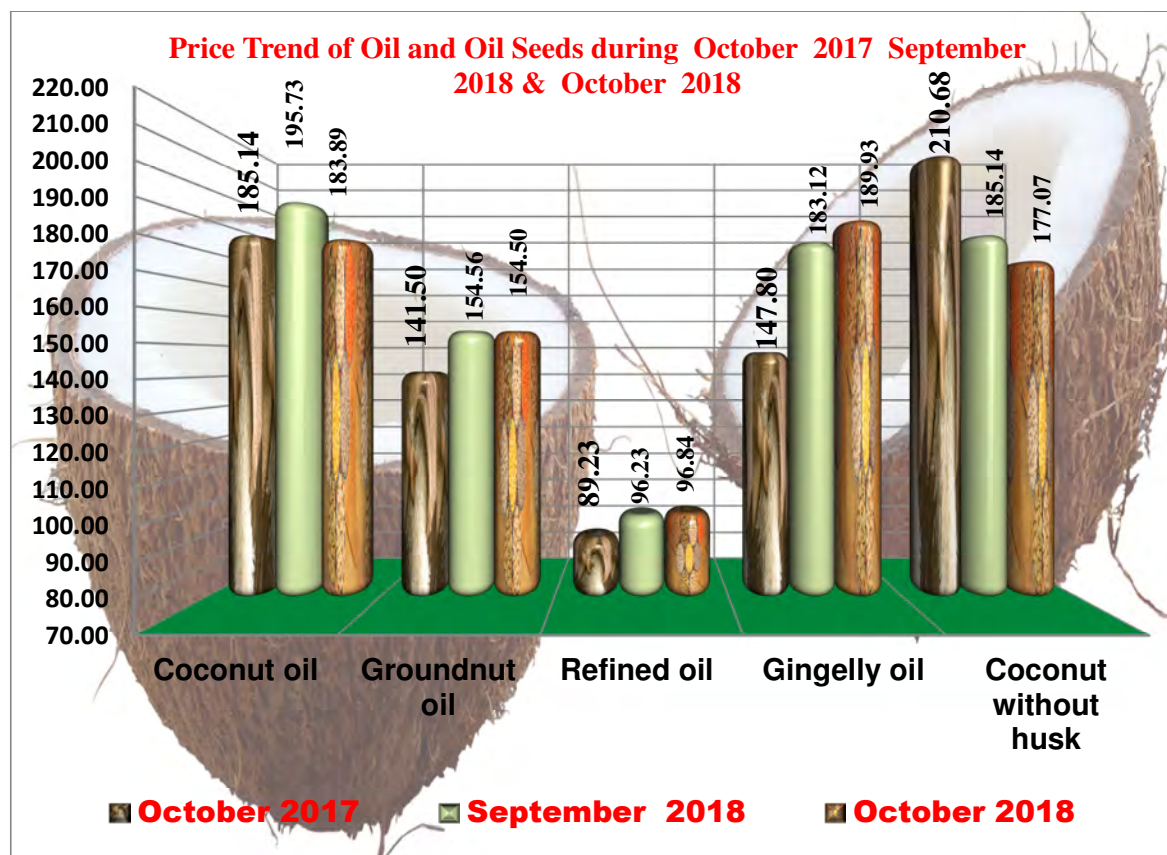
During this period a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of oil and oil seeds when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The state average retail price of Coconut oil, Groundnut oil and Coconut without husk showed a downward trend up to 6.05% while the price of all other items of oil and oil seeds showed an upward trend up to 3.72% when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items of oil and oil seeds except Coconut Oil and Coconut without husk showed an upward trend up to 28.50%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Gingelly oil (28.50%) and decrease was seen in the price of Coconut without husk (15.95%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:

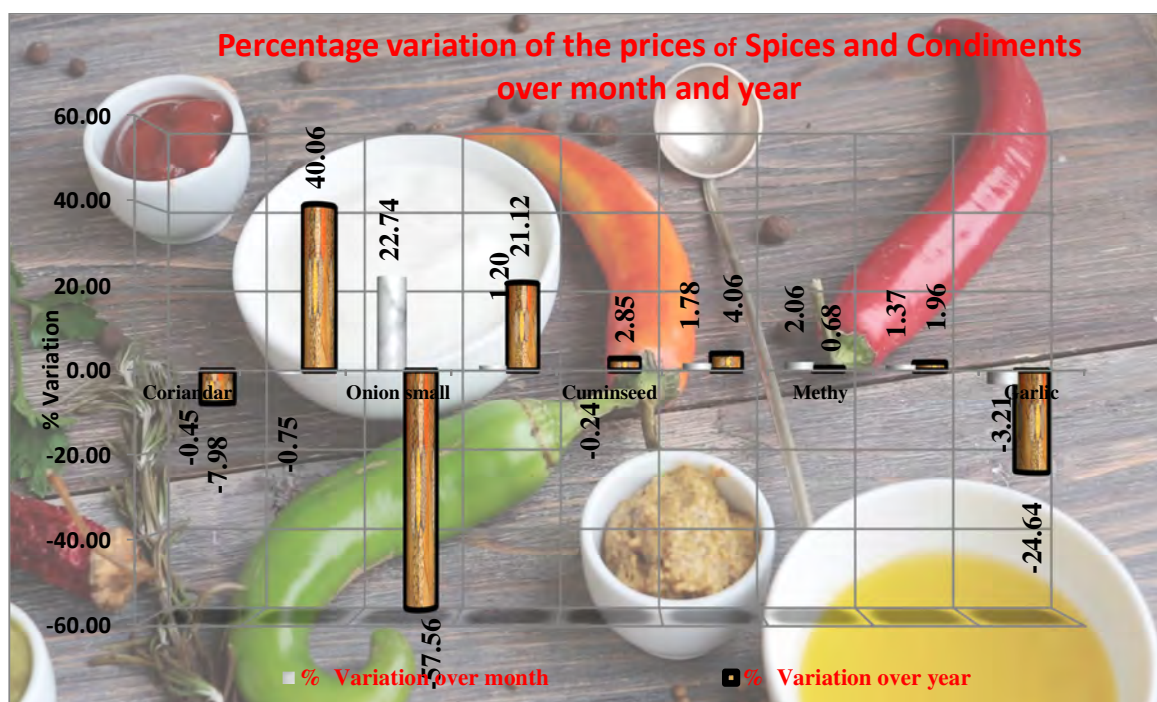
During this period a mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of spices and condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The state average retail price of Coriander, Chillies dry, Cuminseed and Garlic showed a downward trend up to 3.21% while the prices of all other items of Spices and Condiments showed an upward trend up to 22.74% when compared with the price of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion small (22.74%) when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Coriander, Onion small and Garlic showed a downward trend up to 57.56% while the prices of all other items of Spices and Condiments showed an upward trend up to 40.06% when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the price of Chillies dry (40.06%) and Tamarind without seeds loose (21.12%) and decrease was seen in the price of Onion small (57.56%) and Garlic (24.64%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

6. TUBERS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Tubers

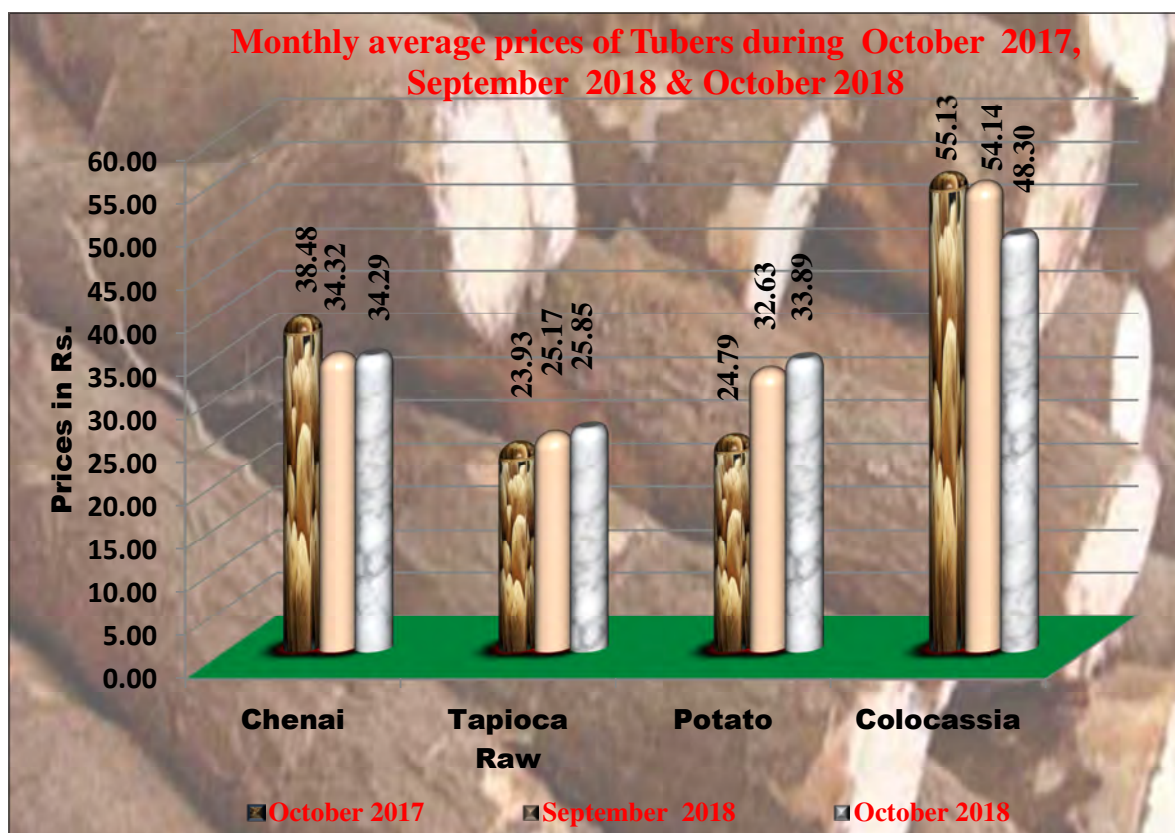
During this period a mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The state average retail prices of all items of Tubers except Chenai and Colocassia showed an upward trend up to 3.89% when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State average retail prices of all items of Tubers except Tapioca Raw and Potato showed a downward trend up to 12.38%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Potato (36.75%) when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year.

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.

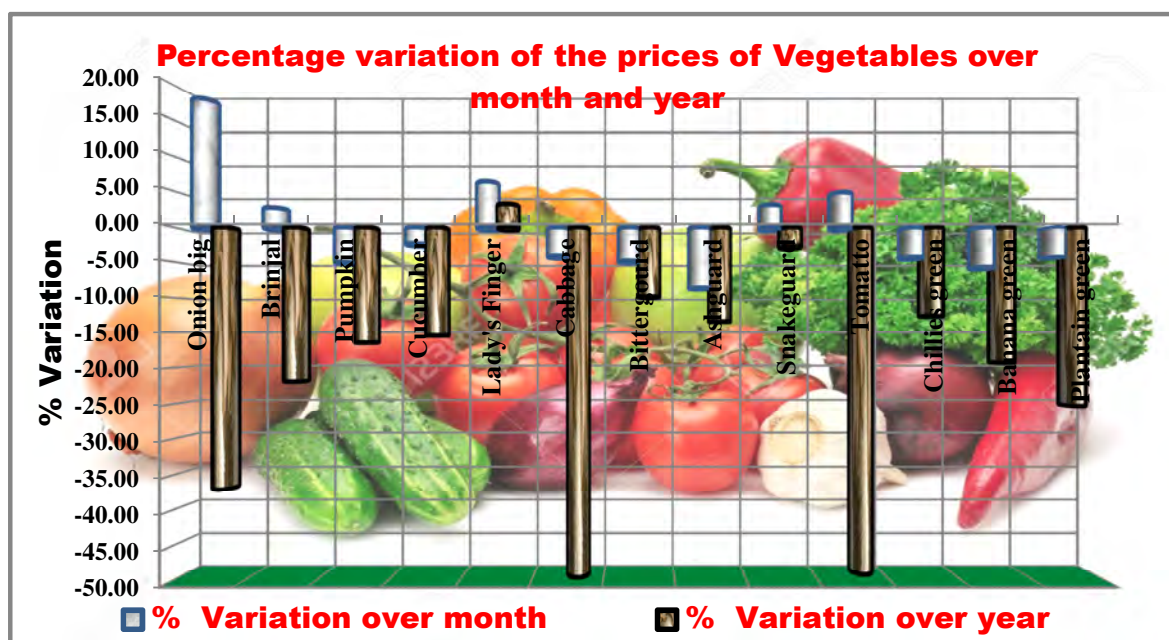
A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of vegetables when compared with that of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The state average retail prices of Onion big, Brinjal, Lady's Finger, Snakeguard and Tomatto showed an upward trend up to 18.01% while the prices of all other items of Vegetables showed a downward trend up to 8.69% when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of all items of vegetables except Lady's Finger showed a downward trend up to 49.53%. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Cabbage (49.53%), Tomatto (49.11%) Onion big (37.06%) and Plantain green (25.28%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage of variation over month and year of Vegetables.

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items

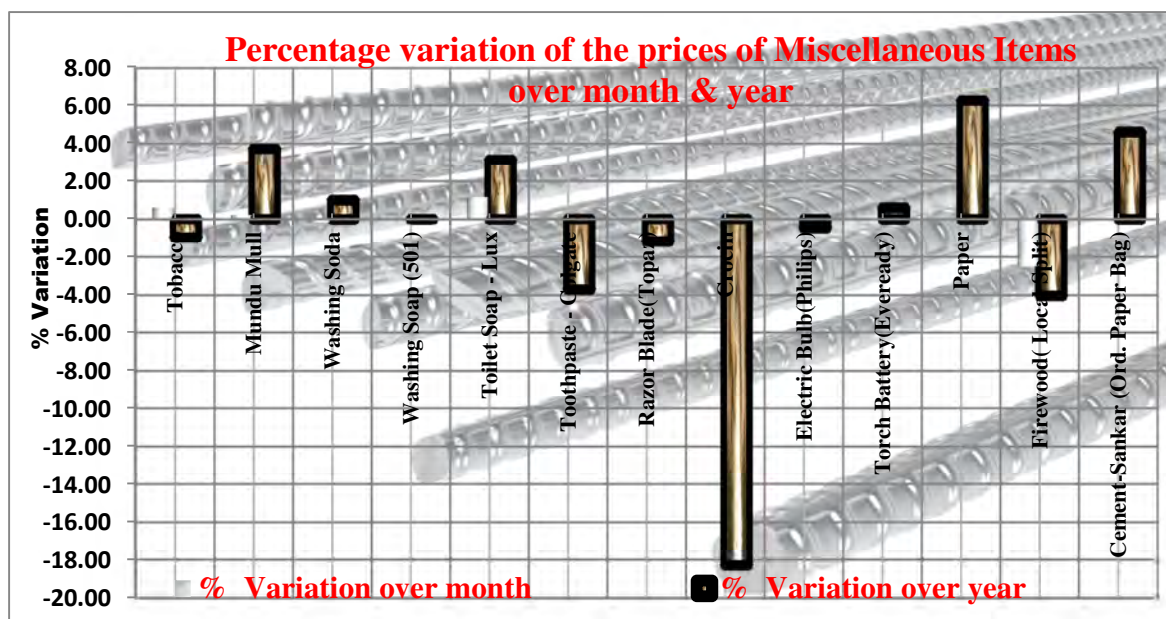
A mixed trend was observed during the month in the State average retail price of miscellaneous when compared with that of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. The state average retail prices of Tobacco, Mundu Mull and Toilet Soap-Lux showed an upward trend up to 1.15% when compared with the prices of the previous month and the state average retail price of Washing Soda and Firewood(Local Split) showed a downward trend up to 2.50% while the prices of all other items of miscellaneous remain unchanged when compared with the prices of the previous month. .

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year all items of miscellaneous except Tobacco, Toothpaste(colgate), Razor Blade(Topaz), Crocin, Electric Bulb(Philips) and Firewood(Local Split) showed an upward trend up to 6.23% .
