As per the G.O read as 1st above, Government had created the following posts in the Directorate of Economics and Statistics on temporary basis during the 5th Economic Census.

In the letter read as 2nd above the Director, Department of Economics and Statistics has informed that Government of India have requested to constitute a cell in the Department of Economics and Statistics by creating posts on temporary basis for 30 months in order to conduct the 6th Economic Census in the state. The number of posts and categories would be the same as was created for the 5th Economic census. Therefore the Director, Department of Economics and Statistics has requested Government to create the above said 9 posts under various categories in the Department on temporary basis for 30 months and submitted detailed proposal for the same.

Government have examined proposal submitted by the Director of Economics and Statistics in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for the creation of following 9 posts on temporary basis in the Directorate of Economics and Statistics for a period of 30 months, for the conduct of Sixth Economic census, subject to the following conditions.

1. The posts will be filled up only after the State Government gets funds from Government of India
2. The posts will be filled up by deputation.
3. The posts will cease to exist when the Government of India grant ceases.
