ORDER

Administrative sanction is accorded for the implementation of the following scheme in the Department of Economics and Statistics during 1982-83.

1. Scheme for the conduct of a sample survey to estimate the quantum of marketable surplus of important agricultural commodities produced in Kerala.

(ii) Scheme for the Socio-economic survey of agricultural labourers in Kerala.

(iii) Setting up of a Surveys Studies Design Division in the Directorate of Economics and Statistics.

2. Objectives of the survey on the quantum of marketable surplus of important agricultural commodities are the following:-

(i) to estimate the quantum of Marketable Surplus of all important agricultural commodities at the cultivator's level.

(ii) to collect information on the disposal pattern of the produce at the cultivator's level for working out the ratios of each type of disposal to total production for computing the State Income from agricultural sector in a more scientific manner.

(iii) to collect data on the farm prices (Prices received by the farmers at the farm site) during the period of the survey.

(iv) to collect wholesale prices of farm products prevailing in the wholesale markets for arriving at the base year prices.

3. Joint Director, Survey on construction Activities will attend to the above survey. The following additional posts are created for the survey for the period noted against each.

4. Object of the Socio-Economic Survey of agricultural labourers in Kavala are the following.

- (i) to build up reliable estimates of important socio-economic characteristics of agricultural labour and other rural labour households.
- (ii) to study the impact of various development schemes on the rural labourer households with special reference to agricultural labour households.

No new staff is sanctioned for this survey. The existing staff will attend to this survey. The survey will cover a period of 24 months.

5. The expenditure on the above scheme for the current year will be met from '304(d)23 Surveys & Studies' in the current year's budget.

6. The 'Surveys Studies Design Division' will design the surveys and prepare schedules and instructions for the schemes. The following supporting staff is created in this Division till the end of February, 1983.

Research Officer on Rs.700-1270 ..2
L.D. Compilers on Rs.330-550 ..2

The posts of Compiler can be converted into U.D. with reference to the admissible rates. Funds required for the scheme will be re-appropriated from the provision under '304(d)23 surveys & studies).
