O R D E R

The Government of India have in their letter read as third paper above conveyed the administrative approval to the continuance of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for the establishment of an Agency for reporting Agricultural Statistics in Kerala during 1977-78 at a total cost not exceeding Rs.40.00 (Rupees Forty) lakhs on the existing terms and conditions. The Government of India in their letter read as 4th paper above have also conveyed their approval for the creation and recruitment of the following additional staff for the implementation of the above scheme during 1977-78.

2. Administrative sanction is hereby accorded for the continuance of the scheme at a total cost of Rs.40.00 lakhs (Rupees forty lakhs) during 1977-78 as per the technical programme approved by the Government of India.

3. Sanction is also accorded for the creation of the temporary additional posts mentioned at para 1 above till the end of February 1978 for the implementation of the scheme.

4. According to the approved pattern of assistance of the scheme, the entire expenditure on actual basis subject to the ceiling of the sanctioned amount will be borne by the Government of India. Strict economy will be observed so as to keep the actual expenditure to the minimum.

5. The expenditure will be debited to the head of account "304(d)15-Timely Reporting Survey (T.R.S.) of Agricultural Statistics in Kerala (C.S.S.) - Plan".

6. The Director, Bureau of Economics & Statistics will take timely action in reporting the expenditure to the Government of India so that central assistance is released for the scheme in time during the current year itself. The Director, Bureau of Economics and Statistics will also forward quarterly report on the progress of the scheme, both financial and physical, to the Ministry of Agriculture & Irrigation, (Department of Agriculture), Government of India, New Delhi and to the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, regularly, through the State Government, by the 10th of the month following each quarter. The report may relate to the quarters ending 30th June, 30th September, 31st December and 31st March.

7. The Director, Bureau of Economics & Statistics will take up the issue of additional funds under para 81(f) of the Kerala Budget Manual after the existing provision of Rs.10.00 lakhs is fully expended.


