ORDER

The statistical work in the Dist. Statistical Offices have considerably increased in the last five years. There has been frequent demands for various items of statistical information at lower administrative or planning levels like Taluks, C.O. Blocks, etc. With the recent set up of District Planning Machinery, the requirements of Statistical data at the lower planning levels is on the increase. It has therefore become necessary to organise the compilation of data at the Dist. level so as to tabulate and maintain all basic statistical information at the levels required for district level planning.

The present set up in the Dist. Statistical office is not able to cope up with the technical competence envisaged above. There is no arrangement in the Dist. Statistical Offices for the tabulation of the data collected. In order to ensure timely availability of Statistical data at the list and lower levels, primary tabulation of important items should be done at the Dist. Statistical Offices. To take up this work and also to handle the increasing requirements of Statistical information required at the Dist. level, the Dist. Statistical Offices have to be sufficiently strengthened and a senior officer of technical competence put in charge of the Statistical work in the district. As a step in this direction, Govt. have decided to appoint a Deputy Director in each district as the head of the Dist. Statistical Office.

Sanctions are accorded for the creation of 6 posts of Deputy Directors on Rs. 975-1625 in six Districts till the end of February 1981. In the remaining five districts the Deputy Directors will be posted by deployment of 3 posts of Regional Deputy Directors (Tabulation), 1 post of Deputy Director in the state Income Unit and one post from the Manpower Unit.

The expenditure will be met from the provision under "304(d) 22- strengthening of BSS" in the current year's budget.
