Preface

Unemployment among the educated is the biggest challenge faced by our state as more than 51% of the job seekers in the live register of Employment exchanges possess S.S.L.C and above qualifications. State Government as a biggest employer in the public sector, have provided employment opportunities to a large number of educated. In 1980 nearly 148 percent of the total public sector employment was under the State Government. An earnest attempt is made in this report to frame the distribution of Government Employees as on First January 1980. Tables showing department wise distribution of employees are given in the appendix of this profile.

Since the details of personnel were collected in a voluntary basis, it has not been possible to ensure full coverage of the Government Employees. This has to be borne in mind while referring to the tables pertaining to individual departments.

Unemployment among the educated is the biggest challenge faced by our state as more than 51% of the job seekers in the live register of Employment exchanges possess S.S.L.C and above qualifications. State Government as a biggest employer in the public sector, have provided employment opportunities to a large number of educated. I would like to place on record my sincere thanks to the departmental heads for furnishing the details of their employees under their control. A. Profile on Kerala State Government Employees - 1980

Assessment of stock of the technical and non-technical personnel is one of the primary steps in Manpower Planning. At present department wise stock of technical and non-technical personnel, showing religion, age, qualification, training, undergone, etc. are not readily available. Since the State Government is the biggest employer in Kerala State, the Department of Economics and Statistics decided to conduct a comprehensive study covering sex, religion, age, qualification, scale of pay, training undergone etc. at the commencement of the sixth Five Year Plan, with the hope that the same will be useful to Planners and Administrators for the selection and implementation of developmental programmes in future.

Coverage:-

Technical and non-technical personnel working in different departments of the State Government have been covered in this profile.

Methodology:-

A list of all Heads of Departments/Controlling Officers of the State Government was prepared and all the above Officers were requested to furnish the necessary informations of all the employees working as on 1-1-1980 under their control in the proforma designed for this purpose.

Limitations:-

Since the details of personnel were collected on a voluntary basis, by mailed questionnaire, it was not possible to ensure full coverage of the employees. This has to be borne in mind while referring to the table pertaining to individual departments.

Analysis:-

Data received from 76 State government departments, were analysed and presented in this profile. Analysis of data is based on the information given by the Heads of Departments/Controlling Officers in good faith. It was seen than about two lakh employees were working in the 76 departments of the State Government as on First January 1980. Eventhough Kerala is in the forefront in respect of literacy and sex ratio, on analysis of sex wise distribution of the employees it was foundout that the females

contributed only about 29% of the total employees. This is exactly on par with the employment statistics, published by the Directorate of Employment. This low percentage may be due to the predominance of males in major departments like Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Police, Public works, Land Revenue, Subordinate Judiciary, Survey and Land Records etc. Religious breakup of the employees reveals that Hindus constituted about 71% followed by Christians with 19% and the remaining 10% by Muslims. Distribution of Employees according to religion and sex is given in the following table.

From the above table, it can be seen that the percentage of female Employees among Christians is higher than that of Hindus and Muslims. Female Employees belonging to Muslim community constitutes only 17%.

On analysis of the strength of the staff in various departments, it was found that employment in 10 departments exceed 2000 which works out 82% of the total employees. The sex wise distribution of employees in these departments is given in the following table.




It is interesting to note that the strength of employees in first five departments mentioned in the above table covers about 65% of the total employees; and the remaining Eleven departments covers only 17.06 percent. It can also seen that the percentage of female employees except in Educational and Health services departments are much less when compared with males. The high percentage of females in Education and Health services departments may be due to the nature of work.



Kerala stood in the forefront among the states in respect of literacy, while the literacy rate of Kerala, according to 1981 census is 70.42, the national average of literacy is only 36.03. Since availability of qualified personnels is one of the perquisite for assessing the requirement in future, an attempt has been made in the following table to clarify the employees in the state Government Service according to their qualification.

The above table shows that more than 74% of the employees possess S.S.L.C and above qualifications. Nearly 30% of the employees possess either diploma or certificate in addition to their qualifications. Most of them have obtained their diploma certificate before entering into service. Graduates contributes about 16% of the total employees and post graduates about 2.6%. In the department like Collegiate Education, health Services, Medical colleges and Technical Education large number of employees possess post graduate and higher qualifications.

For the successful implementation of any scheme and for future planning it is essential to have sufficient number of persons with training in their respective fields. Government have established agencies/Institutions to import training to the employees working in various departments. Facilities are being provided to employees to undergo training out side the state and abroad. An attempt has been made to furnish the details of employees who have undergone training within the state/outside the state/abroad, in various departments. The following table gives the venue and the distribution of trained personnel.



The above table shows that only about 23% of the employees have undergone training. The low percentage may due to the failure of on the part of informants to record the details of training undergone in the relavent columns of the individuals.

Since day to day expenses are increasing steadily employees find it difficult to make both ends meat without the financial assistance of their spouse. Therefore many of the couples are employed either in government or in other services. Since those families will be able to lead a comfortable life with their joint income an attempt has been made to furnish the details of spouses employed (See table VI appendix). On analysis it is seen that 31,303 males and 35935 females are earning their daily bread with the joint effort of their spouse.

To study the financial position of Government Employees, it would be useful to ascertain their distribution based on their actual pay. An effort has been made to furnish the details of

the employees according to their caste; and actual pay drawn in table IX of the concerned department. Distribution of total Government employees according to their actual pay is given in the following table.

It is seen from the above table that more than 75% of the State Government Employees are getting less than Rs.570/- as their actual pay and only about 5% are getting more than Rs.900/- as their actual pay.

For uplifting people belonging to socially and Economically weaker sections, Government have taken various measures to provide special quota in employment opportunities, to persons belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled tribe and other Backward Communities. A certain percentage of posts have been reserved for them and relaxation in qualification & age has also been made in the case of direct recruitment. As Government is the biggest employer in the state, it would be useful to examine whether the people belonging to socially and economically weaker communities have obtained adequate employment in Government Service. Distribution of Government employees according to Scale of pay, year of Birth, Caste and 'actual pay', in respect of each department have been given in tables V, VI, VII, VIII and IX of the concerned Departments. The following table gives the community wise distribution of the total employees.




The above table shows that about 9.5 percent of the total employees belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe community and about 45% to Other Backward Classes. Analysis of department-wise data reveals that maximum Number viz 87 of employees belonging to Scheduled Tribes was seen employed in the General Education Department followed by Health Services with 71 employees. In respect of Scheduled Caste, General Education Departments stands first viz 5092 employees followed by police department with 2439 employees.

Age distribution of employees on a particular date is an important factor for chalkingout future recruitment programmes. Vacancies generally arise due to retirement, death, deputation to other departments/States and creation of new posts. Distribution of employees according to case and year of birth in respect of each department have been given in Table VI (Appendix)



The above table reveals that 20302 (10.16 percentage) employees have retired during the sixth plan period and another 13 percentage within the next five years. It is interesting to note that more than 62 percentage of the total employees will retire on superannuation before 2000 A.D.
