

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Introduction

State income is one of the important yardsticks for measuring economic development. It represents the Net Domestic Product at factor cost originating within the "geographical boundary of the State." The concept of Net Domestic Product has been adopted since reliable data on transfer incomes are not available separately for states. Domestic Product is the product that is generated within a given teritory, while National Product is domestic product plus net factor incomes earned from abroad.

The terms are generally used as NNP/NDP 'at factor cost' because they are derived by adding up costs which are in terms of factor payments only. Factor payments include compensation of employees, rent, interest and profits & dividends. In the case of self employed where no factor payments are made, the category of income is treated as 'mixed income of self-employed'. In India as a whole more than 40 percent of the national income falls under this category. In cases where there are indirect taxes and goods are sold in the market at prices including indirect taxes. Product 'at market prices' means inclusive of indirect taxes and product at factor cost means exclusive of indirect taxes.

In order to measure the growth of National/State income over a period of time estimates are prepared on the basis of two series (1) at current prices and (2) at constant prices. It can be seen that the national poduct at current prices has been shooting up since the last few years. This is largely the result of inflation. But at 1970-71 prices it has been moving up at a very slow pace. This indicates that the growth of real output has been rather very slow.

While estimating National/State income the gross and Net concepts have to be taken into account. Gross product is estimated inclusive of depreciation. Net product equals gross products minus depreciation.

By factor incomes Net Domestic Product can be divided into-

- 1. Wages & Salaries
- 2. Rent
- 3. Interest
- 4. Profits & dividends, and
- 5. Mixed income of self employed.

By economic activity NDP constitutes the sum total of the income contributed by the different sectors viz.

1. Primary sector

: Agriculture & Allied activities

2. Secondary sector

: Manufacturing, Electricity, construction etc.

3. Tertiary sector

: Transport, Communication & Trade Finance & Real Estate Community & Personal Services.

This report attempts to give a pitcure of the trend in the growth of State Domestic Product and per capita income of Kerala vis-a-vis other states and all India. Sectorwise and district wise distribution of the state domestic product and per capita income is also furnished. This publication, for the first time, presents estimates of gross Domestic product and Factor Income Estimation of factor income is only a preliminary attempt based on the available data and the methodology suggested by the Central Statistical Organisation.

The report contains three parts. Part-I is narrative part dealing with metholodgy and trend in the growth of State domestic product. Part-II contains statments. Distribution of factor income and methodology used for the estimation of the same are given in Part-III.

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PREFACE

Every year the Department of Economics & Statistics publishes quick estimates of the Net Domestic Product of Kerala based on the latest available data and using the standard methodology suggested by the Central Statistical Organisation of the Government of India. The methodology followed is also given in this report. Since it takes considerable time to obtain data from various departments/agencies quick estimates of State Income could be prepared only on the basis of crude data and hence are liable to significant changes. The present report deals with the quick estimates of the State Domestic Product in 1983-84. Time series data from 1970-71 are also given in the report. In order to enable state wise and all India comparison of Net Domestic Product such data are also presented.

The report furnishes for the first time two additional items viz., G.D.P. and Factor Incomes by industry of origin. It is hoped that this report will be useful to planners, policy makers and research workers engaged in macro-economic studies.

This report was prepared by the State Income unit* of the Department of Economics and Statistics.

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STATE INCOME OF KERALA

A brief analysis

The present issue of "Estimates of Net Domestic product (State Income) and aggregates covers, the provisional estimates of State Income for the period 1981-82 and 1982-83 and quick estimates for the period 1983-84, and also final estimates for the period from 1970-71 to 1980-81. Estimates for the previous years have undergone some revision consequent on the availability of new and revised data.

This issue however contains two more additional features viz. Gross domestic product at factor cost (at current prices and also at constant prices) for the period from, 1970-71 to 1982-83 and the distribution of factor income by broad sectors for the year 1980-81.

State Income:

State Income is the net domestic product at factor cost orginated within the boundary of the state. Estimates have been prepared according to the methodology suggested by the Central Statistical Organisation. These have the same scope, coverage and approach to methodology as in the past.

At current prices:

Net domestic product at current prices is roughly estimated at Rs. 4,679 crores in 1983-84 against Rs. 4,214 crores in 1982-83; that is 11.03% higher compared to the previous year. The percapita income increased from Rs. 1,613 in 1982-83 to Rs. 1,761 in 1983-84 registering an increase of 9.18%. Between 1970-71 and 1983-84 the state's per capita income increased from Rs. 594 to Rs. 1,761 registering an increase of 196.46%.

At constant prices:

In real terms ie. at constant price (70-71 prices) the state Domestic product works out to Rs. 1,899 crores in 1983-84 as against Rs. 1,816 crores in 1982-83, showing an increase of 4.57%. The per capita income in real terms on the other hand showed only 3.16% increase ie. from Rs. 696 in 1982-83 to 718 in 1983-84. The rise in per capita income over the period 1970-71 to 1983-84 was of the order of 20.88%.

Structural change:

The primary sector of the economy showed a slight increase (at current prices) in its contribution to net domestic product during the period 1983-84. It contributed more than 41% of the total income at current prices whereas it was 40% during 1982-83. At constant prices however it declined from 34.89% in 1982-83 to 32.17% whereas it was 40% during 1982-83. At constant prices however it declined from 34.89% in 1982-83 to 32.17% in 1983-84. However the share of primary sector in the total net domestic product of the state has come down from 49.44% in 1970-71 to 40.42% in 1980-81 at current prices and to 38.93% at 1970-71 prices. The secondary sector showed a declining trend during this period 1982-83 to 1983-84 ie. from 21.08% to 19.99% at current prices. However it can be seen that the contribution of this sector has gone up from 16.32% in 1970-71 to 22.29% in 1980-81 at current prices. At constant prices also the share of the secondary sector showed more of or less same, increase.

The contribution by the tertiary sector remaind more or less the same during the last two years at current prices. But the share of this sector at constant prices showed an increase by 2.75% (increased from 44.90% to 47.65%) during this period. During 1970–71 and 1980–81 the contribution of the tertiary sector (at current prices) was 34.24% and 37.29% respectively.

Comparison with All India:

At current prices the national income works out to 160279 crores as compared with 1,33,151 crores in 1982-83. showing an increase of 20.4% where as in Kerala the corresponding increase is only 11%. At constant prices (1970-71)the total national income in 1983-84 is estimated at 54458 crores as against 50633 crores in 1982-83, thus recording an increase of 7.6%. In Kerala however, the rate is only 4.6%.

More or less the same trend is noticed in the case of per capita income as well. At current prices the growth rates are 17.8% and 8.89% respectively for India and Kerala. Latest available figures indicate that among the various states Kerala holds the 13th rank as regards per capita income, State Income and national income in 1002-93 and 1983-84 are given below:

The primary sector of the economy is the major contributor to national income eventhough its share shows a declining trend over the year.

Gross Domestic Product :

G.D.P. at current prices is estimated at 4608 Grores for the year 1982-83 & 4054 crores at 1981-82 showing an increase of 13.7% over the previous year. At 1970-71 prices G.D.P. accounts for about 1331 crores thus showing an increase of 24.6% over the period.

Gross Domestic Product at. constant price:

G.D.P. at constant price is estimated at 1945 crores in 1981-82 showing an increase of 5.7% over the previous year. The increase over the period 1970-71 to 1982-83 is of the order of more than 40%.

METHODOLOGY ON STATE INCOME COMPUTATION

Agriculture and Allied Activities

The Net Domestic Product from Agriculture (Proper), Livestock and allied activities except Government irrigation system is estimated by using the production approach, which involves estimation of gross value of products and by products and deduction of the value of inputs and consumption of fixed capital. For irrigation income approach is used and the total factor incomes generated as a result of providing the irrigation service is measured. Separate estimates of gross value of output for agricultural crops and Livestock products are prepared, while gross domestic product and net domestic products are worked out for the activity as a whole.

Agriculture (Proper):

Estimates of area and production of all the major and minor crops are based on crop estimation surveys under Timely Reporting Scheme. These figures are used for the estimation of gross value of out put. For miscellaneous and unspecified crops, out-turn estimates are not available but area figures are available. For plantation crops the production estimates published by the respective Commodity Boards are used. The out-turn of byproducts are estimated by applying the yield rates supplied by the C.S.O

For evaluating crop out puts crop-wise weighted average, wholesale prices preavailing in the primary markets during peak marketng periods are used. Weight being the districtwise production of the crop. Crops for which primary wholesale prices are not available, wholesale/Retails prices are used after making necessary adjustments for trade and transport margins.

The value of miscellaneous/unspecified crops, the out-turn of which are not available, is estimated by applying an appropriate average value of yield per hectare to the total area under each crop/crop group.

All the by-products are also evaluated at the primary wholesale prices. By-products for which the current year prices are not available, base year prices are moved to later years using suitable indices.

From the total gross value of out put necessary deductions are made for (1) difference in price of food grains procured (ii) value added by rice milling industry.

Livestok:

For estimating the gross value of out put from livestock products, they are divided into:—(i) milk and milk products (ii) meat and meat products (iii) hides and skins (iv) eggs and poultry meat (v) dung (vi) increment in stock (vii) other products.

In the absence of current direct information on out put of various livestock products, annual production is estimated by carrying forward the bench mark estimates by changes in the number of Livestock of the relevant Categories. The source of information of the Livestock numbers is the Livestock census. The Livestock numbers obtained from the results of the census are projected to later years. The value of out put is worked out by evaluating the Livestock products at the corresponding average annual wholesale prices duly deflated for trade and transport margins and rural/urban price differentials.

Value of hunting and trapping:

The estimates of value of out put from hunting and trapping are prepared from the data obtained from the Forest Department.

Inputs:

To arrive at the gross Domestic Product from agriculture, livestock and hunting and trapping necessary deductions are made for the cost of inputs. The inputs are (1) seed (2) manure (Chemical and organic). (3) current repairs and maintenance (4) Livestock feed (5) irrigation charges (6) Electricity (7) pesticides and insecticides (8) Market charges and (9) diesel Oil.

Net Domestic Product:

The G.D.P. is obtained by deducting the total cost of inputs from the Gross value. G.D.P. from operation of Government irrigation system is also added to obtain the total G.D.P. for the Sector. The consumption of fixed capital is deducted from G.D.P. to obtain the Net Domestic Product from Agricultural Sector.

Estimates at constant (1970-71) prices:

For estimation of NDP at constant prices the out put of agricultural crops, by-products, Livestock Products and inputs are evaluated at 1970-71 prices. From the Gross value, the cost of inputs, and the consumption of fixed capital are deducted to obtain the Net Domestic Product at constant prices.

Forestry and Logging

Forestry Sector includes (i) Forestry and (ii) Logging.

The forest products are classified into two groups viz. (i) Major products comprising industrial wood and fuel wood (2) minor products comprising a number of hetrogeneous items such as bamboo, sandal wood, ivory etc.

The Domestic product is estimated following the production approach.

For estimating the value of major forest products, the recorded production is evaluated at producers price. The producers price is obtained by adjusting the wholesale prices for trade and transport margins. An allowance of 10% of the value of the recorded production is made to cover all such unrecorded production. The royalty value of minor products is adjusted to arrive at the economic value.

From the Gorss value, cost of repairs and maintenance and depreciation are deducted to get the Net Domestic Product from forestry & logging.

Estimates at constant prices:

To obtain the gross value of major products at constant prices, the out-turn is evaluated at 1970-71 prices. The ratio of the recorded value of major products at the current year to the corresponding value at the base year is applied to estimate the value of minor products at constant prices.

From the Gross value, cost of repairs and maintenance and consumption of fixed capital are deducted to arrive at the Net Domestic Product, at constant prices.

Fishing

The activities included in this sector are (1) Marine fish landings (2) Inland fish landings (3) Subsistence fishing (4) Gathering of limeshell, Sea shell, See weeds and other products and (5) Fish curing viz salting and sundrying of fishes.

The production approach is followed to estimate the Net Domestic Product.

The estimates of Gross value of Marine fish landings, inland fish landings and subsistence fishing by non professional fishermen are prepared separately from the data supplied by the Fisheries Department. From the Gross value, cost of repairs, maintenance and other operational costs are deducted to obtain the Gross value added. From the Gross value added consumption of fixed capital is deducted to arrive at the Net value added. Net value added from fish curing and other products are also worked out separately and added to obtain the total Net Value added from Fishing Sector.

Estimated at constant prices:

For estimates of the value of output at constant prices, the current catch of marine fish, inland fish and fish for subsistence are valued at 1970-71 prices. From the gross value, cost of repairs and maintenance and consumption of fixed capital are deducted as above, to obtain the net domestic product. The other products are also evaluated at 1970-71 prices. The value added by fish curing in the base year is projected to later years in proportion to the changes in the quantity of fish cured in the current year relative to the base year. Net value added from fish curing and other products are also added to arrive at the Net Domestic Product from fishing at constant prices.

Mining and Quarrying

The estimates of income originating from this sector has been prepared by the production approach. Data on production and prices of Minerals obtained from the Indian Bureau of Mines have been used for the estimation. The Net product is obtained on deducting mining expenses and depreciation charges for Kerala—published by the Indian Bureau of Mines and Central Statistical Organisation. The value added at 1970-71 prices are obtained by using the price of Minerals for 1970-71.

The District-wise breakup are obtained based on the production of Minerals in each district obtained from the State Geology Department.

Manufacturing

(1) Registered Sector:

The estimates of gross and net products originating in this industry is prepared by 19 Industry Groups on the basis of Annual Survey of Industries. The estimates of gross/net value added obtained from Annual Survey of Industries have been further adjusted for imputed bank charges.

The value added at 1970-71 prices are obtained by deflating the current value of industries at two digit level of National Industrial Code 1970 with the help of State wholesale price index. These estimates are also adjusted for imputed bank charges. The ratio of imputed bank charges to net value added as obtained in the current price series is used for constant price also. The district-wise breakup are obtained based on the number of workers in the organised sector in each district.

(ii) Unregistered sector:

Income method has been followed to estimate income from this sector. For the purpose of estimation of net value added in this sector the survey results of (i) NSS 33rd round "sample survey on Non-Directory manufacturing establishments and own account enterprises of Kerala, 1978-79" and (ii) sample survey on Directory manufacturing establishments of Kerala 1978-79, are used.

The NSS 33rd round covers all manufacturing/repairing enterprises which are not registered under the Indian Factories Act, 1948 and belonging to own account manufacturing enterprises and Non-Directory manufacturing establishments both in the Rural and Urban areas. A separate sample survey on Directory manufacturing establishments in the year was carried out by this Department leaving the registered factories coming under sections 2m(i) and 2m (ii) of the Indian Factories Act, 1948.

The net value added from the above survey results for 19 groups for the year 1977-78 obtained have been moved to other years using the following Index.

The net value added thus obtained is further adjusted for inputed bank charges.

The value added at 1970-71 prices are obtained by deflating the current value of industries at two digit level of National Industrial Code 1970 with the help of State wholesale price index. These estimates are also further adjusted for imputed bank charges. The Dsitrict-wise breakup are obtained based on the number of workers in Household Industries in each district.

Construction

The State Domestic products of construction activities is based on expenditure method.

The estimates of capital expenditure for construction are prepared under the following heads:

I. (a) State Government Administrative Departments and Local Bodies.

Construction expenditure is prepared based on the analysis of State Government Budget and from the analysis of the accounts of Local Bodies.

(b) Departmental enterprises

Construction expenditure is obtained from the analysis of the accounts of Departmental enterprises.

(c) Non-Departmental enterprises:

Construction expenditure is obtained by analysis of the accouts of the non-departmental enterprises.

II. Post and Telegraph

Construction expenditure is collected from the Post and Telegraph Department.

III. Railways:

Construction expenditure is collected from the Railway authorities.

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IV. Central Public Works Department: See September of the public of the Control o

Construction expenditure is collected from the CPWD.

V. (a) Urban Residential Buildings:

The base year estimate in construction expendiure is obtained from the NSS 17th round (1960-61). The Geometric Growth rate of urban households in Kerala is applied on base year estimates. The current price estimates are obtained by applying weighted index of cost of construction of Buildings in Kerala.

(b) Rural Residential Buildings:

The estimates of expenditure on new construction and repairs and maintenance for the year 1971-72 is prepared based on the data available in AIDIS. Two-third of the expenditure on repairs and replacement are treated as capital expenditure and the remaining one-third as current expenditure. 1971-72 estimates of capital expenditure are moved to later years with the help of Geometric growth rate in rural census dwellings in Kerala based on 1971 and 1981 population census data. The current price estimates are obtained with the help of weighted index of cost of construction of Buildings in Kerala.

(c) Rural Non-residential buildings and rural and urban other construction works:

The capital expenditure for 1971-72 is prepared based on the data available in AIDIS. As in the case of rural residential buildings, two-third of the expenditure on "repairs and replacements is treated as capital expenditure." The base year estimate (1971-72) prepared from AIDIS is moved to later years with the help of value of output from Agriculture and total cropped area in Kerala. The price indices of wages of rural skilled workers are applied to these estimates to obtain the current price estimates.

VI. Co-operation:

The estimates of capital expenditure in land and buildings are prepared on the basis of data on assets available in "Statistical Statements relating to Co-operative Movement in India Part-I" (credit societies) and Part-II (Non-credit societies). The expenditure on construction of buildings are assumed to be 80 per cent of the expenditure on land and buildings. Maintenance expenditure and consumption of fixed capital are assumed to be 0.5 per cent and 2.00 per cent respectively of the value of buildings in each year.

VII. Residual (Private | Corporate sector):

Base year estimate is prepared from Lal's paper in RBI publication 1965-66. This is moved to later years with the help of construction expenditure (at current prices) in rural and urban residential sectors, to obtain the estimates at current price.

For the household sectors 33% of the total expenditure is taken and for the remaining sectors 31% of the total expenditure is taken as the net domestic product.

The constant price estimates are obtained by deflating the current price estimates with the help of Index on Wage Structure Survey. District-wise breakup are obtained based on the number of construction workers in each District.

Electricity, Gas and Water supply

(a) Electricity:

The activities considered for the estimation of State Domestic Product in this industry group includes generation, transmission and distribution of electric energy. The estimates of income from this sector are derived by adopting the income approach. The Kerala State Electricity Board covers the major portion of the activity in this Industry in this State. There are also licencees and sanction holders engaged in the distribution of electricity in this State.

The contribution to State Income from the Kerala State Electricity Board has been estimated by analysing the Annual Accounts of the Board. Gross income has been estimated as an aggregate factor payments such as compensation paid to employees including Salaries and Wages, other welfare expenses, managing—agent's remuneration, interest, rent, operating surplus including transfer to reserve and depreciation. The net income is derived on subtracting depreciation from gross income. In respect of licences and sanction holders the value added data furnished in the Annual Survey of Industries reports for the State of Kerala has been directly used.

The estimate at 1970-71 prices are obtained by multiplying the Gross Value added for 1970-71 with the Index number showing the changes in revenue for sale of energy.

District-wise breakup are obtained based on the number of consumers of power in each district.

(b) Gas:

The contribution to State Income from Gas is estimated by analysing the Annaul Accounts received from the Indane distributing agencies of Kerala. Gross Income is estimated as aggregate factor payments such as compensation paid to workers including bonus, interest paid by the distributor, rent and profit. The net income is derived by substracting depreciation from the Gross Income.

The constant price estimates are obtained by using the average income per person of 1970-71. Districtwise break up are obtained based on the number of Indane distributors in each District.

(c) Water Supply:

The estimates are prepared by Income approach. The working force in Water Supply Industry are estimated separately for rural and urban areas on the basis of growth rates observed for 1961 and 1971 census. The per head earnings is computed based on the data on employment and compensation paid to employees collected from Municipalities, Corporations and Townships for urban areas. In respect of rural areas, the average income per worker is not available from 1975-76. Therefore the urban-rural ratio of average income per person for 1975-76 is calculated and applied to the average wage rate of the worker in the urban areas to obtain the wage rate of the workers in the rural areas.

The estimates at constant prices are obtained by using the avarage income per person of 1970-71. District-wise break up are obtained based on the number of employees in this industry in each District.

Transport, Storage and Communications

The sector includes (i) Railways, (ii) Transport by other means and storage and (iii) Communication.

I. Railways:

In the case of Railways, the estimates are supplied by Central Statistical Organisation.

II. Transport by other means and storage:

The net value added in mechanised Road Transport in the Public Sector has been worked out annually using the results of analysis of profit and loss statement of Kerala State Road Transport Corporation. For the private sector the value added per person engaged in passenger transport (Bus) has been worked out each year, using the results of the analysis of profit and loss statement of a sample number of private undertaking from each district. The number of workers for 1970-71 is based on 1971 population census and these have been carried forward to other years on the basis of annual growth rate observed in the number of vehicles registered with the State Transport Authorities. Assuming the average earning from goods traffic to be the same as for private bus service, the net value added is estimated using the estimated number of workers.

The Constant price estimates for Transport mechanised public sector is obtained using the index of employment (K.S.R.T.C.) and that for private sector is obtained using the index of number of registered vehicles.

For the non-mechanised Road Transport, gross earnings is obtained using the number of workers estimated from the 1971 census combined with the earning per worker available from the NSS survey (29th round). This is for the year 1974-75. For the other years it was carried forward and backward with the help of index of consumer price of urban non-manual employees for urban area and wages of skilled workers for rural area.

The estimate at Constant Price is obtained using the index of employment 1971 census.

Estimates of income from Kerala Road Transport Corporation (Water Transport Wing) and Water Transport Department at Alleppey are obtained by analysing the annual accounts of the respective Water Transport undertakings.

Estimate at Constant price is obtained using the index of employment of the respective concerns.

Income from Cochin Port Trust is worked out annually by analysing the relevant budgets.

The value added at constant price is obtained using the index of employment.

Income from Storage:

(Public Sector) is prepared on the basis of the annual accounts of the Ware Housing Corporation. Estimates of value added from storage (NEC) is based on the NSS 29th round. Value added for 1974-75 is prepared by using the data available in the 29th round. This is carried forward and backward for other years using the relevant index of gross value of output of commodity producing sector at current prices.

For the estimates at constant prices data regarding the storage capacity available from the administration report is made use of.

Communication:

The estimates at current and constant price are supplied by C.S.O.

Trade Hotels and Restaurants:

The value added for the year 1978-79 is obtained from the NSS 34th round. For the other years it is carried forward and backward with the help of index on gross value of commodity producing sectors valued at current price. The NSS data does not cover public sector enterprises. Hence adjustment for the same and for imputed bank changes are also made in this estimate.

The estimate at 1970-71 prices is worked out using the index of value of commodity producing sectors valued at constant prices.

Banking and Insurance:

Estimates at current and constant prices are supplied by the C.S..O.

Real estate and ownership of dwelling

Real estate:

The net product in respect of Real estate is worked out by analysing the balance sheet of the joint stock companies.

Ownership of dwelling:

The State domestic product from the ownership of dwelling is estimated by collecting the required details from all the municipalities, corporation and a sample number of panchayats in the State.

In the case of Panchayat, estimated rental/dwelling was worked out from the sample panchayats. Gross rental value is then calculated as a product of rental/dwelling and the estimated number of rural dwellings.

Net domestic product is estimated by deducting from the expenditure on gross rentals the expenditure on current repairs and maintenance and depreciation. For consumption of fixed capital the respective percentages used at all India level (separately for Rural and Urban) is adopted for the State.

Value added at constant price is obtained using the index of number of urban dwellings.

Business Service:

The estimates are prepared following the same approach and same source of data as for other 'services' (other than Medical and Health Service).

The value added at 1970-71 price is obtained using the index of employment (1971—Census).

Public Administration:

The estimates are prepared separately for the State Government, Central Government and Local Bodies consisting of Municipalities, Corporations and Panchayats.

With regard to the income of persons in the State Government Service, the estimates are prepared in terms of compensation of employees obtained from the budget documents of the State. For the Central Part, the estimates are supplied by the Central Statistical Organisation.

For the Local Bodies, data on expenditure on wages and salaries have been collected from all the Municipalities, Corporations and Panchayats of the State.

Constant price is worked out using current constant ratio of C.S.O's. estimate.

Other Services:

Estimates of net domestic product for this sector have been prepared separately for Education, Medical and Health Service, Sanitary Service and the rest.

For Educational Services, the details of expenditure incurred on wages and salaries of teachers and others staff in the respective educational institutions both public and private are estimated from the relevant budget.

Value added at constant price in the education sector is obtained using the average of teacher student ratio.

In the case of Medical and Health Services, the expenditure on wages and salaries in the public sector have been obtained from the budget of the state.

For the estimate of value added from non-Government sector the value added/worker for rural and urban areas are worked out on the basis of the results of NSS 29th round (1974-75). These are then brought forward and backward using the indices of wages of rural skilled workers and consumer price index number of urban non-manual employees. The total working force for the private sector is obtained by substracting employment in the public sector from the total working force from the census.

Sanitary Service:

The compensation of employees has been estimated on the basis of Municipal data.

Other Service:

For the rest of the services the estimate has been 'prepared separately for rural and urban areas with the help of details of working force and the corresponding value added per worker. The gross value added per worker is obtained from NSS 29th Round (1974-75). The gross value added is obtained following the same method as for non Government medical—Health Services.

Value added at constant price for Medical and Health Service, Sanitary Service and other services are obtained using the index of employment.

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Factor Income

(a) Methodology

By definition factor income includes four categories viz., (1) Compensation to employees, (2) Rent, (3) Interest and (4) Profits and Dividends. But in under developed countries like India, the demarcation line is not clear out. In such countries there exist a large number of unincorporated enterprises and household industries. Most of them do not properly maintain records. Besides, they may be managed by self employed workers. In such cases income generated cannot be separated between income from labour and other factors. Hence an additional item of 'mixed income of the self employed" is also introduced. This covers total income of the own account workers as well as the profits and dividends generated in the unincorporated enterprises.

Method of Estimation

As in the case of estimation of net domestic product, the estimates of factor incomes are prepared by sectors.

Agriculture

The estimates are prepared separately for organised and unorganised segments.

The organised part of the sector consists of plantation, and government irrigation system. For plantations (tea, coffee, rubber, and others) the estimates are based on the results of the annual R.B.I. studies on Finances of Medium and Large public limited companies (RBI Bullettin). (1983-July) From the report data regarding the compensation, rent, interest and profits as percentage of value of production for the year 1980-81 are available. With the help of these percentages Components of factor Income of plantation crops like, tea, coffee, rubber, cocoa etc. are estimated. The estimates of a factor incomes from Government irrigation system obtained from the analysis of the budget data and annual reports are added to arrive at the factor income of the organised activities.

The estimates of unorganised agriculture are based on the sample survey of cost of cultivation studies. The study relates to the year 1980-81. From the report we get information on per acre value of output and cost of hired labour. The results are used to determine the proportions of compensation of employees to value of output at the crop level. These are then used to estimate the factor incomes in agriculture (cultivation) sub-sector.

Since no data regarding the livestock sub-sector are available the same proportion as for agriculture (cultivation) sub-sector are applied to this sector also.

Forestry and Logging

The estimates for this sector are based on the data available in the annual budget documents of the State Government. Expenditure on compensation of employees and interest are available from the demand for expenditure. The surplus is derived by subtracting the total expenditure from the receipt. The distribution of factor incomes in the net value added derived from these data, in respect of Government forests, is used to determine factor incomes from the sector as a whole.

Fishing

The activities of this sector are assumed to be mainly unorganised in character. The estimation of factor income mainly based on the data thrown by the study on "Economics of Artisanal and Mechanised fisheries in Kerala—A study on costs and earnings of fishing units" 1980-81. (The study was executed by the programme for community organisation (PCO)—a voluntary agency based in Trivandrum that undertakes village level development work, training, educational programmes and research—in co-operation with the FAO projects for small scale fisheries development). From the report per unit data regarding (1) gross value added (2) per capita crew remuneration etc., are available. Compensation to employees and profit are estimated with the help of these data. The survey however failed to assess interest payments. So the same rate as far All India rate is utilised for Kerala also. Mixed income of the self employed is obtained as a residual by subtracting the other factor incomes from the net value added. According to the methodology of Central Statistical Organisation payments like rent are insignificant and can be ignored.

Manufacturing Registered

The estimates are based on the data available in the ASI reports. ASI reports contain data on compensation of employees, wages and salaries, festival and other bonuses and exgratia payments paid at less frequent intervels Interest and profit are also estimated from ASI reports.

Unregistered Manufacturing

Since, data regarding the components of factor income are not available, the all India rate is adopted for the State also.

Construction

Estimates are prepared separately for the organised sector comprising public and private corporate sectors and the unorganised sector consisting of residual institutions and households. For the organised sector components of factor income are available from the detailed analysis of the annual accounts of the non-departmental undertakings engaged in construction activity in the public sector. This proportion is used for distributing net value added from organised sector into its components.

For the unorganised sector, factor income are estimated in terms of compensation of employees, interest and mixed income of the self employed. Report on the survey of households construction activities, in Kerala 1980-81 provide data regarding the financing of construction work and the rate of interest for the loans used for the purposes. From these data interest is worked out.

Electricity gas, and water supply

The estimates of factor incomes of electricity sub-sector are based on the results of the analysis of annual accounts of the Kerala State electricity Board. In respect of licences and sanction holders the estimates are based on the Annual Survey of Industries.

The estimates of the components factor income for gas are based on the analysis of the annual accounts received from the Indane distributing agencies of Kerala.

Estimates for Water supply are based on the data collected from the Municipalities, Corporations and Townships for urban areas.

Transport, Storage and Communication (1) (Railways & Communication)

The activities of this sector are considered as organised in character factor income is estimated at the same proportion as far All India estimates. same proportion is applied to net value added. The compacted of spiced

(2) Transport by other means and storage

The sub-sector is divided into organised and unorganised.

Organised.—The organised part consists of passenger transport by road inland water in public sector, sea transport by shipping companies port trust, ports and pilotage light houses and light ships, air transportation and warehousing corporation. For this sector current data on components of factor income are available in annual accounts of the non departmental enterprises and also from the budget documents of the State Government.

In respect of unorganised sector the following methods are adopted.

Private Road Transport—Data regarding the components of factor income are available from the survey annually conducted among the private bus owners-same proportion is applied for taxi cars, Autorickshaws and freight transport.

Non-Mechanised road transport & water transport unorganised:

Estimates are based on the results of the 29th national sample survey. The report provides data on value Mixed income of the self employed added for non-mechanised transport and also for components of factor income. is obtained as a residual from independent estimate of net value added.

In the case of warehousing in the private sector the factor incomes are obtained by using the proportions of compensation of employees, rent and interest as observed in the case of public warehousing corporations. The component of mixed income of self employed is obtained as a residual using the estimates of net value added.

Shipping companies:

Estimates of S.D.P. is supplied by C.S.O. since, the data on the components of factor income for the sector are not available, the net value added is distributed using the proportions of compensation of employees, rent and interest as observed in the case of Cochin port trust.

Air transport:

Since no data are available for the sector, the net value added from the sector is distributed in proportion to the factor income of the public organised sector.

Trade Hotel and Restaurants

The sector is divided into organised and unorganised. For the organised sector, the factor incomes are estimated on the basis of the details available from the annual accounts of non-departmental enterprises in this sector.

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For the unorganised activities estimates are based on the 34th round NSS report.

Real Estate, Ownership of Dwellings & Business Service

Real estate:—Components are estimated using the results of the analysis of profit and loss statement of the real estate companies.

Ownership of dwelling.—The activities covered under this sector is considered to be unorganised in nature. Total net product in respect of ownership of dwelling is treated as factor income in the form of rent.

Business service.—More or less same methods as for the other services is adopted.

Public Administration and defence

The net value added of this sector comprise compensation of employees only and as no data on rent is available, it is treated as nil. The estimates are obtained from annual budget documents and relevant administration reports of public authorities.

Other services

The estimates of factor incomes are prepared separately for education, medical and health services, Sanitary service and the rest. For the organised part of the education, medical and health services net value added consists of compensation to employees only.

For the unorganised activities the source for estimating factor income is the 29th N.S.S. (Report and report No. 130, Table with notes on professions and Liberal Arts, 18th Round 1963-64).

The N.S.S. Report provides data on value added, compensation of employees, interest and rent. The proportion is applied to net value added. The component of mixed income of the self employed is obtained residual.

Factor Income—An analysis

The table (1) present distribution of net domestic product by factor incomes. Compensation of employees accounts for about 43% of the total income. The share of mixed income of the self employed is accounted for about 40%. Profit is only 6% where as rent and interest accounts for about 5% and 6% respectively.


