Preface



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Preface

Construction and trading are important economic activities of the State. "Wage Structure Survey" is conducted quinquennially with the objective to study the trend in wage rates of the skilled and unskilled workers in unorganized construction sector and paid employees in trade and commerce sector over the years. The sampling technique used for the survey is multistage stratified random sampling method in which urban and rural sectors are treated as separate strata. The stratification being done with districts as first strata, corporation/ municipalities in the urban area and Panchayath in the rural area as the second strata, wards in the urban area and construction units and shops in the rural area as the third strata, and construction units and shops in the urban area as the fourth strata in each district. 19 units in construction sector and 140 shops in trade and commerce sector are covered in the survey. The data is collected for each quarter of the year.

The present report is an analysis of wage structure data collected during 1997-2002. The report gives a good analysis of wage rates in the concerned sectors with pictorial representation of the data. I hope that this publication would be of great use to data users and researchers in this field.

Report on Wage Structure Survey 1997-2002

Introduction

The wage structure survey was initiated by the Department of Economics and Statistics in 1963-64 is continued on a quinquennial basis. The main objectives of the survey are to study the trend in the wage rates of workers – both skilled and unskilled in the construction sector and the paid employees in the trade and commerce sector on a regular basis.

Wage structure is collected using a sample survey methodology stratified sampling technique is followed in the conduct of the survey with district as the strata. The Corporation/Municipalities selected in the urban area and Panchayats in the rural areas are the 1st stage-sampling units. The construction units and shops selected from urban and rural area formed the ultimate sampling units for the survey. The 1st stage-sampling units are selected in the Directorate. The wards and ultimate sampling units are selected in district offices. For the survey 1997-2002 all district head quarters and one municipality in each district were selected for urban area. For Idukki district Thodupuzha is selected 3 Panchayath from each district have been selected for rural area. As regards construction sectors 5 construction units in each Municipality/Corporation and 3 unit each in Panchayath were selected for the survey. Wages of labourers both skilled and unskilled were collected from 19 units in each district and average wages for urban and rural areas are separately worked out. As regards Trade and Commerce sector the entire shopping activities wholesale and retail are covered in the survey. According to NIC classification wholesale trade has been categorized into 5 group (60-64) and retail shops to 5 groups (65-69). Two shops are selected for each category for each Municipality/Corporation/Panchayath. Thus 80 shops are selected from urban area in each district and 60 shops from rural area. The wages of the employers are collected on quarterly basis from these shops. The paid employees are classified as shop assistant and shop attender and average wages are worked out – Details of the type of trading activities classified according to NIC code is given below:

Details of wages of skilled and unskilled workers in construction sector and wages of paid employees in trade and commerce sector for the period from 1.4.1997 to 31.3.2002 are included in this report.

Analysis

An attempt is made in the following paragraph to analyse the trend in rural and urban wage rates in respect of various types of workers engaged in construction and trading activities.




Table 1 gives wage trend of skilled workers in construction sector for more than two decades starting from 1975-76. Wage rate of Carpenters, Masons, Painters, Seaways, Plumbers, and Electrician showed a steady increasing trend during last two decades in Kerala. It is seen that wage rate of carpenters, masons, painters and plumbers showed 13 fold increase and that of saves 14 times and that of Electrician 11 fold when compared to wage rate of these category of skilled workers in 1975-76.

The following graphs (graphs 1 to 3) depict the daily wages of Carpenters, Masons, and Painters during the survey period.


Graph-1

Wage rate of all category of skilled workers showed an increase (of 25% or more when compared to the position in 1997-98 the beginning of the study period. Wage rate increase for different category of skilled workers during the period 1997-98 to 2001-2002 is as follows:

Wage rate of Masons and Carpenters continued to remain closely and the rural urban variation was also found not significant towards the end of the survey period ie. 2000-2001 & 2001-2002. Wage rate of painters was found to be same in rural and urban areas since 2000. Wage rate of sawyers in rural area stood high in 2002 when compared to the wage of their urban counterparts. The percentage increase in wage rate of skilled workers in rural and urban areas is represented pictorially in graph-4.

Percentage increase in Wage Rate




Table 2 gives the wage trend of unskilled workers in construction sectors for more than two decades commencing from 1975-76. Wage rate of unskilled workers showed an increase of more than 15 times during

last 2 decades. Increase in wage rate of men and women construction labors in rural and urban areas during the period from 1997-98 to 2001-02 is as follows.

Distribution of men workers




