




P R E F A C E

In April - May 1986, The Department of Economics and Statistics conducted a Statewide census of Private Medical Institutions in Kerala. The data collection work of this enquiry was done jointly by the field

staff of the Department of Economics and Statistics and the Department of Municipalities. The tabulated results of this enquiry are given in this report.

From the data collected, a Directory of Private Medical Institutions in the State has also been prepared. It is hoped that the data thrown out by this enquiry will fill a major gap in the Health Statistics of the state.



It is often quoted that the health standards in Kerala are comparable to those available in some of the developed countries. Eventhough this may be slightly exaggerated, no one will dispute the fact that they are the highest available in India. The crude death rate in the State is only 6.7 per 1000 population as against 11.9 for all India. A special feature of this low level of mortality is the very low rate of infant death. The infant mortality rate in 1983 was 33 per 1000 live births, which is one of the lowest compared to even some of the most developed countries in the world. Because of the low level of mortality, the life expectancy in the State is fairly high. The expectation of life at birth is estimated as 68.77 years in 1983, with 66.02 years for males and 71.78 years for females. The high level of literacy and the clean health habits of the people play a key role in the attainment of good health standards. Equally important are the efforts made by Government in establishing a sound health infrastructure capable of delivering health care even to the remotest rural centres and to people at all socio-economic levels. Annually Government spends about Rs.90 crores on health care. There are now 1953 medical institutions in the state run by Government, with a bed strength of 38133. Except in seven or eight panchayats, there is one Government medical institution in every panchayat allopathic, ayurvedic or homoeopathic.

Side by side with the Government sector, the private sector also play a significant role in providing health care especially in the area of curative medicine. Kerala is famous for its Ayurvedic system of treatment even from ancient times. In recent years, there has been an increasing interest in this system of treatment for certain types of diseases. In the field of allopathy, commendable service has been rendered by the medical institutions run by missonaries in providing health care to the needy and weaker sections in remote areas. In the last two or three decades, however, there has been a proliferation of private medical institutions in the state, and there are allegations of large scale exploitation of patients and service personnel by their managements. Most of these institutions are said to cater only to the wealthy. The rapid growth of the private sector has

thus created an imbalance in the total health care system of the State. At present, Government do not have any effective control on the private medical institution. Even basic information on the number of such institutions their location, type of services provided etc. are not available to Government. As a first step in this direction, it was decided to conduct a quick census of private medical institutions in the state to collect basic data which can be used for further enquiries on the working of these institutions.

2. Objects of the enquiry:-

The main object of the census was to find out the number of private medical institutions in the State under various systems of medicine, the number of medical and para medical staff employed in them and the type of facilities available. Further, the enquiry would provide data for the preparation of a block/townwise directory of private medical institutions in the state.

3. Concepts and definitions used

(i) Medical Institutions:-


An institution where patients are examined for diagnosis of diseases and medical treatment prescribed and provided. Places/institutions where only consultation facility is available such as consulting rooms and institution engaged only in selling medicine were not treated as medical institutions.

(ii) Private medical institution:-

A medical institution run by individual (s) or an organisation (e.g. Trust, Co-operative Society, Companies etc.) other than Government. Institutions receiving Government grants were treated as private institutions.

(iii) System of medicine:-

This refers to the system of medical treatment followed in the institution viz. Allopathy, Ayurveda, Homeo, Naturopathy, Siddha etc. If more than one system of medicine is being followed in an institution, the institution was classified by the most important one (as reported by the owner).



(iv) Doctor:-

Any person in the institution authorised to do diagnosis of illness, prescribe medicines, carryout surgery etc. was considered as a doctor for the purpose of this enquiry. He may be paid or unpaid, and may work full time or part time. No attempt was made to verify whether he has the prescribed qualification or possessed valid registration.

(v) Para medical staff:-

These included Nurses, Midwives, lab technician, Compounders, multi purpose health workers and the like, but excluded ministerial employees and watch and ward staff.

4. Coverage:-

The census covered all private medical Institutions in the State as existed on 1-4-1986.

5. Method of data collection and processing

In the rural areas (ie. C.D.Blocks) the data were collected and compiled by the Junior Statistical Inspectors of the Department working in C.D.Blocks. In the urban areas, the data collection work was done by the Health Assistants of the Department of Municipalities, while the compilation was done by the statistical Inspectors of the Department of Economics & Statistics. The Deputy Director/District Officer of the Directorate of Economics and Statistics organised and carried out the census work at the district level. At the state level, the co-ordination and direction was done by an Additional Director. State level tabulation and preparation of Directory was done by the headquarters staff.

Before the commencement of the survey, the investigators prepared a list of private medical institutions in each ward under their jurisdiction by local enquiry. With this list they visited the institutions one by one to confirm that the institution listed was a private medical institution as per definition. During the course of this work additions and/or alterations in the list were made through further local enquiries. The particulars relating to each institution were gathered from the institution itself, but no attempt was made to check its accuracy either by physical verification or by inspecting the records.

6. Main findings of the census


i) As on 1-4-1986, there were 9663 private medical institutions in the State with 12743 doctors. Of these, 2040 medical institutions had inpatient facilities and had a total bed strength of 50766.

ii) The distribution of these institutions according to the system of medicine is given below.

(iii) Only 1612 private medical institutions had laboratory facilities. Most of these are allopathic institutions as seen from the following table.

(iv) The enquiry shows that 12743 doctors and 15221 paramedical staff work in the private medical institution, majority of them being in the allopathic institutions.

(v) Inspite of the existence of such a large number of medical institution, only 385 provided family planning facilities. Of these 212 institutions have obtained Government approval for providing the facility.

(vi) Some of the medical institutions provided training to paramedical personnel. The enquiry showed that 103 institutions have training facility for nursing, 48 institutions have training facility for laboratory technicians & 13 institutions have training facility for health workers.

7. Detailed tables

District wise tables showing the number of private medical institution, number of beds, number of doctors, facilities available etc. are given in tables I to VI.

8. Block/Town level Abstract

A Primary block and town level abstract of medical institutions classified by the system of medicine followed is given as appendix to this report.

9. Directory of private medical institutions

The department has prepared a Directory of private medical institutions which can be used for further studies of this important sector. The Directory is available for reference in the district offices of the Department and in the Directorate.

IN KERALA


