#### **PREFACE**

Being the Nodal Agency for the collection, compilation and dissemination of price statistics in the state, Economics and Statistics Department is collecting various types of prices from various centers in the district. Price data prepared by the department is used by various central and state government departments and agencies such as Civil Supplies Department, Forest Department, Reserve Bank of India, Spices Board, Supply co, KSEB etc.

Staff in the district offices collect Retail prices of 50 essential commodities and 28 additional items from each district headquarters and forward to directorate by online. Prices of fruits and vegetables and 20 other items are also collected weekly from district headquarters. Analysis of prices thus collected are being done at directorate and daily and weekly reports are sent to the offices of Chief Minister, Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary etc.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations. These prices are being collected from the market by the Price collectors and supervised by district level Officers

This publication, "PRICE BULLETIN NOVEMBER 2023" is being prepared and published by Prices Division in the Directorate. I appreciate the work done by Sri. Rajendran Nair S. (Assistant Director), Smt. Shamju B.K. (Research Officer), Sri. Syam S. (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) under the guidance of Sri. Vinodan T. P., Additional Director (Prices) for bringing out such a publication.

#### **REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES**

#### November- 2023

#### **INTRODUCTION**

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of November 2023. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of November of the previous year 2022, previous month October 2023 and current month of November 2023 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year are included in this report. Group Wise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

#### 1. RICE

#### Comparison of State Average Retail Price of different varieties of Rice

During the month a marginal decreasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month but a mixed trend was observed when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.


The State Average Retail Price of Red-Matta and Andhra-Vella decreased by 0.4% and 0.35% respectively, but there was no change in the price of Red - Chamba when compared with the prices of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of Red- Chamba and Red- Matta increased by 7.78% and 1.96% respectively while notable decrease was seen in the price of Andhra-Vella (4.03%).

#### **Comparison of State Average Retail Price of Pulses**

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month notable increase was seen in the price of Red Gram (6.64%), Peas Dhall (4.92%), Black Gram split with husk (4.03%), Green gram (2.56%), Black Gram split without husk (2.44%), Dhall (Tur) (2.27%), Bengal Gram Bold (1.84%) and Bengal Gram small (1.76%), but all other items have only marginal variations.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of pulses showed an increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Dhall (Tur) (40.76%), Green gram (27.13%), Red Gram (25.55%), Bengal Gram Bold (22.51%), Black Gram split without husk (15.04%), Black Gram split with husk (14.7%), Green Gram Dhall (14.09%), Bengal Gram small (13.79%) and Peas Dhall (12.87%).



#### 3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

#### Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Other Food items.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Other Food items when compared with the prices of the previous month and showed an increasing trend when compared with the price of corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month notable increase was seen in Egg Hen's (White lagon) (2.91%) and Coffee Powder (Brook Bond Gr. Label) (1.06%) while notable decrease was seen only in the price of Baby Food Amul (5.96%), but all other items have only marginal variations when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of Other Food items showed an increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coffee Powder (Brook Bond Gr. Label) (18.64%), Milk (Cow's) (13.35%), Sugar (O.M) (6.45%), Egg Hen's (White lagon) (6.18%), Mutton without bones (3.95%) and Baby Food Amul (1.35%).

#### 4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

#### Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Oil and Oilseeds.

During the month a mixed trend was seen in the State Average Retail Price of Oil and Oil seeds when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.


When compared with the prices of previous month a mixed trend was observed. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coconut without husk (13.21%) and Coconut oil (2.83%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Gingelly oil (1.11%).

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of Oil and Oil seeds also showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coconut without husk (16.92%) and Coconut oil (1%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Refined oil (Postman) (27.38%) and Gingelly oil (5.42%).

#### 5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

#### Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Spices and Condiments.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

Notable increase was seen in the price of Garlic (17.19%) and Turmeric (2.99%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coriander (3.51%), Onion small (2.5%), Cumin seed (1.52%) and Mustard (1.08%) but all other items have only marginal variations when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Price of Spices and Condiments showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Garlic (159.07%), Cumin seed (117.66%), Turmeric (9.07%) and Onion small (6.6%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coriander (26.5%), Chillies dry (13.99%), Mustard (3.24%) and Methy (1.03%).

#### 6. TUBERS

#### **Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Tubers**

During the month a decreasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month and showed a mixed trend when compared with the price of corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the price of the previous month, the State Average Retail Price of Chenai and Tapioca Raw decreased by 1.8% and 1.06% respectively but all other items have only marginal variations when compared with the prices of the previous month.


Mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the prices of Chenai (66.89%) and Colocassia (7.9%) while Tapioca Raw and Potato were decreased by 17.19% and 5.26% respectively.

#### 7. VEGETABLES

#### **Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Vegetables.**

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of vegetables when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the State Average Retail Prices of vegetables showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (98.82%), Snake gourd (17.3%), Ladies Finger (9.5%) and Cucumber (6.73%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Brinjal (8.72%), Onion big (6.11%), Chilies green (3.06%), Ash gourd (1.83%), and Cabbage (1.58%), but all other items have only marginal variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Prices of vegetables showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (112.43%), Onion big (87.34%), Cucumber (37.15%), Snake gourd (31.08%), Ladies Finger (29.6%), Bitter gourd (3.67%) and Brinjal (2.75%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Cabbage (12.8%), Banana green (11.57%), Pumpkin (10.07%), Ash gourd (10.02%), Chilies green (9.65%) and Plantain green (5.59%).

#### 8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

#### Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of miscellaneous items

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of this group when compared with the prices of the previous month and an increasing trend when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month a mixed trend was observed. Notable increase was seen in the price of Cement-Sanker (Old Paper Bag) (1.66%) only but all the remaining items in this group showed only marginal variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of this group showed an increasing trend except Cement-Sanker (Old Paper Bag) (8.64%). Notable increase was seen in the price of Torch Battery (Eveready) (15.59%), Washing Soda (10.49%), Paper (10.34%), Tooth paste(Colgate) (7.84%), Crocin (5.69%), Tobacco (5.11%), Electric Bulb (Philips) (5.03%), Razor Blade (Topaz) (4.97%), Mundu (Mull) (2.55%) and Toilet Soap Lux (1.21%).
