# DISTRICT STATISTICAL HAND BOOK, 1971

## DISTRICT—ERNAKULAM

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## ERNAKULAM DISTRICT

The District is known after the name of its headquarters town of Ernakulam. There are a number of popular stories about the origin of this name. One story is that the name is a corrupt form of the name of a tank called "Rishinagakulam" around which this town grew. This tank was used by one Devalan, a Nagarshi to worship and propitiate Lord Siva to attain Moksha. A more probable story is that the name is derived from the words "Irainarkulam" (Place of Lord Siva). Ernakulam was also known as "Panchabjapuram" (city of the five lotus flowers). The inscriptions on the Deepastambam and metal vessels of the Thirumala Devasom bear testimony to this.

Ernakulam district is located between latitudes  $9^{\circ} 42' 30''$  and  $10^{\circ} 18' 00''$  N. and longitudes  $76^{\circ} 9' 30''$  and  $77^{\circ} 2' 00''$  E. It is bounded on the north by Trichur District, on the east by Kottayam district on the south by Kottayam and Alleppey districts. The Arabian Sea lies all along the western boundary. It is 78 k. m. across along east to west and 52 k. m. across along north to south at the farthest points. The area of the district is 3271 Sq.k.m; This area is distributed among the Taluks as follows:

This district was formed in 1958 (1st April), portions of the old Trichur and also Kottayam districts were pieced together to form the new district. The taluks thus separated out from Trichur were Alwaye, Parur, Kunnathunad, Kanayannur and Cochin and those from Kottayam were Muvattupuzha and Thodupuzha.

There are two administrative subdivisions, one for the eastern portions with its headquarters at Muvattupuzha and the other at Fort Cochin. There are seven taluks each again divided into furkas and villages

The District may be divided into three well defined natural divisions commonly found in the State namely, the high land, midland and the low land. The high lands occur to the east and consists of a section of the western ghats, with an altitude of more than 1000'. To the west of this hilly high altitude regions stretches in gentler slope the plains dotted with home steads. The backwaters occur along the fringes of this plain to the west.

Between the backwaters and the sea is a narrow long stretch of sandy area. It is low and is generally swampy. During the monsoon this area is liable to be flooded. The sea coast is 50 k.m. long.

Periyar and Muvattupuzha are the important rivers of this District. Periyar flows through all the taluks of the district except Cochin.

Peyriar is the second longest river in the State. It is 142 miles long. The river is navigable upto Malayattur and even upto Boothathankettu during the hot seasons.

Muvattupuzha river is formed by the confluence of the rivers namely, Kaliar and Kothamangalam. It is 75 miles long.

There are mainly 3 canals in the district. One is 7 miles long and flows between Cheranallur and Edapally. Another is 8 k.m. long and form the boundary between Elamkulam and Ernakulam.

A portion of the Vembanad lake falls within Cochin Taluk and is used for navigation and fishing. Two other backwaters are the Kodungalloor Kayal and Verapuzha Kayal.

The main crops occurring in the high lands are Teak plantations and Rubber. Fodder grass and essential oil yielding grasses, Bamboos and Cardamom are also grown here.

Coconut is the main perennial crop in the midland. Paddy, plantain, tapioca, sugarcane, pepper, pulses, etc. are the other main crops. In the low land region, coconut plantations are grown.

The average annual rain fall is around 3400 m.m. Rainfall increases from the coast towards the interior. Rains are brought both by the south west monsoon and north east monsoons. Nearly 80% of the rain occur during the south west monsoon period from June to September. June and July are the Rainiest month accounting for about 45% of the annual rainfall. The variation in rainfall from year to year is not large. On an average there are about 140 rainy days in the year.

The hot season begins from February, March and April are the hottest months. During this period, the average daily temperature (maximum) is around 31°C., and the minimum temperature is about 26°C. in the coastal region which increase slightly towards the interior. During the Southwest

monsoon period from May to September the temperature is lower. During the post monsoon periods including the North east monsoon periods, the heat is as hot as in summer.

The atmosphere is humid throughout the year, the relative humidity being generally over 70%. Towards the interior, this is slightly less.

The population of the district is 23.83 lakhs according to the 1971 census. The density of population is 729 persons per sq. k.m. Compared to 549 for the State. The densest taluk is Cochin with 2818 persons per s. q. k. m. Kanayaanur and Parur follows behind with only 1546 and 1467 respectively. The densities in the other taluks are far less, the lowest being in Thodupuzha Taluk with only 237 persons per s. q. k.m.

Males out number females in this district. There are only 983 females per 1000 Males. This phenomenon is noticed in all the taluks except in Paru where near parity in numbers is noticed between the sexes. In Thodupuzha taluk there are only 939 female for 1000 males. In rural areas, the number of females is 994 per 1000 males, but in the urban area it is only 955.

The population of the district increased by 27.70% during the decade ending with 1971. This is in all time high for the last 7 decades, the nearest increase to this being for the decade ending with 1931 (26.63%).

About 72% of the population live in rural areas and only about 28% are town dwellers. The largest percentage of urban population is found in Cochin and the smallest in Kunnathunad Taluk.

The largest and most populous city is Cochin Corporation.

Nearly 46% of the population are Hindus followed by X'ian with about 42%. 12% are Muslims. There are Buddhist, Jains and Sikhs in the population but they are small in numbers. About 8% of the population are Scheduled Caste. They are distributed all over the district. The population of Scheduled Tribes is only 11648 of which more than 90% are found in Thodupuzha Taluk.

The literacy percentage is 65 according to the 1971 census against a state average of 60. The percentage increase for the decade ending with 1971 was 15%. This compares favourably with that for the State.

There were 1018 institutions for school educations and 34 for professional educations during 70-71 with 274717 students. The number of Colleges for higher education was 24. This includes two for teachers training each for engineering, Law Ayurveda, and Homoeo medicine. 26531 students were studying in these institutions during the period. This include 306 students studying in the various University Teaching Departments.

The number of Government Hospitals (modern medicine) was 18 and the number of dispensaries 54 (including primary health centres) during 70-71. 86 other institutions were also functioning during the period. There were 2320 beds provided for in-patients. 1.50 lakhs in-patients were treated. The number of out-patients treated was 32.34 lakhs.

There were 8 Government Ayurveda hospitals functioning in 70-71 with a bed strength of 104. There were also 28 Government dispensaries and 27 other institutions.

The District is served by a good system of roads. The railways pass along the western portions of the district. The water ways are also confined to these portions. The district is connected by air through the air port at Cochin. The Cochin port is situated at Ernakulam in this District. It is one of the most important ports on the western coast of India.

Before the advent of wheeled traffic, inland traffic was almost exclusively carried out by means of back waters and rivers. During the period from 1840-1879 this system of inland water transport was much improved.

The district has a net work of roads and village roads. In 1967-68, the total length of roads in the district was 2948 k. m. (excluding road maintained by Panchayats & K. S. E. Board).

There were 581 buses registered in the district during 1970-71, the number of registered taxi cars was 1657 and private cars 6168. 2231 goods vehicles (lorries) were also registered during the period.

The state road transport Department operated 127 routes during 1970-71 covering a distance of 6297 k. m. The role of private transport is even more important.

There was 41 kms. of broad gauge lines and 29 k. ms of metre gauge lines in the district. The broad gauge portions forms the Cochin Shornur line and the metre gauge line of the Ernakulam Quilon line. The former line was opened in 1902 and the latter in 1956.

A large portion of the area is under forest (18%). However it is much below the State figure. The net area sown was 2.19 lakhs hect. which is nearly 69% of the area. The area sown more than once in 70-71 was 58365 Hect. bringing the total cropped area to 2.77 lakh hect.

Paddy was grown in 93691 hectares producing 1.29 lakhs tons of rice in 1970-71. Tapioca was grown in 14500 hect. producing 2.23 lakh tons of tubers. The most important perennial crop is coconut. It was cultivated in 64687 hect. in 1970-71 and the production was 379 M. nuts. Pepper, ginger and cardamom were cultivated in 7940, 1159 and 1042 hect. respectively. Betel nuts was grown in 9223 hect., cashew in 6618 hect. and Mangoes in 5914 hect. Rubber is the most important plantation crop in the district covering an area of 26459 hect in 1970-71. Coffee & tea are only sparingly grown in this District.

The total livestock population was 5.06 lakhs in 1966. The corresponding figure for 61 was 5.16 lakhs. The poultry population increased to 1.31 lakhs in 1966 from 1.25 lakhs in 1961.

The number of veterinary institution in the district was 33 during 1969-70 including 9 hospitals. 1.32 lakhs animals were treated in these institutions.

There were 423 factories registered in the District oil mills, saw mills, printing and binding factories metal industries etc., lead in numbers. A number of large industrial concerns are located in this region. The fertilisers & chemicals the premier tyres, the shipyard at Cochin, Hindustan Machine tools, oil refinery, Travancore Cochin chemicals, Indian aluminium Company, Tata oil mills, Travancore Rayons, Indian Rare Earths Glass Factory, Hindustan Insecticides etc. are among them. In fact the most important industrial belt of the state is located in Ernakulam. Alwaye Kalamassery belt in this District. The average daily number of workers engaged is about 26585.

The plantation industry especially rubber plantations is an important one. The average daily number of persons employed in the plantation industry is 0.14 lakhs in 1969-70.

The power requirements of the District are at present met from peringalkuthu and Sengulam Hydro Electric Projects. Alwaye is the most power Consuming Centre. The Idukki hydro electric project, the biggest of its kind in the State lies in Ernakulam District. Designed for an installed capacity of 8 lakh K. W. with five generating sets, it will also provide Irrigation benefits to the area of 50000 hect. in Thodupuzha, Meenachil and Vaikom Taluks.

The number of Consumers of electricity is about 70000. Almost all the villages have been electrified. About 20000 street lights alone was provided in 1971.

There were 3 Banks registered in the District in 70-71 with a paid up capital of 12.02 lakh Rs. The number of Co-operative Societies (non industrial) was 530 with a membership of 2.72 lakhs. Ag. credit Societies led in numbers with 217 of them in 1969. There were 87 non ag. non credit Societies and 86 credit Societies. There were also 32 Coir Co-operative Societies, with a membership of 9161 in 1968-1969.

357 post offices were in position during 1970-1971. There were also 85 telegraph offices. The number of telephone exchanges was 27, the number of trunk call offices 14 and local call offices 100 providing facilities for 8422 telephone connections. The number of radio licenses issued was 40773 during the period.

The important towns in the district are the Cochin Corporation, the Alwaye Parur, Perumbavoor & Muvattupuzha Municipalities.

The Cochin Corporation is one of the three Corporations in the State. It comprises of the earlier three municipalities of Ernakulam, Mattancherry & Fort Cochin. The Cochin port is also located here.

Alwaye is a small municipality. A large industrial belt lies near this town. The Periyar flows by the side of this town. Perumbavoor, Parur and Muvattupuzha also are small towns which are the taluk Head quarters of Kunnathunad, Parur and Muvattupuzha taluks respectively.

## I. AREA, POPULATION AND HOUSING

This section mainly deals with the area, population and housing, their distribution and characteristics according to 1961 Census. Wherever possible the data from 1971 census have also been included. All the important aspects such as density of population, growth of population, sex ratio, religion, rural urban break up, population by age groups, distribution of households according to tenure, materials of roof, number of rooms material of wall etc. have been dealt with in this section.
