## PREFACE

This report presents the adjusted residential vital rates of births and deaths in Municipalities and Corporations in the State for the year 1984. The rates have been estimated from the registered births and deaths to the normal residents, after making adjustments for under registration and for the events occurring outside the Municipal/Corporation areas, using the results of spot check conducted in the Municipality/Corporation. 31 Municipalities and 3 Corporations are covered in the report. The report has been prepared by the Vital Statistics Unit of the Population Division of the Directorate of Economics and Statistics.

## **RESIDENTIAL VITAL RATES IN MUNICIPALITIES**

### **1. INTRODUCTION**

To complement the civil registration of vital events, the spot check survey was introduced in the State under the scheme "Strengthening of Statistical Units in Municipalities for improvement of Vital Statistics". This report contains the spot check survey results for the year 1984.

The Registration of Births and Deaths Act of 1969 and the Kerala Births and Deaths Registration Rules govern the registration of vital events in the State. Unregistered events invariably occur. All the events occurring inside the towns whether they pertain to normal residents or outsiders have to be registered at the places of occurrence of the events.

To avoid omissions in the registration of vital events, the municipal authorities are exhibiting notices to educate the public about the importance of births and deaths registration. Slides are also exhibited in cinema theatres. Show cause notices are issued to defaulters and action is taken as per provisions of the Births and Deaths Act by the Municipal/Corporation Commissioners.

### **2. SCHEME FOR IMPROVEMENT OF VITAL STATISTICS**

The spot check scheme was introduced in the Corporations and Municipalities to estimate the correct residential vital rates and to estimate the extent of under registration of vital events.

During the year 1984, 3 Corporations, 30 Municipalities and Guruvayoor Township were covered under the scheme. In the Corporations of Trivandrum, Cochin and Calicut, 15 wards each were selected, as sample, for the study. In the major municipalities of Quilon and Alleppey, 18 wards each were selected. All the wards in Guruvayoor Township and 15 wards each in all other municipalities were selected for spot check work by the statistical staff. The statistical staff assigned for the work, visited these selected wards periodically and collected data on vital events from each household. Vital events occurring to normal residents enumerated during the spot check are divided into three categories:—

- (i) Events occurring inside the town and registered.
- (ii) Events occurring inside the town and not registered.
- (iii) Events occurring outside the town registered or unregistered.

For the calculation of the percentage of under registration, the events occurring to persons coming into the town/city to avail themselves of better medical facilities are excluded.

For the calculation of residential vital rates of a town/city the vital events occurred to outsiders should be excluded from the total registered events. The registered rate to normal residents is weighted for under registration and further adjusted for events occurring outside the town to the normal residents.

In the corporations of Trivandrum, Cochin and Kozhikode and in the major municipalities of Quilon and Alleppey, the scheme for medical certification of causes of death has also been introduced to develop cause of death statistics.

### 3. GENERAL FINDINGS OF THE TOWNS/CITIES

Table I gives the area, mid-year population and density of population of the municipalities and corporations. The highest density of population in 1984 was for Quilon (7727 per Sq. km.) followed by Trivandrum (6800 per Sq. km.) and Trichur (6339 per Sq. km.).

Table II represents the number of hospitals and other institutions in the municipalities and corporations. The largest number of public hospitals is in Trivandrum (20) with 4300 beds. About half a dozen municipalities (namely Punalur, Shertallai, Kodungallur, Chalakudy, Kunnamkulam, Kasargode) and Guruvayoor Township have only one public hospital. The maximum number of dispensaries is in Alleppey (135) and the majority of which is in the private sector.

Table III shows the number of burial-grounds, cremation-grounds and civil registration units in the various municipalities and corporations. Here again, as in the case of health facilities, the private sector dominates.

Table IV compares the area and population with the registration units. Considering the 3 corporations, the highest number of registration units is in Calicut 14. In Trivandrum there are 13 registration units and in Cochin 2. The area per registration unit is highest in Cochin (4744 Sq. km.). The area per registration unit for Trivandrum and Calicut is 5.76 Sq. km. and 5.90 Sq. km. respectively. Of the Municipalities, in Alleppey and Trichur, there are 6 registration units and in Palghat 5. In all the other Municipalities the number of registration units is below 5. The area per registration unit is highest in Punalur (34.60 Sq. km.) and lowest in Trichur (2.10 Sq. km.).

Table V presents the town-wise details of the vital events registered during the year. The maximum number of live births that occurred to normal residents in 1984 was in Trivandrum (11035) and the lowest in Guruvayoor Township (43). The highest number of still births to normal residents occurred in 1984 as also in 1983 was in Calicut (1983-136), (1984-141). The maximum number of infant deaths in respect of normal residents in 1984 was again in Calicut (286), though

it had decreased from its previous level (396) in 1983. We find occurrences of maternal deaths in Kottayam (1), Chalakudy (2), Guruvayoor (1) and Calicut (6).

In Table VI the distribution of deaths according to causes is listed out. The maximum number of deaths that occurred in Trivandrum on account of varied causes is 6,427 and the most dreaded cause has been heartfailure, which claimed 368 lives in Trichur.

The details of vital events collected through spot check during the year 1984 are presented in Table VII. The number of live births enumerated is highest in Cochin Corporation (2302) and that registered is highest in Trivandrum (1749). During 1983, the largest number of live births enumerated (2363) and registered (2156) was in Trivandrum.

Table VIII presents under registration and occurrence of outside events. The highest percentage of under registration of births has been in Calicut (24.70 per cent) and of death in Trichur (43.48 per cent). During the previous year under registration of births was highest in Neyyattinkara (35.13) and of deaths in Cannanore (37.50). Cent per cent registration of births and deaths occurred in Kottayam and Muvattupuzha.

#### 4. ADJUSTED RESIDENTIAL VITAL RATES AND REGISTERED VITAL RATES 1984

Table IX presents the registered vital rates and adjusted residential vital rates. The registered birth rate is lowest in Guruvayoor township (2.31) and highest in Kasaragode (32.74). Regarding registered death rate, it is lowest in Cannanore (1.74) and highest in Chittoor-Thathamangalam (6.74). Turning to adjusted residential vital rate, the highest birth rates is for Kasargode (39.12) and lowest is for Tellicherry (7.35). During 1983, also, this rate was lowest in Tellicherry (9.61). The adjusted death rate is highest in Perumbavoor (8.95) and lowest in Malappuram (3.53). The method of calculation of adjusted residential vital rates is also given as appendix.

Table X presents the adjusted residential rates from 1980-84. In Trivandrum, the birth rate indicates a rise (that is from 20.15 in 1980 to 24.17 in 1984) over the 5 year span. This rate in Trivandrum has been alternately falling and rising. In Cochin too, a rise is witnessed (that is from 24.32 in 1980 to 26.41 in 1984). It has been steady around 25 for 3 years, from 1981 to 1983. In Calicut, over this 5 year period much variation did not occur. (30.80 in 1980 and 30.74 in 1984) but in 1983 it reached a high rate of 40.63. Over the years under comparison, the lowest birth rate continued to be 7.01 for Alwaye in 1981 and the highest (45.83) for Kodungallur in 1982. Reviewing death

rate for this period, in Trivandrum, it rose from 4.62 in 1980 to 5.52 in 1984, in Cochin it remained steady (7.21 in 1980 and 7.20 in 1984) and in Calicut it rose from 6.64 in 1980 to 8.87 in 1984.

### 5. CONCLUSION

In 1984 also, the implementation of the spot check scheme proved invaluable in highlighting the problem areas where under registration was high, as also in evolving birth and death statistics in the sample wards selected. The scheme also succeeded significantly in roping in unregistered events in the sample towns/cities.

## APPENDIX

### METHOD OF CALCULATION OF ADJUSTED RESIDENTIAL VITAL RATES

Residential Vital rates can broadly be defined as the rate of occurrence of vital events to the normal residents of an area in a year. The vital events occurring to Normal Residents enumerated during the spot-check are divided into three categories:—

- (i) events occurring inside the town and registered
- (ii) events occurring inside the town but not registered
- (iii) events occurring outside the town registered or unregistered.

For calculation of the percentage of under registration, the events occurring to persons coming into the town/city to avail themselves of better medical facilities are excluded and those of normal residents who are going outside the town are to be included.

I. Percentage of under registration	=	No. of events occurred to normal residents inside the town but not registered $\times 100$
II. Percentage of events occurred outside the town to normal residents	=	No. of events occurred to normal residents outside the town registered and unregistered $\times 100$
Total No. of events enumerated	=	Total No. of events enumerated and occurred to normal residents inside the town.

**III. Registered Birth/Death rate to NR.\*** = Total No. of Birth/Death occurred to N.R.  $\times 1000$

**IV. Residential Birth/Death rate to NR

**V. Final Residential Birth/Death rate  
(weighted for outside events)** = Residential Birth/Death rate to N.R.
