PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumerfed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division. I appreciate the work done by Sri.Damodaran.K,Additional Director (Prices). Sri.Suresh.U (Assistant Director), Smt.Naseera.M (Research Officer), Sri.Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisors in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

FEBRUARY - 2022

INTRODUCTION

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of January 2022. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of February of the previous year 2021, previous month January 2022 and current month of February 2022 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the current month of the previous year are included in this report. Group Wise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State average retail prices of Red Matta and Red Chamba decreased by 1.03% and 1.59% while that of White Andhra Vella increased by 0.13 % when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andhra Vella increased by 9.73% and 3.48% while that of Red Chamba decreased by 4.05%.

2. PULSES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.

During the month a downward trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month while a mixed trend was noticed in the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State average retail price of Pulses showed a decreasing trend when compared with the prices of the previous month. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Redgram(6.58%) and Bengal gram small(1.34%). While all other items showed a marginal variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of pulses showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Red gram (24.01%),Bengalgram Small(12.29%)and Bengalgram Bold(8.20%), while Notable decrease was seen in the price of Greengram (7.72%). Blackgram split with husk (5.03%), Blackgram split without husk(4.01)%

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Other food items when compared with the prices of the previous month but an increasing trend prevails when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State average retail price of Other food items showed a mixed trend when compared with the prices of the previous month. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Egg (Hens)White Lagon 3.69%. While all other items showed a marginal variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Other Food Items showed an upward trend except the price of Coffee powder (Brook bond Gr. Label). Notable increase was seen in the price of Baby food (Amul) 10.36%, Sugar(OM) 5.46% and mutton with Bones (5.24%), while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coffee powder (Brook bond Gr. Label) by 4.43%.

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

During the month a decreasing trend was observed for Oil and Oilseeds except for Groundnut Oil when compared with the prices of the previous month. However when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year a mixed trend was observed.

When compared with the prices of previous month, the State average retail prices of Oil and Oilseeds showed a down ward trend except the price of Groundnut Oil. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Coconut without husk (2.17%) and coconut oil (3.44%).


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Oil and Oilseeds showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Gingelly oil (14.90%), Refined Oil(5.32%) and Groundnut Oil (4.65%). while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coconut oil (20.45%) and Coconut without husk (18.24%).

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of Spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as with the corresponding month of the previous year.


The state average retail price of all items of Spices and Condiments showed a mixed trend when compared with the price of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coriander (6.72%), Garlic (6.59%), and Chillies dry (6.05%). While notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion Small(12.18%).

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of all items of Spices and Condiments showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coriander(30.91%)Mustard (22.48%), Chillies Dry (21.61%) and Methy (18.60%), while notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion small(46.13%) and Garlic (26.38%).

6. TUBERS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Tubers

During the month a decreasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Tubers except for Tapioca raw when compared with the prices of the previous month, however when compared with previous year an increasing trend was observed except the price of Potato.

When compared with the price of the previous month, the state average retail price of all items of Tubers showed a downward trend up to 6.50 % except Tapioca raw. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Potato (6.50%).


Increasing trend was observed in the retail prices of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year except the price of Potato. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coloccassia (13.91%) and tapioca (raw)(13.81%). The prices of Potato was decreased by 4.56%

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.

A general decreasing trend except for Banana green was observed in the State average retail price of vegetables when compared with the prices of the previous month. However a mixed trend was observed when compared with the previous year

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail prices of all items of vegetables except Banana green showed a downward trend up to 33.26%. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Tomato (33.26%), Ladies finger (31.16%), and Cabbage(28.14%)).while the price of banana green increased by 2.17%.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of all items of vegetables except Onion Big, Ladys finger and Cucumber, Snake guard and Tomato showed an upward trend up to 77.16%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Pumpkin (77.16%), Cabbage (69.30%), Chillies green(62.96%) and Banana green(50.43%), while notable decrease was seen in the price of Ladies finger (35.31%),Onion Big 27.26%),and cucumber(25.92%).



8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items

During the month only a marginal fluctuation was observed in the State average retail price of miscellaneous items except the price of cement when compared with the prices of the previous month but a mixed trend prevails when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail prices of miscellaneous items showed marginal variations. The price of Cement increased by 4.56%.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous Year, the state average retail price of all items except Firewood (Local split), and Mundu mull showed an upward trend up to 13.06 %. Notable increase was seen in the price of Toilet Soap -Lux(13.06%), and Crocin (12.40%), respectively.
