PREFACE

Price represents the monetary value assigned to a commodity or service at a particular time and location. Farm prices of agricultural produce are shaped by multiple interrelated factors that affect both the income security of farmers and the purchasing power of consumers. Gaining insight into these influences is essential for policymakers as well as stakeholders in the agricultural sector.

The Department of Economics and Statistics functions as the nodal agency for the systematic collection, compilation, and dissemination of price statistics in the state. The department records a wide range of prices, including farm wholesale and retail prices, market wholesale prices of agricultural commodities, and retail prices of essential goods. Moreover, the cost of crucial agricultural inputs such as seeds, fertilizers, labour, and fuel significantly affects production expenses. Variations in these costs inevitably bring about corresponding changes in farm prices to safeguard profitability.

The “**Report on Analysis of Farm Prices 2023**” presents an overview of farm wholesale and retail prices compiled on a fortnightly and monthly basis, respectively. This publication is the result of the dedicated efforts of the officers in the Price Division of the Directorate.

INTRODUCTION

FARM PRICES

Since 1954, the Department of Economics and Statistics has been collecting farm prices of major agricultural commodities cultivated in the state. These prices are broadly classified into Farm Wholesale Price and Farm Retail Price.

Farm Wholesale Price

The Farm Wholesale Price of a commodity refers to the average price received by farmers for bulk quantities of their produce at the village level or directly at the farm site. In certain cases, especially for perennial crops like coconut or arecanut, farmers may even sell the produce while it is still on the tree. To capture these prices accurately, the Department of Economics and Statistics collects data through Taluk Statistical Officers from all 77 revenue taluks across the state on a fortnightly basis. A total of 81 wholesale commodities with significant marketable surplus are selected for this purpose, ensuring comprehensive coverage of key agricultural products. This data plays a vital role in understanding farm-level price trends and supporting policy decisions related to the agricultural sector.

Farm Retail Price

In addition to Farm wholesale prices, the Department of Economics and Statistics also collects Farm Retail Prices, which represent the average prices farmers receive when selling their produce in smaller quantities, often directly to consumers or in local markets. These prices provide valuable insights into the earnings of farmers from small-scale sales. Farm Retail Price data for 63 selected agricultural items are collected by Taluk Statistical Officers from all 77 revenue taluks across the state. This data collection is carried out on the last working day of every month, ensuring consistency and reliability in tracking price trends at the farm retail level. The information gathered is crucial for assessing farm-level income, understanding rural market dynamics, and aiding in the formulation of supportive agricultural policies


Data Analysis-Major Crops-Farm Wholesale Price

Paddy Local Nadan (₹ /Quintal)

The price of **Paddy Local Nadan** showed notable fluctuations across the months. The highest price was recorded in June at ₹2481.25, while the lowest was in July at ₹2175.00. Prices remained relatively stable in the first quarter, peaking in February at ₹2369.50. A gradual decline followed until May, after which prices spiked in June. However, this was followed by a sharp drop in July. Prices recovered again in September, reaching ₹2423.33, before settling around ₹2246.36 by December. 


Paddy Local High yield-(₹ /Quintal)

In 2023, the price trend for **Paddy Local High yield** showed strong performance in the first half of the year, with prices peaking in April at ₹/2673.06, the highest of the year. From January to June, prices remained consistently above ₹/2549. However, there was a sharp decline in July (₹/2466.67) and a further drop to the lowest point in August (₹/2225.00), likely due to peak harvest and market saturation. Prices rebounded in September (₹/2620.38) and remained relatively stable through the year-end, closing at ₹/2534.78 in December. Overall, the year reflected a high-yield crop's typical price movement—strong early-year prices, a mid-year dip, and late-year stabilization. 


Comparison of Paddy Local Nadan and Paddy High yield (₹ /Quintal)

In 2023, Paddy Local Nadan and Paddy High yield showed distinct price trends, with the high yield variety consistently commanding higher prices throughout the year. Paddy High yield peaked in April at ₹2673.06, while Local Nadan reached a maximum of ₹2481.25 in June. Local Nadan prices were more volatile, with a sharper drop in July (₹2175.00) and lowest in August (₹2200.00). In comparison, Paddy High yield also dipped during this period but remained higher, bottoming out at ₹2225.00 in August. The price gap between the two remained significant, averaging around ₹300–₹400 per quintal.


Coconut (Medium)-without husk (Ripe)-(₹ /) 100 Nos

In 2023, the price of **Coconut (Medium)-without husk (Ripe)-100 Nos** showed a gradual downward trend during the first half of the year, starting at ₹1477.15 in January and reaching the lowest price of ₹1359.41 in July. From August onward, prices began to recover, rising consistently through the later months and peaking in December at ₹1531.22, the highest price of the year. Overall, the market experienced moderate fluctuations, with a clear rebound in the final quarter.


Coconut (Medium) Ripe (without husk) - (₹ /Quintal)

The price of Coconut (Medium) Ripe (without husk) – Quintal showed a gradual decline in the first half of the year, falling from ₹3039.00 in January to ₹2781.33 in June, The lowest price was recorded in June, but the market began to recover in the second half, with prices steadily climbing back up. By December, the price had reached ₹3098.33, the highest of the year.


Coconut (Medium) Ripe (with husk)- (₹ /)100 Nos.

The price analysis of Coconut (Medium) Ripe (with husk)-100 Nos from January 2023 to December 2023 shows a fluctuating trend. The prices started relatively high at 1,428.93 in January, gradually decreasing to a low of 1,318.10 by June. There was a slight recovery in the following months, with the price reaching 1,467.07 in December. Overall, prices saw a general decline mid-year before stabilizing in the later months.



The price trends for both without husk and husked coconuts exhibited significant seasonal fluctuations throughout 2023. Beginning the year at their highest levels (₹1,477 for without husk and ₹1,429 for husked in January), prices for both varieties gradually declined over the next six months, reaching their lowest points in July at ₹1,359 (without husk) and ₹1,321 (husked), representing a 7-8% decrease from January prices. This downward trend reversed in August, initiating a steady five-month recovery that peaked in December at ₹1,531 (without husk) and ₹1,467 (husked) - an impressive 12-11% increase from the July lows.


Arecanut Ripe -(100 Nos)

In 2023, the price of **Arecanut Ripe (100 Nos)** showed a generally upward trend in the first eight months, starting at ₹242.37 in January and peaking at ₹305.43 in August. The sharpest rise occurred between June and August. However, from September onwards, prices began to decline gradually, ending at ₹245.40 in December, close to the year's opening rate.


Arecanut Chamban- ₹ / (100 Nos)

The price of Arecanut Chamban (100 Nos) in 2023 showed significant fluctuations with limited data points. It started at ₹125.43 in January, dropped to a low of ₹102.00 in February, and then sharply increased to ₹165.00 in March. Prices ranged between ₹135.00 in August and ₹140.00 in September before dropping sharply to ₹84.79 in October. By December, the price recovered slightly to ₹100.00.




Comparison of Arecanut Ripe 100 No.s and Arecanut Chamban ₹ /100Nos.

In 2023, the **Arecanut Ripe (100 Nos)** showed a steady upward price trend during the first eight months, rising from ₹242.37 in January to a peak of ₹305.43 in August. Prices slightly declined afterward, closing the year at ₹245.40 in December, maintaining stability near the year's starting point. In contrast, **Arecanut Chamban (with husk – 100 Nos)** experienced more volatile and inconsistent pricing. Starting at ₹125.43 in January, the price dropped to ₹102.00 in February, surged to ₹165.00 in March, and then showed scattered data for the middle months. By November, the price hit a low of ₹84.79, before a minor recovery to ₹100.00 in December. Overall, Arecanut Ripe was more stable and consistently priced higher.


Groundnut with Husk- (₹ /Quintal)


Cashew nut Ripe (with husk) -(₹ /Quintal)

In 2023, the price of Cashew **Nut Ripe (with husk)** showed a clear downward trend in the first half of the year. Starting at ₹10,000 in January, prices gradually declined to ₹9244.74 by April. The drop became sharper in May, falling to ₹7360, before a slight recovery to ₹7530 in June. Overall, the market experienced a significant price decline in the first six months.




Comparison of Tapioca raw, Tapioca dry and Tapioca dried and boiled. (₹ /Quintal)




Comparison of Turmeric Raw and Dry-(₹ /kg)
