PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumerfed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division. I appreciate the work done by Sri.Damodaran.K, Additional Director (Prices). Sri. Sivalal. S (Assistant Director) Sri. Sooraj Cheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisors in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

JANUARY-2021

INTRODUCTION

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of January 2021. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of January of the previous year 2020, previous month December 2020 and current month of January 2021 are attached and the percentage of variation over the previous month and the current month of the previous year are attached. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice

The downward trend continued in the state average retail price of Rice varieties except Red Champa when compared with the prices of the previous month, as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andhra Vella decreased by 0.62 %, 0.50% respectively, while that of Red Chamba remains unchanged when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andra Vella decreased by 10.12 % and 4.89 %, while that of Red Chamba increased marginally.

2. PULSES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.

During the month a decreasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month, while a mixed trend was observed in the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State average retail price of all items of Pulses except Peas Dhal showed a decreasing trend up to 3.43% when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of all items of pulses except Red gram, Blackgram split without husk and Bengalgram small, showed an upward trend up to 14.52 %. Notable increase was seen in the price of Peas dhal (14.52 %), Dhal Tur(14.17 %), Greengram (10.82 %), Greengram dhal (9.69 %). Blackgram split with husk (7.87 %), when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Other food items when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with previous month the prices of Egg (White Lagoon) decreased by 4.10% while all the remaining item in this group showed a marginal variation.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Mutton with bones increased by 10.20% while, the prices of all other items showed a marginal variations of below 3%.

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State average retail price of Oil and oilseeds except the prices of Gingelly Oil and Coconut without Husk when compared with the price of the previous month,

The State average retail price of all items of Oil and Oil seeds showed a incresing trend up to 5.72% when compared with the prices of the previous month except Gingelly Oil and Coconut without Husk. After a gap of a few months the prices of Coconut without Husk decreased marginally.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Refined Oil, Coconut Oil, Coconut without husk, and Groundnut Oil increased by 28.76 %, 19.74 %, 15.76 % and 10.83 % respectively while the price of Gingelly oil Decreased by 8.62%, when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:

Mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as with the corresponding month of the previous year.

The price of Onion Small decreased by 6.05% and Garlic 3.90 %, and Chillies Dry by 2.09% while the prices of Mustard increased 2.08% when compared with the price of the previous month. All the remaining showed a slight variations.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, Notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion Small (35.68%, Garlic(31.66%), Chillies Dry(16.31%) while notable increase was seen in the price of Tamarind without seed Loose (12.46 %), Mustard(8.41 %), and Methy (5.70%),



6. TUBERS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Tubers

During the month a decreasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the Corresponding month of the previous year.

The prices of Potato, Coloccassia, Tapioca raw and Elephant Yam, decreased 23.16 %, 5.56%, 5.03 % and 4.98 % respectively when compared with the prices of the previous month.


Decreasing trend was observed in the retail prices of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Tapioca raw (18.59 %) and Coloccassia (17.77 %)

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.

A mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of vegetables when compared with that of the previous month, as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.


When compared with the prices of the previous month. Of these, the prices of Ladies finger and Cucumber increased significantly by about 56% and 26% respectively. Other Items that have gone up in prices are Snake gourd (10.25%), and Ash gourd (5.12%). During the month inexpensive varieties in Vegetables are Tomato (6.16%), Cabbage (6.07%), and Pumpkin (4.46%)

When compared with the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion Big (31.08%), Banana Green (27.73 %), Ash guard (23.85 %), Plantain (20.95%) Pumpkin (16.63 %,) Tomato (11.87%) when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items

Only a slight variation in the prices of all items except Cement (Sankar) during the month in the State average retail price of miscellaneous items when compared with that of the previous month, while an increasing trend was observed when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

The state average retail prices of Cement (Sankar) decreased 3.36%. There was slight variation or stability in the price of all other items when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month Notable increase was seen in the price of Torch Battery (Eveready)(14.24 %), Tobacco(14.14%), Crocin(14%), Cement Sankar(10.74 %) and Washing Soda(8.49%) when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.
