#### **PREFACE**

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, ChiefSecretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumerfed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division. I appreciate the work done by Sri.P.D.Santhosh Kumar, Additional Director (State Income). Smt.Haleema Beegam (Joint Director), Sri.RajendranKuttikadu (Assistant Director), Smt.Sarulatha (Research Officer), Sri.SoorajCheruthottathil (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) and all the Price Reporters and Price Supervisors in the Districts for preparing such a worthy publication.

# REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

## **MAY-2022**

# **INTRODUCTION**

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of May 2022. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of May of the previous year 2021, previous month April 2022 and current month of May 2022 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the current month of the previous year are included in this report. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

#### 1. RICE

#### Comparison of state average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month. However when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year a mixed trend was observed.

The State average retail prices of Red Matta, White Andhra Vella and Red Chamba increased by 1.15 % 0.79% and 1.50 % respectively when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andhra Vella increased by 14.26% and 7.29 % while that of Red Chamba decreased by 3.75%.

#### 2. PULSES

# Comparison of state average Retail prices of Pulses.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding months of the previous year

When compared with the prices of previous month, Notable increase was seen in the price of Black gram Split with Husk (4.73%). the retail prices of Black gram Split without Husk, Tur Dhal, Bengal gram Bold and Bengal gram Small rose marginally. While the prices of Green gram, Green gram dhal, Redgram and Peas dhall showed a slight downward trend up to 1.95%.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of pulses showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Red gram (9.83%), Bengal gram Small (6.78%) and Bengal gram Bold (3.74%). Notable decrease was seen in the price of Green gram (7.88%) and Green gram dhal (4.51%).

#### 3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

#### Comparison of state average Retail prices of other food items.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Other food items when compared with the prices of the previous month. However when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year a mixed trend was observed.

The State average retail price of all items in this group showed an upward trend or remain stable when compared with the prices of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coffee Powder (2.73%). The prices of Sugar, Tea (Kannan Devan), Baby food (Amul), Egg(Hens)White Lagon showed slight increase while the prices of Milk (Cows) and Mutton with Bones remain stable.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Other Food Items showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Baby food (Amul) (12.49%) and Sugar (5.21%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Egg(Hens)White Lagon 4.75%.

#### 4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

## Comparison of state average Retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Oil and Oil seeds when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month, the State average retail prices of Oil and Oilseeds showed an upward trend up to 3.24% except Coconut without husk and Coconut Oil.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Oil and Oilseeds showed the same trend as in the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Refined Oil (11.71%), Gingelly Oil (10.02%) and Groundnut Oil (8.71%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coconut oil (20.33%) and coconut without husk (14.03%).

#### 5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

#### **Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Spices and Condiments:**

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as with the corresponding month of the previous year.

The state average retail price of Spices and Condiments showed a mixed trend when compared with the price of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coriander(8.84%), Turmeric(3.87%), Onion Small(3.69%), Chillies Dry (2.90%) and Cuminseed (2.60%), while remaining items showed marginal variation.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of Spices and Condiments showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coriander (60.66%), Chillies dry(28.87%), Mustard(24.52%) and Methy (21.58%), while notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion small (35.01%) and Garlic (30.35%).

#### **Comparison of state Average Retail prices of Tubers**

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the price of the previous month, the state average retail price of all items of Tubers showed an upward trend up to 8.17%.


Increasing trend was observed in the retail prices of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the price of Coloccassia (73.23%) and Tapioca raw (50.24%).

#### 7. VEGETABLES

#### Comparison of state average Retail prices of Vegetables.

During the month a huge increase was seen in the price of Tomato. Otherwise a mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of vegetables when compared with the prices of the previous month. While somewhat increasing trend was observed when compared with the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail prices of vegetables showed a mixed trend .Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (118.80%), Brinjal (25.81%) and Bitterguord (17.30%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Chillies green (16.74%).


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of all items of vegetables showed an increasing trend except Onion Big and Cucumber. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (225.44%), Cabbage (24.77%),Banana green (23.75%), Plantain green(19.55%), Snake guard (19.04%) and Brinjal (18.12%), while notable decrease was seen in the price of onion Big (12.80%).

#### 8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

#### **Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items**

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of this group except the price of Cement, when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail prices of all items of this group showed marginal increase except the price of Cement that showed slight decrease of about 10%.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous Year the state average retail price of all items except Cement-Sankar showed an upward trend up to 19.40%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Toilet Soap -Lux(19.40%), Torch Battery (Eveready) (12.85%) and Crocin (12.40%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Cement-Sankar (Ord. Paper Bag) (10.63)%.
