

## PREFACE

*Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance in the context of a growing economy. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmer's and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assumes significance, because the same is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Agr.Production Commissioner, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.*

*From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly, incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations.*

## **REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES**

### **NOVEMBER 2012**

#### **Introduction**

*This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of November 2012. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the corresponding period of the last year as well as the last month. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of November of the previous year 2011, previous month October 2012 and current month of November 2012 are attached and the percentage variation over previous month and current month of previous year are attached. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.*

# 1. RICE


## Comparison of State average retail prices of different varieties of Rice

An upward trend is still continuing in the retail prices of Rice during the period under report when compared with that of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. A marginal increase is seen in the price of Red-Matta (0.15% and 27.28%). Red-Chamba (0.18% and 26.77%) and white Andra Vella (1.58% and 22.42%) respectively over the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year respectively. The following table and diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of Rice.

## 2. PULSES


### Comparison of State average retail prices of Pulses.

A mixed trend is seen in the retail prices of pulses when compared with the price of the previous month and year. A nominal decrease in the prices of Black gram split with husk, without husk, Redgram, Bengalgram Bold and Bengalgram small was noticed while the price of all the other items showed a marginal increase when compared with the price of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, Blackgram split without husk and with husk showed a negative change and all the other items increased by 2% to 61%. Notable increase was seen in the price of Redgram, Bengalgram Bold and Bengalgram Small, when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year. The following Table & Diagram represents the prices and percentage variation over month and year of pulses.

### 3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS


#### Comparison of State average retail prices of other food items.

During this period a mixed trend was noticed in the retail prices of items in this group when compared with the price of the previous month. The price of Sugar (OM), Coffee Powder (Brook Bond Red Label) and Egg hens (White Lagon) had a marginal decrease of 1.44%, 1.00% and 1.85% respectively while the prices of milk and Baby Food (Amul) went up by 8.20% and 1.54% respectively when compared with the price of the previous month. The prices of all items of this group increased by 9% to 20% when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

#### 4. OIL AND OILSEEDS


##### Comparison of State average retail prices of Oil and oilseeds.

During this period the prices of all items of Oil and Oil seeds showed an upward trend when compared with the prices of previous month. When compared with the corresponding month of the previous year, the State average retail price of Coconut oil and Coconut without husk has decreased by 25.02% and 21.11%, while the price of Groundnut oil, Refined oil and Gingelly oil increased by 15.95%, 6.39% and 16.90% respectively.

## 5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

### Comparison of State average retail prices of Spices and Condiments:


A mixed trend is seen in the state average retail prices of spices and condiments. A negative trend is seen in the state average retail price of Coriander, Chillies dry and Turmeric while the State average retail price of all the other items showed a marginal increase when compared with the price of previous month.

Coriander, Chillies dry, Tamarind without seed loose, Turmeric and Garlic showed a downward trend of 5.34%, 30.35%, 27.54% 21.26% and 63.06% respectively, while all other items showed an upward trend when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of previous year.

## 6. TUBERS


### Comparison of State average retail prices of Tubers

During this period the prices of all items except Tapioca raw showed a decreasing trend when compared with the price of the previous month. Chennai and Tapioca Raw showed a downward trend by 3.05% and 5.32% respectively, while all the other items showed an upward trend when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year.

## 7. VEGETABLES

### Comparison of State average retail prices of Vegetables.


A mixed trend has been seen observed during the month in the State average retail prices of Vegetables when compared with that of previous month as well as the corresponding month of previous year. The price of Cucumber (9.34%), Lady's finger (4.54%), Cabbage (1.24%), Bitter gourd (0.08%) and Snake gourd (0.86%) decreased, while all the other items showed an upward trend when compared with the price of the previous month.

The state average retail price of Pumpkin(12.28%), Cabbage(2.37%), Bitter gourd(0.85%) and Tomato (32.12%) showed a negative trend, while the prices of all other items increased by 4% to 51% when compared with the price of the corresponding month of the previous year.

## 8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS


### Comparison of State average retail prices of miscellaneous items

In this group the price of all the items except Crocin showed a nominal increase with respect to the State average retail prices of the previous month. The price of Crocin decreased by 3.19%, when compared with the price of previous month. When compared with the price of the previous year, all items except paper showed an increasing trend while the state average retail price of paper decreased by 11.42%.
