PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumerfed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations. These prices are being collected from the market by the Price collectors and supervised by district level Officers

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

AUGUST-2022

INTRODUCTION

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of August 2022. An increasing trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of August of the previous year 2021, previous month July 2022 and current month of August 2022 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year are included in this report. Group Wise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of State Average Retail prices of different varieties of Rice

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State average retail prices of Red Matta, Red Chamba and White Andhra Vella increased by 3.96 %, 1.64 % and 2.69 % respectively when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail prices of Red Matta and White Andhra Vella increased by 18.56 % and 18.07 % while that of Red Chamba decreased by 2.17%.

The following table and diagram represent the prices and percentage of variation over month and year of Rice.

2. PULSES

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Pulses.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month, as well as the corresponding month of the previous year

When compared with the prices of previous month, an increasing trend was observed in the state average retail price of Pulses except the price of Peas dhal. Notable increase was seen in the price of Dhal (Tur) (6.09 %), Black gram Split without husk (5.16 %) and Green gram (4.13 %) while the prices of Peas dhal decreased marginally.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of pulses showed an increasing trend except the prices of Green gram dhal and Peas dhal. Notable increase was seen in the price of Red gram (12.70 %), Black gram Split with husk (9.12 %), Dhal (Tur) (6.48 %), Black gram Split without husk (5.73 %), Bengal gram Bold (4.84 %) and Bengal gram small (4.78 %) while the prices of Peas dhal and Green gram decreased marginally.

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Other Food Items.

During the month mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Other Food Items when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State average retail price of all items in this group showed only marginal variations except the prices of Egg (Hen) White lagoon, that decreased by 10.82 %, when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Other Food Items showed mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Baby Food (Amul) (8.26%), Coffee powder (Brook Bond Gr.Label) (5.09%) and Sugar (OM) (4.31%)

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Oil and Oilseeds.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Oil and Oilseeds when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month, the State average retail prices of Oil and Oilseeds showed only a marginal variations. Notable decrease was seen in the price of Refined Oil (2.10 %)


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of Oil and Oilseeds showed the mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Refined Oil (10.09%), while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coconut oil (17.96 %) and Coconut without husk (17.26 %).

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Spices and Condiments:

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as with the corresponding month of the previous year.

The state average retail price of Spices and Condiments showed a mixed trend when compared with the price of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion Small (14.38 %), Chillies Dry (13.11 %) and Cuminseed (4.32 %) while all the remaining items showed marginal variation.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of Spices and Condiments showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Chillies dry (88.67%), Coriander (63.30 %), Cuminseed (19.78%), Mustard (18.56%) and Methy (14%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Garlic (32.63 %) and Tamarind without seeds Loose (6.40 %).

6. TUBERS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Tubers

During the month mixed trend was observed in the state average retail price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month while an increasing trend was noticed in the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the price of the previous month, the state average retail price of Tubers showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tapioca Raw (7.20 %) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Elephant Yam (5.66 %).


Increasing trend was observed in the retail prices of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. During this period the prices of all items increased significantly. The price of Tapioca Raw have more than doubled from last year. The prices of Colocasia (53.56 %), Elephant Yam (34.58 %) and Potato (33.47 %) increased significantly.

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Vegetables.

During the month mixed trend was observed in the State average retail price of vegetables when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail prices of vegetables showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Cucumber (23.45 %). Brinjal (18.23 %), Bitter gourd (16.85 %), Chillies green (10.41 %), Plantain green (6.68 %), while notable decrease was seen in the price of Tomato (13.73%).

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of vegetables showed mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Plantain green (57.46 %), Cabbage (49.77 %), Banana green (39.59 %), Chillies green (24.78 %), Cucumber (24.16 %). Brinjal (17.10 %), Ladies finer(12.67%), while notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion Big (15.64%)



When compared with the prices of the previous month, the state average retail prices of all items of this group showed only marginal variations.



Notable increase was seen in the price of Toilet Soap –Lux (27.20 %), Washing soda (21.30 %), Toothpaste –Colgate (17.75 %), Torch Battery (Eveready) (12.52 %) and Razor blade (12.32 %) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Cement-Sankar (Ord. Paper Bag) (10.40 %).
