PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumer fed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations. These prices are being collected from the market by the Price collectors and supervised by district level Officers

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

DECEMBER- 2022

INTRODUCTION

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of December 2022. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of December of the previous year 2021, previous month November 2022 and current month of December 2022 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year are included in this report. Group Wise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of different varieties of Rice

During the month mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month, while an increasing trend was seen when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State Average Retail Prices of White Andhra Vella and Red Chamba increased by 2.84 %, and 1.11 % while the prices of Red Matta decreased by 1.61 %.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Prices of Red Matta, Red Chamba and White Andhra Vella increased by 25.27 %, 14.82 % and 29.01 % respectively.

The following table and diagram represent the prices and percentage of variation over month and year of Rice.

2. PULSES

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Pulses.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month, only marginal variation was seen in this group.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of pulses showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Dhal (Tur) (15.77%), Black gram Split without husk (7.06%) Black gram Split with husk (6.04%) and Green gram (6.77%). while Notable decrease was seen in the prices Red gram (6.49%).

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Other Food Items.

During the month mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Other food items when compared with the prices of the previous month, while an increasing trend observed in the corresponding month of the previous year.

From December 1st onwards the Milma has increased the Price of milk by Rs 6 more per litre. The State Average Retail Price of Egg (Hen) White Lagoon increased by 2.69 %. All the remaining items in this group showed only a marginal variation when compared with the prices of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of Other Food Items showed an increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Milk (Cows) (12.59 %), Coffee Powder (Brook Bond Gr. Label) (11.73 %) and Egg (Hen) White Lagoon (9.67 %),

4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Oil and Oilseeds.

During the month mixed trend was seen in the State Average Retail Price of Oil and Oil seeds when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month, a mixed trend was observed. Notable increase was seen in the price Coconut Oil (3.10 %) and Coconut without Husk (5.65 %) while all the remaining items in this group showed only marginal variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of Oil and Oilseeds showed the mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Refined oil (7.46 %) and Groundnut Oil (5.76 %) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coconut oil (13.93 %) and Coconut without husk (11.79 %).

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Spices and Condiments:

During the month mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

The state average retail price of Spices and Condiments showed only marginal variations when compared with the price of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Garlic (2.69%) and Onion Small (2.57%). Notable decrease was seen in the price of Coriander (3.04%) and Methy (2.37%).


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Price of Spices and Condiments showed an increasing trend except the prices of Garlic and Tamarind without seeds loose. Notable increase was seen in the price of Chillies dry (79.54%), Onion small (42.52%), Coriander (36.36%) and Cuminseed (27%). while notable decrease was seen in the price of Garlic (19.65%).

6. TUBERS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Tubers

During the month a decreasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month while an increasing trend was noticed in the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the price of the previous month, the State Average Retail Price of Tubers showed a decreasing trend except the price of Colocasia that increased by 2.31 %. The State Average Retail Prices Tapioca Raw, Potato and Elephant Yam decreased by 5.41 %, 2.43 % and 2.34 % respectively.


Increasing trend was observed in the retail prices of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the prices of Tapioca (76.92 %), Colocasia (40.94 %) and Elephant Yam (22.66 %).

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Vegetables.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of vegetables when compared with the prices of the previous month, while a decreasing trend was observed in the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the State Average Retail Prices of vegetables showed mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (5.41%) and Banana Green (5.06%). While notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion Big (24.36%), Cabbage (1.76%), Bitter gourd (16.81%).


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the state average retail price of vegetables showed downward trend except the price of Banana green and Plantain green. Notable increase was seen in the price of Plantain green (12.45%), Banana green (8.91%), While notable decrease was seen in the prices of Tomato (62.62%), Lady's Finger (51.50%), Cabbage (49.48%), Cucumber (46%), Brinjal (45.33%), Snake gourd (35.78%), Onion (Big)(33.42%), Ash gourd (31.50%), Bitter gourd (26.28%) and Chillies green (26.14%).

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of state Average Retail prices of miscellaneous items

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of this group when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, an increasing trend was observed except the prices of Cement (Sanker) and Tobacco that decreased by about 4.49% and 0.40% respectively, Notable increase was seen in the price of Torch battery (Eveready) (5.31%) and Paper (2.39%) all the remaining item showed a marginal increase.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the state average retail price of this group showed an increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Toilet Soap –Lux (25.73%), Washing soda (22.44%), Toothpaste – Colgate (15.54%), Paper (12.55%), Torch Battery (Eveready) (7.26%), Razor blade (10.17%) and Cement - Sankar (Ord.Paper Bag) (8.57%).
