PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and Civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumer fed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations. These prices are being collected from the market by the Price collectors and supervised by district level Officers

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division. I appreciate the work done by Sri. Sreekumar.B, Additional Director (PRICES), Sri. Rajendran Nair S (Assistant Director), Smt. Shamju.B.K (Research Officer), Sri. Vinodkumar.I.V (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) for bringing out such a publication.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES JANUARY- 2023

INTRODUCTION

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of January 2023. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of January of the previous year 2022, previous month December 2022 and current month of January 2023 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year are included in this report. GroupWise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of different varieties of Rice

During the month mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Prices of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month while an increasing trend was seen when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State Average Retail Prices of Red-Matta and Red-Chamba decreased by 2.7 %, and 4.3 % while the prices of White-Andhra Vella increased by 0.64 %.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Prices of Red-Matta, Red-Chamba and White-Andhra Vella increased by 18.62%, 14.1% and 27.54% respectively.

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Pulses.


During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Prices of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year. When compared with the prices of previous month, only marginal variation was seen in this group. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Prices of Pulses showed a mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Green gram (7.61%) and Dhall (Tur) (12.1%) while Notable decrease was seen in the prices of Red gram (6.96%)

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Other Food Items.

During the month mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Prices of other food items when compared with the prices of the previous month while an increasing trend observed in the corresponding month of the previous year.

From December 1st onwards the Milma has increased price of Milk by Rs.6 more per liter. The State Average Retail Prices of Mutton without bones increased by 5.26 %. All the remaining items in this group showed only a marginal variation when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Prices of Other Food Items showed an increasing trend except Sugar. Notable increase was seen in the price of Milk (Cows) (13.11 %), Coffee Powder (Brook Bond Grable) (13.76 %), Egg (Hen) White Lagoon (21.15 %) and Mutton without bones (7.14%)



4. OIL AND OIL SEEDS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Oil and Oil Seeds.

During the month mixed trend was seen in the State Average Retail Prices of Oil and Oil Seeds when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month, a mixed trend was observed. Notable decrease was seen in the price Refined Oil (Postman) (2.81 %) while all the remaining items in this group showed only marginal variations.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Prices of Oil and Oil Seeds showed the mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Refined oil (Postman) (8.01 %) and Gingelly Oil (5.49 %) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coconut oil (9.47 %).

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Spices and Condiments:

During the month mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Prices of Spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

Notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion small (25.81 %) and Coriander (7.61%) while all the remaining items in this group showed only marginal variations when compared with the price of the previous month. Notable increase was seen in the price of Cumin seed (9.65 %) and Garlic (2.39 %).


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Prices of Spices and Condiments showed an increasing trend except the prices of Garlic and Tamarind without seeds loose. Notable increase was seen in the price of Chilies dry (51.47%), Coriander (14.3%), Turmeric (10.05%) and Cumin seed (40.24%). while notable decrease was seen in the price of Garlic (5.04%).

6. TUBERS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Tubers

During the month mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Prices of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month while an increasing trend was noticed in the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the price of the previous month, the State Average Retail Prices of Elephant Yam (Chennai) increased by 4.01%. The State Average Retail Prices of Tapioca Raw& Potato decreased by 3.09 %, 9.94% respectively.


Increasing trend was observed in the Retail Prices of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the prices of Colocassia (57.23 %), Tapioca (50.95 %), Elephant Yam (Chennai) (30.44%), and Potato (15.95%)

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Vegetables.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Prices of Vegetables when compared with the prices of the previous month and corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the State Average Retail Prices of Vegetables showed mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Ladies Finger (72.69%), Snake gourd (18.38 %), Chilies green (24.57%), Brinjal (12.14%), and Cucumber (7.65%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Onion big (6.36%), Bitter gourd (6.14%), Banana green (10.04%), Plantain green (9.95%).


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Prices of Vegetables showed mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Ladies Finger (56.70%), Cucumber (35.46 %) and Ash gourd (6.48%) While notable decrease was seen in the prices of Bitter gourd (50.48 %), Pumpkin (36.89), Banana green (26.9%) Cabbage (12.28 %), Brinjal (5.59%), Onion (Big) (26.92%), Ash gourd (10.91), and Chilies green (1.03 %).

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Miscellaneous Items

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Prices of this group when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month a mixed trend was observed. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tobacco (1.5%) and notable decrease was seen in the price of Crocin (2.14%) and Cement-Sankar (Old Paper Bag) (4.51%) while all the remaining items in this group showed only marginal variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Prices of this group showed an increasing trend except Crocin and Cement- Sankar (Old Paper Bag). Notable increase was seen in the price of Toilet Soap –Lux (22.95%), Washing Soda (23.03%), Tooth Paste –Colgate (14.64%), Paper (13.24%), Torch Battery (Eveready) (12.46 %), Razor Blade (Topaz- 10.17%) and Electric Bulb (Philips) (5.13%)
