PREFACE

Price collection is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as for the preparation of Indices, to provide compensation to Farmers and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Institutions. Among the Retail prices, the statement of daily prices of fifty essential commodities being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assume significance, because it is being forwarded daily to the office of the Chief Minister and Minister of Food and Civil Supplies, Minister for Agriculture, Chief Secretary, Food and civil Supplies Secretary, Planning secretary, Department of Civil supplies, Reserve Bank of India, Consumer fed etc. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices are also being collected every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities under 8 major groups. Group wise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representations. These prices are being collected from the market by the Price collectors and supervised by district level Officers

This publication is being prepared and published by Prices Division. I appreciate the work done by Sri. Rajendran Nair.S (Assistant Director), Smt.Shamju.B.K (Research officer), Sri.Syam.S (Statistical Assistant Grade-I) under the guidance of Additional Director (PRICES) for bringing out such a publication.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

June- 2023

<u>INTRODUCTION</u>

This bulletin reflects the average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of June 2023. A mixed trend has been seen in the retail prices under report when compared with that of the last months as well as the corresponding month of previous year. Statement showing the monthly average retail prices of essential commodities for the month of June of the previous year 2022, previous month May 2023 and current month of June 2023 along with the percentage of variation over the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year are included in this report. Group Wise analysis has been made with reference to the current month, the previous month and the corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

1. RICE

Comparison of State Average Retail Price of different varieties of Rice

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Rice varieties when compared with the prices of the previous month but increasing trend was observed when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

The State Average Retail Price of Red-Matta increased by 0.65% and Andhra-Vella decreased by 2.82% but there was no change in the price of Red - Chamba when compared with the prices of the previous month. When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Price of Red-Matta, Red-Chamba and Andhra-Vella increased by 18.08%, 18.18% and 4.43% respectively.



2. PULSES

Comparison of State Average Retail Price of Pulses

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Pulses when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month notable increase was seen in Dhall (Tur) (11.94%), Black Gram split without husk (3.77%), Redgram (3.03%) and Green gram(2.46%). But all other items have only marginal variations.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of pulses showed an increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Green gram (22.76%), Green Gram Dhall (10.57%), Black Gram split without husk (10.26%), Black Gram split with husk (4.13%), Red Gram (14.99%), Dhall (Tur) (35.93%), Bengal Gram Bold (10.56%), while Notable decrease was seen in the prices of Peas Dhall (2.41 %).

3. OTHER FOOD ITEMS

Sl.

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Other Food items.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of other food items when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of previous month notable increase was seen in Egg Hen's (White lagoon) (15.35%), Coffee Powder (Brook Bond Gr.Label) (3.01%) and Sugar (O.M) (1.41%), but all other items have only marginal variations when compared with the prices of the previous month.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of other Food Items showed an increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Milk (Cows) (13.59%), Coffee Powder (Brook Bond) (12.64%), Egg Hen's (White lagon) (13.48%) and Mutton without bones (7.27%) but Baby Food Amul decreased by 1.57%.



4. OIL AND OILSEEDS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Oil and Oilseeds.

During the month a decreasing trend was seen in the State Average Retail Price of Oil and Oil seeds when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year except Gingelly oil.


When compared with the prices of previous month a decreasing trend was observed. Notable decrease was seen in the price Refined Oil -Postman (4.69 %), Coconut oil (3.65%) and Coconut without husk (3.51%) while all the remaining items in this group showed only marginal variations.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of Oil and Oil seeds showed the decreasing trend. Increase was seen only in the price of Gingelly oil (3%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coconut oil (7.95%), Refined Oil -Postman (34.33 %) and Coconut without husk (4.97%).

5. SPICES AND CONDIMENTS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Spices and Condiments.

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Spices and Condiments when compared with the price of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion small (27.34%), Cumin seed (16.83%), Chillies dry (1.87%) and Garlic (10.07 %) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coriander (7.25%) and Mustard (2.13%) when compared with the price of the previous month.


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Price of Spices and Condiments showed increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Onion small (128.44%), Chilies dry (12.69%), Garlic (58.76%) and Cumin seed (90.77%) while notable decrease was seen in the price of Coriander (31.69%).

6. TUBERS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Tubers

During the month mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the previous month as well as the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the price of the previous month, the State Average Retail Price of Potato and Colocassia increased by 4.06% and 8.51% respectively, but Chenai decreased by 1.68% and Tapioca decreased by 2.61%.


Mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of Tubers when compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year. Notable increase was seen in the prices of Chenai (35.25%) and Colocassia (22.43%) while Potato and Tapioca were decreased by 17.35% and 7.96% respectively.

7. VEGETABLES

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of Vegetables.

During the month an increasing trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of vegetables when compared with the prices of the previous month and a mixed trend when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month, the State Average Retail Prices of vegetables showed increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Tomato (222.53%), Chilies green (75.04%), Ladies Finger (33.36%), Banana green (32.48%), Pumpkin (28.58%), Brinjal (15.48%), Snake gourd (15.3%), Ash gourd (14.32%), Onion big (14.29%), Cabbage (11.95%), Bitter gourd (7.51%), Plantain green (6.62%) and Cucumber (4.75%).


When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year, the State Average Retail Prices of vegetables showed mixed trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Chilies green (98.62%), Tomato (97.89%), Bitter gourd (36.51%), Ladies Finger (29.88%), Ash gourd (16%), Brinjal (12.7%), Snake gourd (11.72%), Cucumber (9.96%), Pumpkin (7.71%) While notable decrease was seen in the prices of Cabbage (39.51%), Banana green (14.02%), Plantain green (13.5%) and Onion big (2.32%).

8. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Comparison of State Average Retail Prices of miscellaneous items

During the month a mixed trend was observed in the State Average Retail Price of this group when compared with the prices of the previous month and an increasing trend when compared with the corresponding month of the previous year.

When compared with the prices of the previous month mixed trend was observed in almost all items. Notable increase was seen in the price of Mundu (Mull) (3.89%), Paper (3.08%), Razor Blade (Topaz) (2.68%), Electric Bulb (Philips) (1.43%) and Tooth paste (Colgate) (1.37%), notable decrease was seen in Tobacco (9.53%), Firewood (Local split) (7.17%), Cement-Sanker (Old Paper Bag) (2.11%), Washing soda (1.92%) and Torch Battery (Eveready) (1.14%) while all the remaining items in this group showed only marginal variations.

When compared with the prices of the corresponding month of the previous year the State Average Retail Price of this group showed an increasing trend. Notable increase was seen in the price of Razor Blade (Topaz) (11.33%), Paper (9.51%), Washing Soda (8.93%), Tooth paste(Colgate) (8.74%), Crocin (7.83%), Toilet Soap (Lux) (7.36%), Torch Battery (Eveready) (6.46%), Electric Bulb


(Philips) (5.75%) and Mundu (Mull) (3.89%), notable decrease was seen in Tobacco (7.05%) and Firewood (Local split) (2.25%).
