1 ABOUT PALAKKAD

1.1 HISTORY OF PALAKKAD

Palakkad is the land of Palmyrahs and Paddy fields is also known as the 'Granary of Kerala' a union of diverse culture and background. It is often called the gateway of Kerala. By the linguistic re-organisation of states, Kerala State was formed on 1st November 1956. The Palakkad district was formed on the 1st January, 1957 consisting of Palakkad, Perinthalmanna, Ponnani, Ottappalam, Alathur and Chittur Taluks. When Malappuram District was formed on 16th June, 1969 Ponnani and Perinthalmanna Taluks forms the part of Malappuram district and a new taluk called Mannarkkad was formed comprising the 19 Villages of the erstwhile Perinthalmanna Taluk.

The ancient History of Palakkad is shrouded. According to William Logan, the author of "Malabar Manual" the Pallava Dynasty of Kanchi might have invaded Malabar in the second or third century. One of their headquarters was Palakkad which could be the present Palakkad. For many years the Malabar region was ruled by Perumals. Malabar had been invaded by many of the ancient 'south Indian Rulers. After this the Malabar was divided among their Utayavars. The famous among them were the Valluvakonathiri (ruler of Valluvanad) Kollengode Raja (Ruler of Vengunad) and Sekharivarma Raja (Ruler of Palakkad) of Palakkattussery. The Palakkad Region was come under the control of Kollengode Raja and Sekharivarma Raja of Palakkad.

When the Kozhikkode Sammoothiri invaded Palakkad in 1757, the Palakkad Raja sought the help of Hyder Ali of Mysore. His help forced the sammoothri for retreat. Later Hyder Ali subjugated all territories in palakkad which were under the possession of Kozhikkode Sammoothri. Thus whole dominion of Palakkad passes into the control of Mysore Sulthan Hyder Ali Khan and his son Tippu Sulthan. The war between East India Company and Tippu Sulthan ended with the treaty of 1792 and all possessions of Tippu in Malabar area ceded to the East India Company and it formed the Malabar District of the Madras Presidency.

Palakkad is situated almost in the centre of the State, has no coastal line. The Palakkad Gap 32KMs wide natural gap in the Western Ghats is the most influential factor of the unique characteristics of the district, such as climate, commercial and cultural activities. The Palakkad Gap is the main outlet to the midland of India. Through this gap the Tamil, Mysore and British Army reached Palakkad and established their supremacy in the state. Bharathapuzha the longest river in Kerala originates from the highland and flows through the middle of the entire district. It is the longest river in the state, has 6186sq.k.m. of catchment area in the district. A number of irrigation dams were constructed along the course of the river.

Palakkad district is called as the "Granary of Kerala". Palakkad district accounts for about 38% of Paddy area and 34% of Rice production in the state. The net cultivated area of the district is 204289 hectares i.e. 48 % of the total area. The total paddy area (gross) comes to 105131 hectares. Palakkad is the only district in the state where cotton and groundnut are cultivated. The district produces about 1/3rd of the total production of rice in the state. The only Panchayath (Muthalamada) in the world where there are Five large irrigation dams were constructed is in Palakkad district.

The district has 28386 ha. of wastelands in different categories which constitute 6.5% of total geographical area of the district. Attappady Valley in Mannarkkad Taluk accounts for 57% of the total wasteland in the district. The underutilized/Degraded forest land with an area of 11,202 ha. accounts for 39.5% of total waste lands. The degraded forest land constitute about 8% of total forest land.

At present Palakkad district consists of two Revenue Divisions – Palakkad and Ottappalam - , Five Taluks with 163 Revenue Villages. The Taluks are Chittur, Alathur, Ottappalam, Palakkad and Mannarkkad. For the smooth development, the district comprises of 12 Community Development Blocks and One Tribal Development Block, four Municipalities and 91 Panchayaths. The total Geographical area of the district comes to 4480 sq.kms.

According to 2001 census and total population of the district is 26,17,482 of which the male population is 12,66,985 and the female population in 13,50,497 the density is 584 persons per sq.k.m. About 85 percent of the people in the district live in villages. The growth rate in the district from 1991 to 2001 is 9.86 percent. The highest growth rate in the district is recorded in Mannarkkad Taluk. The effective literacy rate is 84.31 percent. It is very low in the state average of 90.92 percent. The literacy rate of woman in the district is 79.31 percent while it is 89.73 for men. The sex ratio in the district is 1068 women. The sex ratio of the state is 1058.

The language spoken by the people of the district is Malayalam. Tamil stands next to it. Those who have language other than Malayalam as their mother tongue can generally understand and speak Malayalam. Tamil is common in Chittur and Palakkad Taluk. About 25 percent of the people have Tamil as their mother tongue. Konkani, Taluk and Kannada speaking families are also seen here and there in the district.

Hinduism is the pre-dominating religion of the district. Nearly 71 percent of the people belong to the Hindu Community. All the sub castes of Hindus are well occupied in the district. The second largest community of the district is Muslim forming 25 percent of the total population. The strength of Christian Community is nearly 4 percent. Almost all the sections of the Christian Community are represented in the district. A large number of Christian families from Travancore areas have moved to the hilly tracts of the north and south valets in thirst of land and living.

Almost 10% of the rural population of this district is agriculturists. And 75% of the labourers depend on Agricultural works. Attappady which is mainly inhabited by the tribal folk is a part of this district. A number of development schemes are introduced for the betterment of the tribal people both by the Central and State governments. Though basically an agrarian one, this district, in tune with Industrial development of the nation is gradually picking up its industrial base. The Walayar- Kanjikode sector on the eastern side of this district has already been identified with industrial establishments like the I.T.I., Instrumentation Ltd., Malabar Cements Ltd. and other private industries like B.P.L., Carborandum Universal Ltd., etc. The easy availability of land at comparatively low cost and close proximity to the well-developed industrial bite of Coimbatore and other places in Tamilnadu are favourable factors in the development of the industries. The nearness to Coimbatore and Pollachi also posses threat to marketing of products. There are 86 medium and large scale industries in this area. The number small scale industries registered in the district is 22,111. A number of small industrial units have also started functioning in other parts of the district like Shornur, Parali and Olavacode.

The Government Goat Farm Attappady and the Regional Poultry Farm Malampuzha are also functioning in the district for the distribution of 'Malabari goats' and Improved variety of chicks for the weaker sections of the community.

Palakkad has given birth to so many cultural leaders and artists and has contributed to their growth. Thunchath Ezhuthachan who is the father of modern Malayalam Literature spent his last days at Thunchan Madam(also called 'Gurumadhom') in Chittur. Kunchan Nambiar the founder of 'Thullal' the most popular poet of Malayalam had his birth in a small village named Killikurissimangalam near Lakkidi,Ottappalam taluk. Mani Madhava Chakkiar for' Koothu' and Vazhenkada Kunju Nair for 'Kathakali' are two famous names to be remembered in this context. The district has blessed with the birth of Sri. Chembai Vaidhyanatha bagavathar, the exponent of Carnatic Music, Sri. Palakkad Mani Iyer the inimitable master of Mridangam. Sir C .Sankaran Nair , first and only Malayali President of Indian National Congress belongs to Mankara in this district. The great modern poet Mahakavi Kumaranassan wrote his famous poetry "Veena Poovu" at Jainimedu, Palakkad. The life and growth of modern literary gents like P.Kunhiraman Nair, Olappamanna Subramanian Namboothirippad, M.T.Vasudevan Nair and O.V.Vijayan are intimately connected with this district.

Two eminent personalities who increased the fame of this district abroad are late. K.P.S.Menon and K.P.Kesava Menon. 'Swadesabhimani' Ramakrishna Pillai spent his life in exile at Vadakkenthara near Palakkad Town. The Ex.-Chief Election Commissioner Sri.T.N.Seshan also belongs to Palakkad town.

Important festivals of the district are Kalpathy Car Festival, Chittur Konganpada, Nemmara Vallenghy Vela, Vadakkenthara Vela, Arat festival in Kachanamkurissi, Pattami Nercha, Chinakkathur Pooram etc.

Palakkad district with its vast geographical features stands in the topmost position. The milestones in the development of this district are powerful. The present picture of Palakkad district depicts the fact that 'slow and steady wins the race'.

1.2 Mineral Resources

Lime stones deposit found at Pandarettu in Walayar reserve forest by the Geological Survey of India in 1961 – 62. Exploratory drilling was conducted in 1968 – 70 and a possible reserve of 9.82 Million tones of crystalline lime stones had been estimated upto 300 metre above MSL. The famous Walayar Cement Factory is established by Government of Kerala for utilizing these deposits. Minor banks of crystalline lime stones are also reported from the area north of Chavadipara and east-south-east of Nettuvangai area. In Vannamadai area lime stone occurs as banks and lenses.

Small capping of Kankar is found along the stream courses of Varattar river in Attappady and Korayar river near Eruthempathy.

Sands of Siruvani river and its tributaries flowing along Attappady valley near Agali and Kanjirappuzha near Pulassery and South-east of Pottassery have believed to alluvial fold by the people since ancient times. Sample of heavy minerals from Siruvani and its tributaries are seem to contain minor amount of Monozite, Zircon, Epidote and a few grain of tungsten ore.

1.3 SOIL

The sol of palakkad district is mainly of four types, namely, peaty (kari), laterite, forest and black. Peaty soil is found only in thrithala, firka of Ottapalam taluk. Laterite is seen in the major portions of all Taluks. Forest soil is confined at Mannarkad and Ottapalam taluks, the narrow strip of land along the western boundaries of palakkad and Alathur taluk and along ht southern boundary of Chittur Taluks. Black soil is seen mostly in the eastern sector of Chittur taluk and a small portion of palakkad taluk.



3.1 MAJOR TOURIST SPOTS IN PALAKKAD

Silent Valley

The Silent Valley National Park is located in the Kundali Hills in Kerala, along the hill ranges known as the Western Ghats. The core of the Nilgiri Biosphere Reserve, it probably is one of the magnificent **gifts of nature** to mankind. Attappadi Reserve Forests to the East, the Palghat and Nilambur forest divisions in the West and South and the Nilgiri Forests in the North. This biodiversity hot spot is a unique treasure trove of rare flora and fauna. The Silent Valley National Park was threatened by the construction of a Hydel Power Project during the 1970's.

The park is called Silent Valley because of a perceived absence of noisy cicadas. Silent Valley is a unique reserve of tropical rain forest in all its pristine glory with an almost unbroken ecological history. It has a fair representation of rare species of Flora and Fauna. . It is an "ecological island" with a relatively undisturbed evolutionary history of at least 50 million years manifested in a high degree of floral and faunal endemism. Rare, endangered and new biological species continue to be discovered from the Silent Valley National Park. Protests by environmentalists led to the renomination of Silent Valley as a National Park in 1984. The Nilgiri Biosphere Reserve with the Silent Valley National Park as its core area, was created in 1986. Silent Valley National Park is called Sairandhrivanam. . Visitors are permitted only up to Sairandhiri, the site of the proposed dam, 23 km from Mukkali, where the Deputy Director of the Kerala Forest Department has his office. The intrepid traveller seeking to go deeper has to convince the Conservator of Forests, Northern Region, based at Palakkad, that he is a bona fide nature-lover, not some biopirate out to rob the forest of genetic resources. With his permission, you can choose from several trekking routes

Malampuzha

Malampuzha garden is the Vrindavan of Kerala, about 12 km away from palakkad town . It exudes the charm of the harmony of nature, a perfect synchronization of the grandeur of the mountains blending with the serenity of rivers. There are lush green lawns, innumerable flower beds, glittering pool, fountains and avenues, there is a fresh water aquarium also, a snake park and a children's park with a toy train which await the pleasure and delight of children. The reservoir is ideal for boating and fishing. The garden house has a unit of water ports. a small garden in the Japanese style gives a touch of exotic charm to the landscape. So does the hanging bridge across the river, another items of interest in the part is the imposing g concrete sculpture of YAKSHI done by the renowned artist kanai kunhiraman. The passenger ropeway is the first of its kind in south India, offers adventurous and delightful air journey of 20 mintuers across the gardens, giving a soul stirring view of the garden. there is a road train for amusement ride on wheels. There is also telescope tower in the garden providing a terrestrial view upto 40 miles. The first rockgarden emerged from the master creator Padmasree Neck Chand Saini of Chandigarh, in south Asia is at Malampuzha. Modeled after Appu Ghar of Delhi and Essel world of Bombay, the first amusement park of Kerala named Fantasy Park is at Malampuzha.

Parambikulam

Nelliampathy

Nelliampathy is 55 km from Palakkad. By Road it takes 2.30hrs. The ranges here consist of a chain of ridges cut off from one another by valleys. The highest peak is Nellikota. The forest contains teak of extraordinary height and girth. Estates of tea, coffee, orange and cardamom dot the ranges. Located at a distance of 52 kms from Palakkad, the cool hills of Nelliampathy, nestling atop the Western Ghats, offer a breathtaking view of the misty mountains and enchanting valleys interspersed with sprawling tea, coffee, cardamom and orange plantations. The height of the hills ranges from 467 metres to the tallest peak Padagiri looming at 1572 metres. Nelliampathy has immense trekking potential. The community hall at Kaikatty provides a good camping ground for the trekkers. Accessing Nelliampathy from Palakkad is a sensation on its own, as one has to negotiate over a dozen hairpin curves on the Ghat Road, passing through the fascinating jungles of the Sahya Ranges. En route, 17 kms from Palakkad, the shimmering Pothundi Reservoir and its manicured surroundings make for the ideal stop over.

Palakkad Fort

Palakkad Fort is one of the best preserved Forts in Kerala, was built by Mysore's Haider Ali in 1766 AD. In 1790, the Fort was taken over and renovated by the British. This old granite Fort is situated in the very heart of Palakkad town. Also known as Tipu's Fort, Palakkad Fort was supposedly built to hasten communication between Coimbatore and the West Coast. In 1784 AD, after a siege lasting eleven days, the British Colonel, Fullerton stormed the Fort. It later fell into the hands of the Zamorin's troops but was recaptured by the British in 1790 AD. Martyr's Column, Open Air Auditorium called "Rappadi" are located in the spacious grounds of the Fort, now preserved by the Archaeological Survey Of India. There is also a Children's park on one of the sides of the Fort.

Dhoni

Dhoni, a hilltop is situated 15 km from Palakkad. Dhoni, situated at a distance of 15 Km from Palakkad is a fairly long climb of a 3-hour trek from the base of the Dhoni Hills. This reserve forest area with its small, beautiful waterfall has many tourists all through the year. It is a splendid and captivating waterfall. Dhoni provides trekkers the opportunity to explore its hilly terrains. Its lush green surroundings are a pleasure to watch. Dhoni is also famous for its farmhouse, harboring hundreds of cattle of Swiss variety. .

Chittur Gurumadam

Located on the banks of the River Sokanasini (the destroyer of sorrows), this is a memorial to Thunchath Ezhuthachan, the author of Adhyatma Ramayana, who spent his last days here. It is situated in Thekkegramam near Arikode Srichakra, some of the idols worshipped by him, a stylus, wooden slippers and a few old manuscripts are exhibited here.

Pothundy

Pothundy is 38 kms south of palakkad town. An irrigation project was commissioned here in 1968, consisting of a an earthen dam with a spill way section across the tributaries. Its 10 kms right bank canal and 8 kms. Left bank canal irrigate an area of 5465 hectares in Chittur and Alathur taluks.

Jain Temple of Jainmedu

The only existing Jain Temple in South India is situated at Jainmedu, 3 kms from Palakkad. Here you can find images of Jain THIRTHANKARAS and YAKSHINIS. Rituals are being held even now in this historic temple.

SmritiVanam

J.P. Smriti Vanam located at Walayar, on the border of Kerala and Tamil Nadu, extends to about 100 acres. You can conduct a safari ride here and see deers, elephants and other animals moving freely. The park is located at a distance of 22 kms from Palakkad.

Siruvani

Siruvani is 48 kms from Palakkad. The gateways on either side of the road across the dam bear the stamp of Kerala and Tamil Nadu Architectural Styles. Its thick reserved forest has all kinds of wild animals.

Meenvallam

There are 10 steps of Water Falls at Meenvallam, the originating point of Thuppanadu river. The height of the fall varies from 5 to 45 meters. Meenvallam is located at a distance of 37 kms from Palakkad.

Mayiladumpara peacock sanctuary

Myiladumpara choolannur peacock sanctuary is 30 kms away from palakkad. It is well known as a grove abounding in peacocks.

Kunchan smarakam

Kalakkathu kunchan nambiar represents an age and its culture in the field of malayalam literature. He was the native of killikurissi mangalam in palakkad. Now, the kunchan smarakam is a national monument and is being governed by a committee

appointed by the government. A three year course on Ottan, thullal, seethankan thullal and parayan thullal was started with the help of artistes attached to this monument.

3.2 RIVERS

Bharathapuzha, with her tributaries, sprawls across the entire district. the river takes its origin form anamalai hills and flows through the district of palakkad, malappuram and thrissur before empty in into the Arabian sea at ponnani. Its four main tributaries are gayatripuzha ,kannadipuzha ,kalpathy puzha and thuthappuzha.

Gayathripuzha river originates from anamala hills and after traversing through kollengode, Nemmara, Alathur, wadakkanchery and pazhayannur, joins bharathapuzha at mayannur. This tributary has five main sub tributaries. Managalam river, Ayalurpuzha, Vandazhipuzha, Meenkarapuzha, and Chulliyar.

Kannadipuzha is also known as chitturpuzha or amaravatipuzha. This river, which also starts from the anamalai hills, flows through thathamangalam and Chittur and joins the main river at Parli. There palar, aliyar and upper streams combine to this river.

Kalpathypuzha also know as korayar this river starts from the place called chenthamarakulam in the hills, north of walayar. Kalpathypuzha is formed by four streams, viz., korayar, varttar, walayar and Malampuzha.

Thuthapuzha , otherwise known as Pilanthol river, starts from the silent valley hills and joins the main river about two kms off pallipuram railway station. The important streams which feed this tributary are kunthipuzha, kanjirapuzha, ambankadavu and thuppanadipuzha.

3.3 IRRIGATION

The major irrigation project in palakkad district are Walayar, Malampuzha, Cheerakuzhi, Gayatri(meenkara-chulliyar) , Mangalam, Pothundy, Chitturpuzha.


4.10 Production of Rice- Palakkad Dist




