## P R E F A C E

*The report 'Economic census 2005 -Provisional Results' has been compiled based on the data generated under the Fifth Economic Census 2005 conducted in Kerala from June to September 2005.*

*Economic census is the official count of all economic activities both agricultural and non-agricultural except those under crop production and plantation. Enterprises employing 10 or more workers were also enumerated separately in the fifth Economic Census since it was a felt need for want of a Business Register. The main purpose of the Census is to generate an updated frame of enterprises for detailed follow up surveys.*

*This report has been brought out by the Economic Census division of this Directorate. This report is based on the Quick Manual Tabulation of data contained in the enterprise abstract. The final results would be released in a separate report after complete processing of data.*

*I am extremely thankful and grateful to Sri. Palat Mohandas, the former Chief Secretary, Govt.of Kerala for his support and guidance in carrying out the fifth Economic Census of the state.*

*I also thank District Collectors and all other officers in the state and in the districts who are responsible directly or indirectly for the successful completion of this census.*

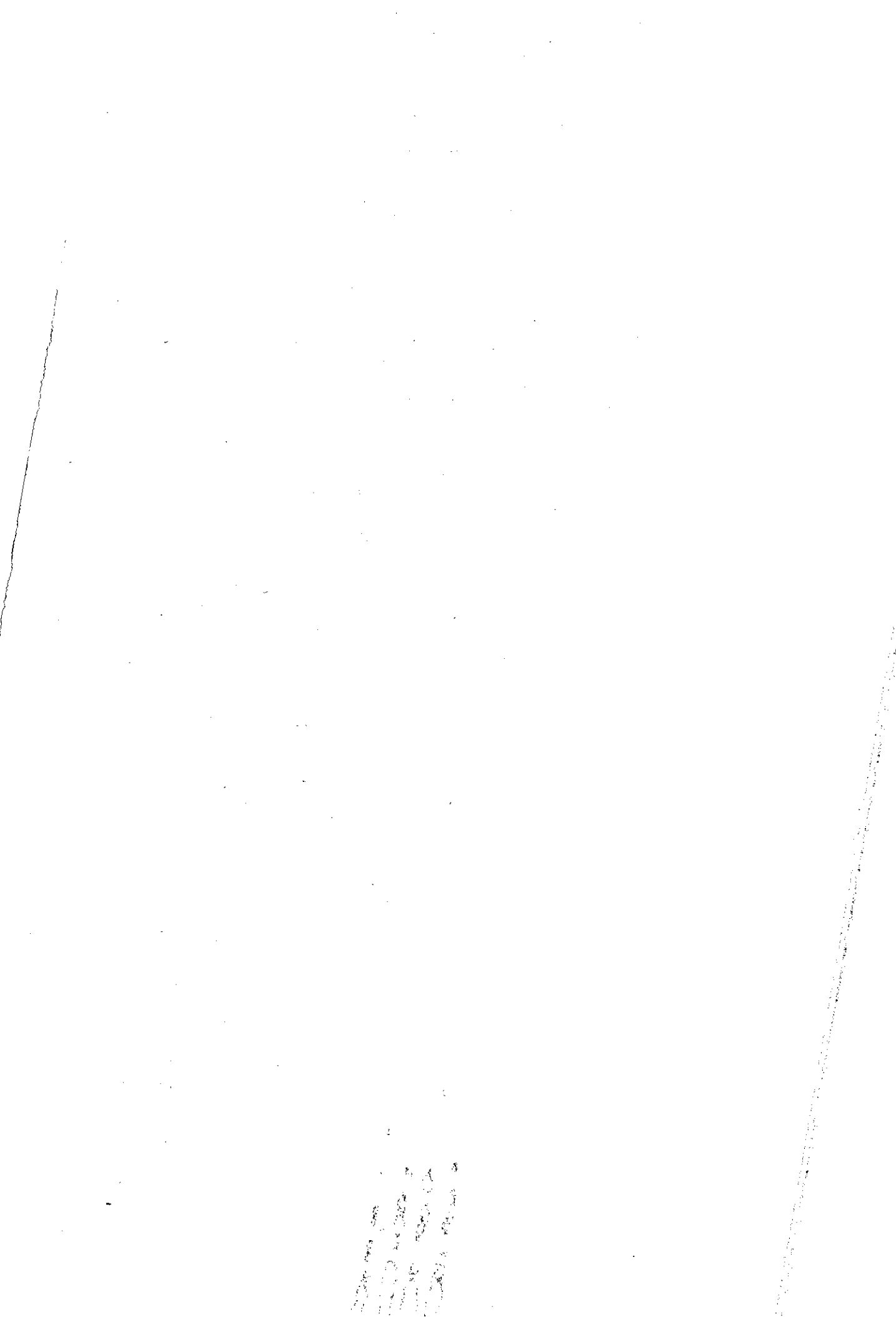

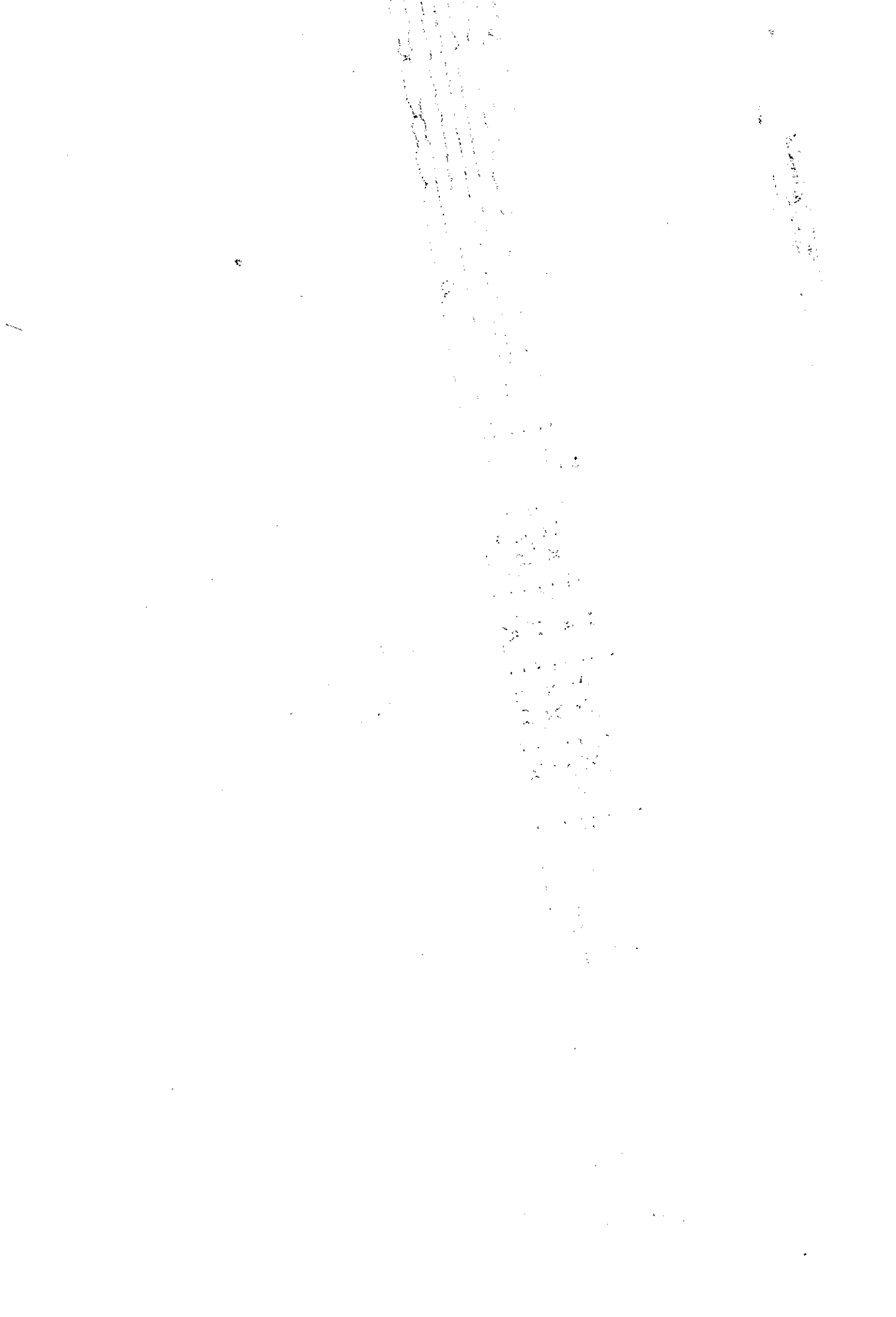

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## INTRODUCTION

The importance of unorganised sector in a developing country like India need not be overemphasized. Though a fairly adequate system of agricultural statistics has already been developed in the country, such an information system has not yet been built up for the non-agricultural sector. The statistics in respect of organised segments of the non-agricultural economy are being collected more or less regularly, But it is not so in the case of unorganised segments. It is a fact that a significant contribution towards GDP is from unorganised sector. The data gaps in the unorganised sector continue to pose problems for planners and policy makers.

In order to fill the data gap in the unorganised non-agricultural sectors of the economy, a scheme, "Economic Census" was launched by the Central Statistical Organisation (CSO) in 1976. Since then CSO has conducted four economic censuses in the years 1977,1980, 1990 and 1998.

### **Fifth Economic Census**

The last Economic Census conducted in 1998 could only capture the impact of economic reforms partially. Due to economic reforms, the structural and compositional changes in the economy have been more rapid in the recent years. To meet the situation, Govt. of India has decided to launch the fifth economic census.

### **Economic census in Kerala**

The Department of Economics and Statistics, Kerala has been playing the role of a nodal agency and has conducted the 4 previous economic censuses. The fifth one in this series has also been conducted during 2005.

### **Scope and Coverage**

Economic census is the official count of all entrepreneurial units within the country. All households, structures/buildings and enterprises (all economic activities (agricultural and non-agricultural) except those under crop production and plantation)

were enumerated. Economic census has been conducted in Kerala by dividing the whole area into two sectors, namely Rural and Urban.

The main purpose of conducting Economic census is to generate an updated frame of enterprises for detailed follow-up surveys.

Examples of enterprise: Rearing of cows and selling of milk is an agricultural enterprise where as collection of milk through societies and selling it to the customers is non-agricultural.

### **Funds**

Economic census is a 100% Centrally sponsored scheme. An amount of Rs. 295.61 lakhs has been allotted to Kerala for conducting the census in Kerala. Under this scheme, the posts of Joint Director and Assistant Director (one each) with supporting staff have also been created in this directorate on temporary basis.

### **State Level Steering Committee**

For the smooth conduct of economic census in Kerala, a 14 member State Level Steering Committee has been constituted headed by the Chief Secretary as Chairman and the Director, Dept. of Economics & Statistics as convener.

Similarly In all the 14 districts, a District Level Monitoring Committee was also constituted making District Collector as Chairman and Deputy Directors concerned as conveners.

### **Manpower deployment and Training**

A total number of 6061 enumerators were employed for the collection of field data. A total of 11,889 Rural wards and 11,129 urban blocks were covered. Departmental staff supervised their field work.

For the smooth conduct of Economic Census 2005, two days State level training (including field training) to state and district level officers were conducted followed by 3 Regional trainings at Thiruvananthapuram, Trichur and Kannur respectively.

Similarly District and Taluk level trainings were also imparted with sufficient field training.

### **Schedules**

The schedules that were used for the census are as follows:

1. House List (for rural and urban separately)
2. Enterprise schedule (for rural and urban separately)
3. Abstract (for rural and urban separately)
4. Address slip

### **Publicity**

Wide publicity was organised through print media by releasing advertisements in the leading Malayalam dailies and also through Doordarshan channel.

### **New Features**

For the first time, Intelligent Character Recognition Technology (ICR) is used for scanning and processing of the economic census data using the infrastructure of the office of the Registrar General of India.

Separate 'Address slip' was also canvassed among the enterprises which are employing 10 or more workers for compilation of a Directory of larger enterprises.

### **Quick Manual Tabulation Report**

The Quick Manual Tabulation Report of the census have been prepared by the economic census division of this Directorate and submitted to the Government of India and Kerala during November 2005.

### **Final Report**

The Final Report of the Economic Census-2005 will be released by the end of 2006.

## **CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS OF IMPORTANT TERMS**

Concepts and definitions of some of the important terms used in the fifth Economic Census are given below:

### **ENTERPRISE**

An enterprise is an undertaking engaged in production and/or distribution of goods and / or services not for the sole purpose of own consumption.

### **AGRICULTURAL ENTERPRISE**

An agricultural enterprise for the purpose of Economic Census is defined as one engaged in livestock production, agricultural services hunting trapping & game propagation; forestry and logging, fishing (corresponding to Groups 012,013,014,015,020 and 050 of NIC 2004). Enterprises engaged in activities pertaining to agricultural production and plantation (Group 011 of NIC-2004) are excluded from the coverage of Economic Census.

### **NON –AGRICULTURAL ENTERPRISE**

Enterprises engaged in economic activities other than agricultural activities (excluding activities pertaining to agricultural production and plantation) are termed as non-agricultural enterprises.

### **NATURE OF OPERATION**

If the entrepreneurial activity is carried on through out the year more or less regularly is treated as perennial activity. If the activity of the enterprise is confined to a particular season, the same is called the non-perennial activity.

### **NUMBER OF PERSONS USUALLY WORKING DAILY**

The total number of persons usually working daily in an enterprise with break-up of Adult male, Adult female, Child male and child female and component of non-hired (unpaid) was taken in to account. The workers with age less than 15 years have

been categorized as children. Workers include members of the household whether paid or not engaged in any activity. The figure of number of persons is as position in the last year for perennial enterprises and last working season for seasonal enterprises. The category of workers includes both supervisory and primary workers. A worker need not mean the same person is continued but refers to a position. Part time workers are also treated employees as long as they are engaged on a regular basis.

**Salient Features: -**

- ✓ Total number of enterprises in Kerala engaged in different economic activities other than crop production and plantation is 28.48 lakhs.
- ✓ The average annual growth rate of enterprises is 8.93 per cent over the 1998 economic census
- ✓ The total number of households in the state is 76.28 lakhs of which 57.40 lakhs are in rural areas and the remaining 18.88 lakhs are in urban areas
- ✓ Out of the 28.48 lakhs of enterprises, 21.17 lakhs are in rural areas and the remaining 7.31 lakhs are in urban areas

- ✓ Total number of workers engaged in all the 28.48 lakhs of enterprises is 55.60 lakhs
- ✓ The average annual growth rate of employment is 5.39 per cent over the 1998 economic census
- ✓ Out of the 55.60 lakhs of workers, 36.84 lakhs are working in rural areas and the remaining 18.76 lakhs are in urban areas.
- ✓ Out of the total enterprises in Kerala, 88 per cent of enterprises is working with premises and the rest (12 per cent) is working without premises
- ✓ Density of enterprises is 73 per square kilometer
- ✓ Density of agricultural enterprises is 23 per square kilometer
- ✓ Density of non-agricultural enterprises is 50 per square kilometer
- ✓ Average number of employees per enterprise is 2
- ✓ Average number of employees per enterprise in rural areas is 2 where as the same is 3 in urban areas
- ✓ The number of non-agricultural enterprises is 19.55 lakhs (68.64%) while the number of agricultural enterprises is 8.93 lakhs (31.36%)
- ✓ Out of the 19.55 lakhs of non-agricultural enterprises, 13.22 lakhs belong to rural areas and the remaining 6.33 lakhs are in urban areas
- ✓ Out of the 8.93 lakhs of agricultural enterprises, 7.95 lakhs are in rural areas and 0.98 lakhs are in urban areas
- ✓ As regards the number of enterprises, Ernakulam ranks first with 11 per cent of enterprises and Wayanad stands last with 3 per cent of enterprises among the 14 districts
- ✓ Out of the 28.48 lakhs of enterprises, 0.42 lakhs of enterprises (1.47 per cent) are engaging 10 or more workers
- ✓ Regarding the number of enterprises employing 10 or more workers, Thiruvananthapuram district has the maximum number of enterprises (16 per cent) where as the district Idukki has the least number of enterprises (2 per cent).
- ✓ Considering the total number of workers, Ernakulam ranks first with 12 per cent of workers where as Wayanad ranks last with 3 per cent of workers among the 14 districts

The table gives data collected through economic censuses in Kerala. The first Economic Census was conducted in 1977, and the subsequent series were conducted in 1980, 1990, 1998 respectively and the fifth and latest was in 2005.

In 1977, only non-agricultural enterprises employing at least one hired worker on a fairly regular basis were enumerated. From the second economic census 1980 onwards, all types of enterprises (agricultural and non-agricultural) including own account enterprises have been covered. Enterprises engaged in crop production and plantation have been excluded.

An analysis of the growth rate of the number of enterprises and workers shows that both are having an increasing trend where as the average number of workers per enterprise has been declining. The number of enterprises reported in 1977 was 1.71 lakhs which increased to 28.48 lakhs during 2005. Similarly, the number of workers reported during 1977 was 14.07 lakhs which also increased to 55.59 lakhs during 2005.

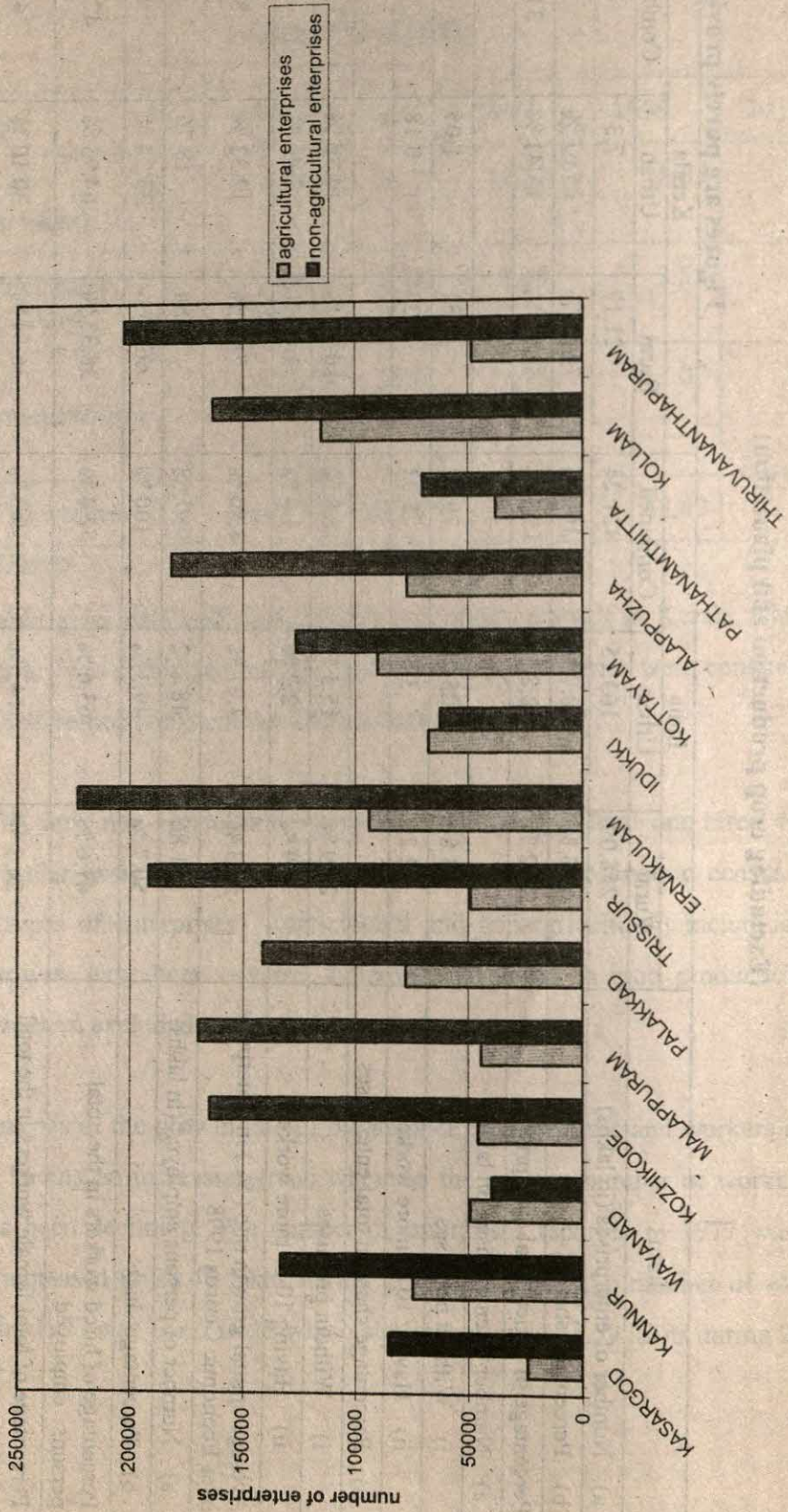


**COMPARISON BETWEEN INDIA AND KERALA**

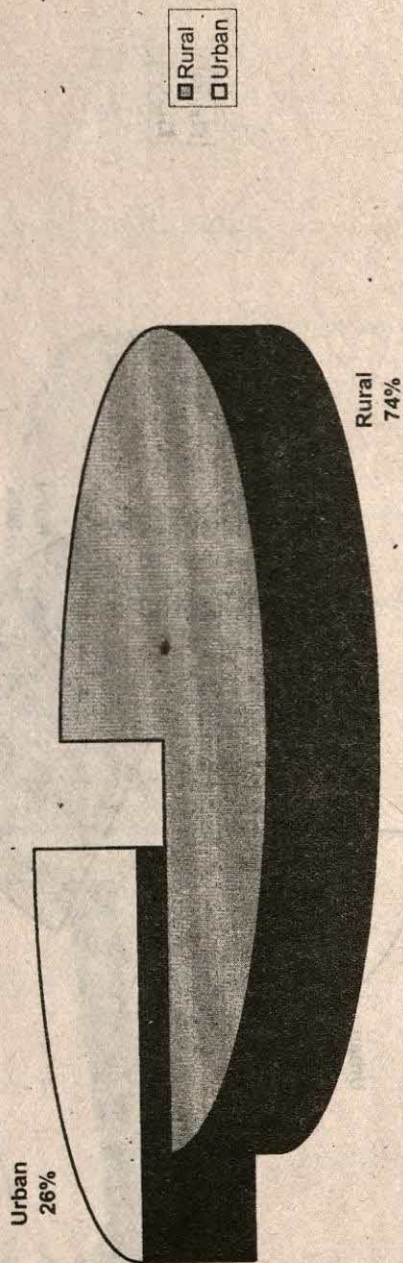

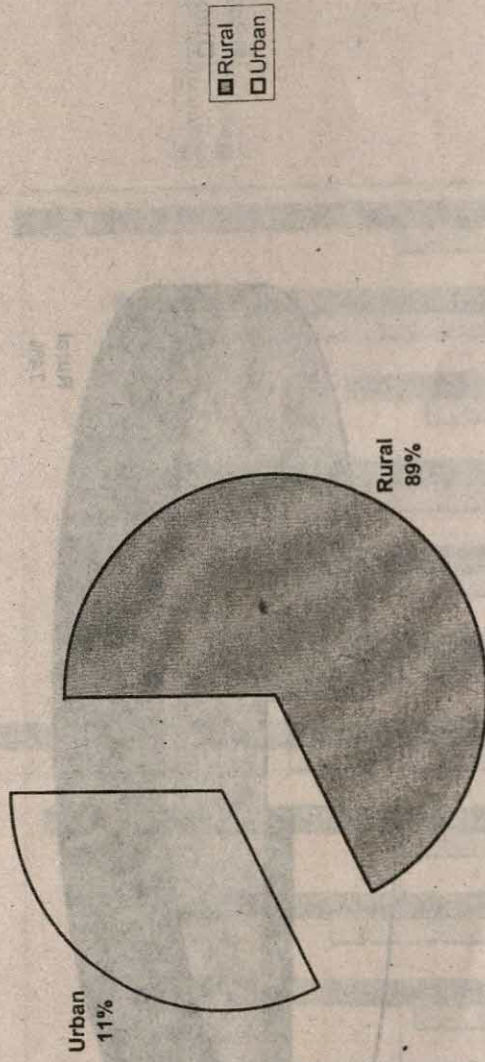
Districtwise distribution of agricultural and non-agricultural enterprises



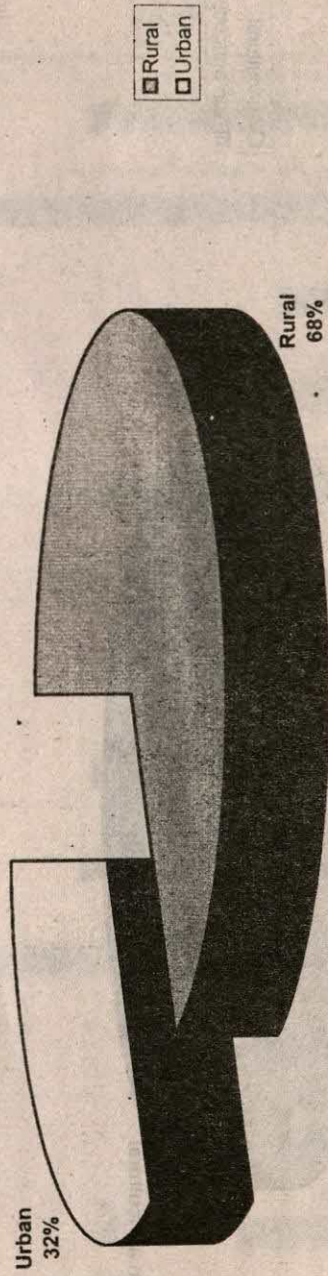
### Percentage share of enterprises in rural and urban sectors



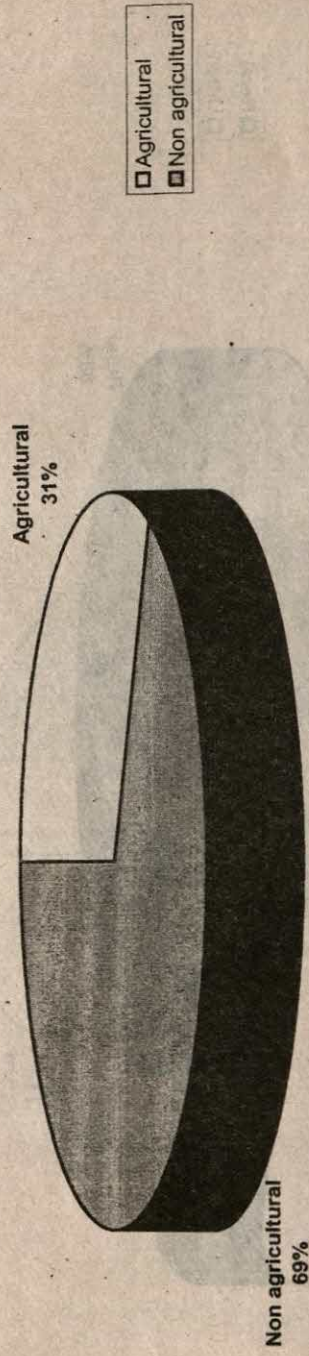
Percentage share of agricultural enterprises



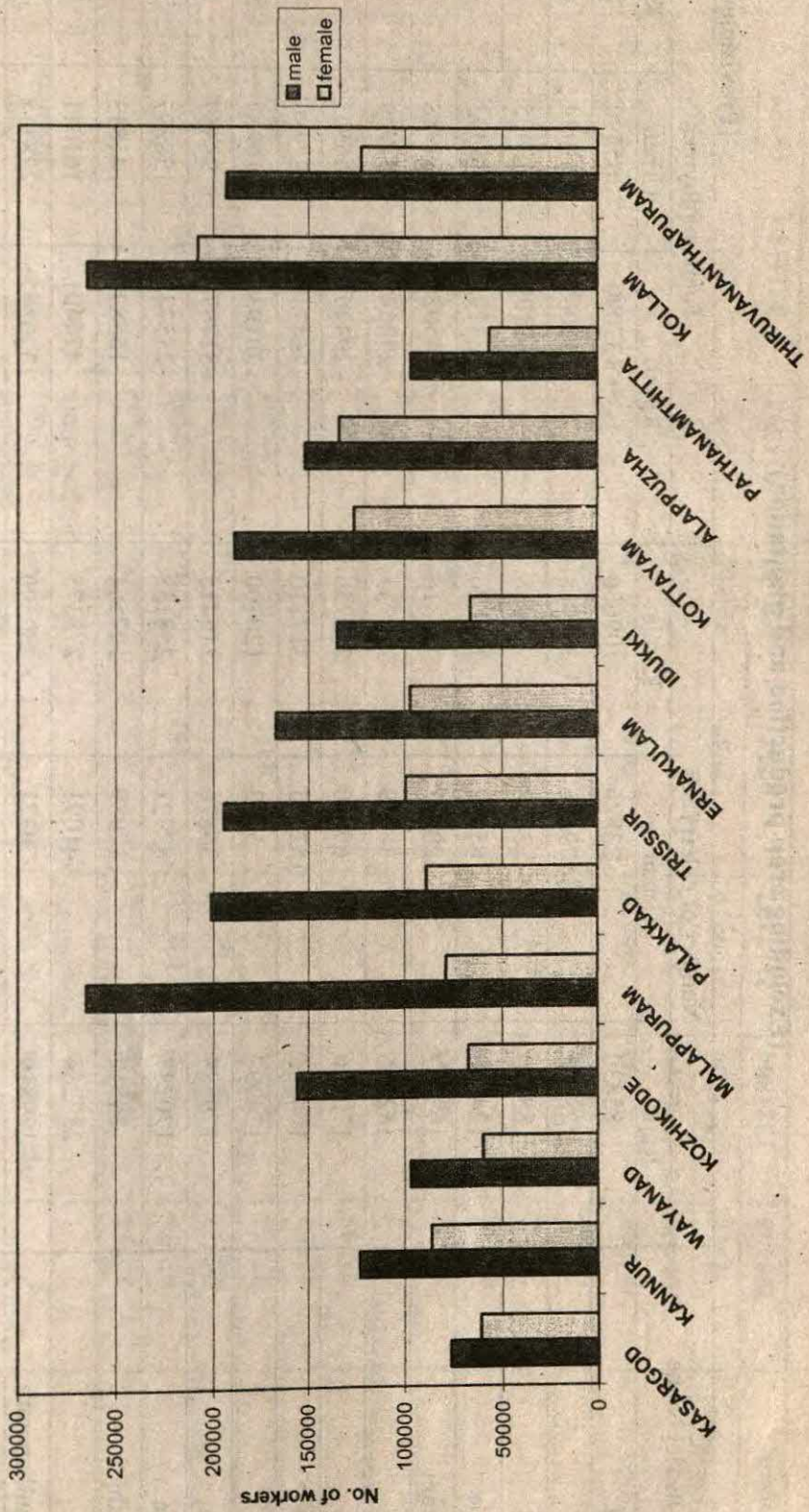
### Percentage share of non agricultural enterprises
