




PREFACE

The collection of prices is one of the major items of work undertaken by the Department of Economics and Statistics. The importance and usefulness of the information pertaining to the price movements has much significance in the context of a growing economy. This Department has been collecting different types of prices viz. Farm price, Market price, etc. (both Wholesale and Retail). These prices are being widely used for various purposes such as Preparation of Indices, to provide compensation of Farmer's and for tendering consumable articles for Govt. Firms. Among the Retail prices, the one which is being collected on daily basis from District Headquarters assumes significance, because the prices of 50 essential commodities are being forwarded to the Chief Minister's office and Ministry of Food and Civil Supplies daily. In addition to the daily prices, weekly prices of 20 items are also being collected on every Friday.

From January 2004 onwards a publication titled "PRICE BULLETIN" is being prepared and published monthly incorporating the Retail prices of main essential commodities from 50 items schedule (daily) and 20 items schedule (weekly) under 8 major groups. Groupwise analysis has been made with reference to current month, previous month and corresponding month of the previous year with suitable pictorial representation.

This publication is being prepared and published by Price Division under the supervision of Shri. D. Rajan, Additional Director (Prices). The report is drafted with the guidance of Shri. B. Sreekumar, Assistant Director (Prices). I appreciate the work done by Shri. V.K.Sreejan (Research Officer), Shri. K. Soman Nadar (Research Assistant), Smt.UshaKumari Kecheriyil (L.D.Compiler) and Shri. S.Krishna Kumar (L.D.Compiler) for preparing such a worthy publication and Shri. S. Saseendran (U.D.Typist) for doing DTP works in connection with this publication.

REVIEW ON RETAIL PRICES OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES APRIL-2004

During the month it is seen that the price variation is more on the upward direction when compared with the figures of previous month and that of the corresponding month in the previous year. Group Wise comparisons of commodities with suitable graphs are given below.





Compared to last month a positive trend is seen in the prices of Pulses for the month. Only two commodities moves downward direction, rest fluctuates between 0.04% to 3.97%. But compared to previous year a negative trend is seen. The prices of Redgram and Greengram dhall are down by more than 10%. Graph 2 represents the changes of prices in the Pulses group.


% VARIATION OF PULSES





A mixed trend is displayed in both form of comparison. For comparison with last month, price of Onion small is increased by more than 30% But compared to last year the prices of Corriandar and Chillies dry are down by 20.43% and 20.10% respectively and the price of Tamarind is up by 22.66%. 

Compared to last month price of Tapioca raw slightly moves in the negative side, while all other commodities have high fluctuation in the positive direction. Prices of potato, Chenai, and Colocassia are increased by 27.57%, 18.99% and 10.08% respectively. But compared to last year a negative trend is seen except for Colocassia. %VARIATION OF TUBERS



In the Vegetable group, prices of all commodities except Onion big are moving in the upward direction when compared to last month. Among this the percentage change of six commodities are over 10%. 

Compared to last month price of most of the commodity remains unchanged, only slight positive variation is seen for the remaining commodities. But comparing last year a slight mixed fluctuation is seen. The price of Tobacco and Colgate are down by 10.77% and 15.65% respectively while the price of Razor blade is up by 10.62%.
