





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Season and Crop Report of Kerala 1995-96, 1996-97 & 1997-98

1.1 Introduction

Kerala is one of the smallest states of Indian Union. With a geographical area of 38863 Sq.Km. which forms only 1.18% of the total area of the country. The state lies at the southwest corner of the Indian Peninsula, between 8°-18' and 12°-48' north latitude 74°-52' and 77°-22' East longitudes. It is bounded by Karnataka state on the north, Tamilnadu on the east and south the Arabian sea on the west. The western ghats comprising the high altitude mountain tracts act as a boundary wall on the eastern side. The state is blessed with a long coastal line of 580 KM in length. The width of this narrow strip of land called Kerala varies from 130 Km in the middle to 32 KM in the extremities.

1.2 Topography

The topography of the state is a particular one. From the forest had high altitude mountains terrains of the Sahya mountains, the land mass undulates to the golden shores of the Arabian sea presenting a series of hills and valleys. Because of this nature of the terrian and heavy rainfall numerous rivers and rivalets flow west wards until they empty into the Arabian sea. The land on the west coast is more or less flat and is adorned by numerous lakes and lagoons. Because of these diverse characteristics of the land and consequent changes in plant growth the state is well marked into three district regions viz., the high land, midland and the lowland.

The highland is classified as the region that lies 250 feet above mean sea level comprising an area of about 18653 Sq.Km. This region comprises the ghat, forest and most of the reserve forests. Many prestigious varieties of trees like sandalwood, rose wood, teak, mahagani, etc. and a numerous other varieties of hard and soft wood trees also grow in this region. Most of the reserve forests of the State are located here. The highest peak in South India viz., the 'Anamudi' is situated on the border of the State. The periyar lake from which the river Periyar orginates is also located here. Rainfall is very high in this region compared to other regions. This region is highly suitable for the cultivation of plantation crops like Tea, Coffee, Cardamom and rubber.

The middle land region lies between 25' and 250' above mean sea level with an area of 16231 Sq.Km is famous for its diverse crops, while rice is grown in valleys, coconut, arecanut, rubber, pepper and tapioca are grown in the slopes of the hills. Thus major and minor crops are cultivated inter mixed with one another.

The low land lies up to 25' above mean seal level on the west coast and comprises an area of 3979 Sq.Km. The lowland region is monopolised by paddy and coconut. Fishing is a major avocation of this people of this region.

Paddy, coconut, arecanut, pepper, rubber, tapioca, banana and plantain are the important crops cultivated. Paddy being a seasonal crop and the main staple food of Kerala is cultivated in three seasons viz., Autumn (virippu) Winter (mundakan) and Summer (puncha). Autumn crops are mainly rainfed while winter crops are raised as a single crop originally on water logged areas on reclaimed lagoon lands by de-watering during summer. The other important seasonal crops are pulses, ragi, seasamum, sugarcane, tapioca, groundnut, ginger, turmeric, etc.

The high cost of cultivation and comparatively low return had adversely affected both area and production of paddy. Since the rice produced in the State is less than half of the requirements. The state has to depend on other neighbouring states for its food needs. There are also seasonal floods and draughts to which cause damage crops.

1.3 Administrative regions

For administrative purposes the state is divided in to 14 districts viz. Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Pathanamthitta, Alappuzha, Kottayam, Idukki, Eranakulam, Thrissur, Palakkad, Malappuram, Kozhikode, Wayanad, Kannur and Kasaragod. Each district are again divided into taluks and villages as Revenue administrative units Panchayats and Blocks and in rural and Municipalities and Corporations in urban development units. The district wise distribution of area according to village records is given in the following table.

1.4 Rural Development

The state is delimited into 152 Blocks for alround development of the rural areas. The important programmes implemented by these blocks are Integrated Rural Development Programmes (ITDP), Training of Youths for Self-Employment (TRYSEM) and the Rural Landless Employment Guarantee Programe (RLEG). Besides these various schemes under the poverty amelioration programmes better known as 20 point programmes are also implemented in these blocks.

1.5 Local Self Government

Panchayat in rural areas and Municipalities and Corporations in urban areas are the units of local Self-Government in the State. At present there are 990 Panchayats 55 Municipalities and 3 Corporations in the State which administered by the elected representatives of local people.

1.6 Climate

The state is blessed with a moderate climate. Since the State is a narrow strip of land that lies between high attitude mountains and the sea extreme climates are not experienced in the State.

1.7 Rainfall

The State receives copious rains from the south, west and the north east monsoon winds blowing over the State. The southwest monsoon starts from the beginning of June and extends up to September. The northeast monsoon spell is from October to December. Isolated off seasonal showers do also occur during the remaining months of the year.

1.8 Temperature

The average temperature of the State varies between 21°C and 32°C. But the temperature recorded at Palakkad and Punalur had always been higher than those recorded at other places during

summer. This is because the hot summer winds blowing over the Decan Plateau escapes into these places through the gaps at Palakkad and Aryancavu respectively in the Sahya mountains.

1.9 Soils

The different types of soil found in various parts of the state are classified as follows:-

- 1) The hilly and forest soil seen all along the eastern part of the state.
- 2) The sandy soil seen in the coastal belt.
- 3) The laterite soil seen in the midland.
- 4) The black soil seen in patches on the eastern border of Palakkad District.
- 5) The peat or Kari soil seen in Alappuzha.
- 6) The alluvial soil seen along the Southern and Eastern parts of Vembanad Lake and in small patches in Thiruvananthapuram District.
- 7) The red soil found on the eastern tip of Thiruvananthapuram District.

1.10 Minerals

The state is not rich in mineral wealth. Basic minerals like coal, iron, ore etc. and petroleum are conspicuous by their absence. Consequently the state is industrially backward among the Indian states. But rare mineral sands like ilmenite, rutile, monazite, zircon and silliminite are mined from the coastal line. Minor mineral like white quartz sand, fire clay, ball clay, lime shell and china clay are also mined in the state.

1.11 Crop and crop season

The major crops grown in the state are food crops like paddy, pulses, tubers and topioca.

2.0 Land Utilization.

The land utilization particular of the state for the year 1995-96 to 1997.98 are furnished in the table 2.1 of the summary table and table 3.5,3.6 and 3.7 of the part III. The total area of the state referred to in various tables according to the village papers while slightly differ from that under professional survey.

The district wise area under various land users are discussed in the following paragraph. Fruits like plantain, banana, Mango, Jack and cashew, spices like pepper, ginger, cardamom and arecanut, Oil seeds like coconut, groundnut and gingelly and plantation crops like tea, coffee, rubber and cocoa.

The periods of sowing of various crops are mainly in the rainy seasons. Autumn, Winter and Summer are the seasons for paddy, the staple food of the people of Kerala. But most of the seasonal crops (rainfed) are sown well before south west monsoon set in the state.

Unlike other parts of India perennial crops dominate the agricultural sector of the state. Intensive mixed cropping of the perennials and seasonal on dry land is the general pattern of cultivation of the people of Kerala.

2.1 Forest

27.83% of total geographical area is covered with forest. In the district of Pathanamthitta and Idukki 50% or above geographical areas of the districts are under forest. Where very smallest area of forest is in Kasaragode district and no forest in Alappuzha district.

2.2 Land put to non-agricultural uses

Land put to non-agricultural uses was estimated as 313131 hectares 317871 hectares and 320307 hectares during 95-96,96-97 and 97-98 respectively which forms 8.06%, 8.18% and 8.24% respectively to the whole geographical area. From the following table it can be seen that land put to non-agricultural uses is large in Alappuzha district followed by Ernakulam district and less in Idukki district. By analysing the given table it can be seen that only a small portion of area is used for non-agricultural purposes in Idukki.

2.3 Barren and uncultivable land

Area under barren and uncultivable land for 95-96, 96-97 and 97-98 are 43154 hectares, 14030 hectares and 38934 hectares respectively which forms 1.11%, 1.06% and 1% of the geographical area of the state during 95-96, 96-97 and 97-98 respectively. It is greater in Kasaragod district and less in Alappuzha districts. By comparing the area of barren and uncultivable land for some years it shows a decreasing tendency.

2.4 Permanent pastures and grazing land

The estimated area under permanent pastures and grazing of land is 1170 hectares, 931 hectares and 825 hectares respectively during 95-96, 96-97 and 97-98. Which forms 0.0.3%, 0.02% and 0.02% of the geographical area of the state. Area under this category is greater in Idukki district

2.5 Land under miscellaneous tree crops

Estimated area under miscellaneous tree crops during 95-96, 96-97 and 97-98 were 26852 hectares 23256 hectares and 22028 hectares respectively.

2.6. Cultivable Waste land

This includes lands available for cultivation whether not taken for cultivation or abandoned after a few years for one or other reason. Land once cultivated but remaining uncultivated for five years or more in succession shall also be included in this category. The district wise distribution of cultivable wasteland is given below.

By analyzing the above table the estimated cultivable wasteland during 95-96, 96-97 and 97-98 were 74382 hectares, 67413 hectares and 65072 hectares respectively. Cultivable wasteland is more in Kasaragod district and less in Pathanamthitta district with respect to the geographical area of each district. It can be seen that the total cultivable wasteland area shows a decreasing tendency.

2.7 Fallow other than current fallow

The estimated area of fallow other than current fallow during 1995-96, 96-97 and 97-98 were 29143 hectares, 29342 hectares and 27730 hectares respectively. It is about 0.75%, 0.75% and 0.71% of the total geographical area of the state during 95-96, 96-97 and 97-98 respectively. Palakkad district accounted for the highest area under this category and lowest in Thiruvananthapuram district.

2.8 Current fallow

Cropped areas which are kept fallow during current year is current fallow. If any seeding area is not cropped again in the same year it may be treated as current fallow.

The district wise distribution of area under current fallow is given below:

Area under current fallow during 96-97 and 97-98 are estimated as 55532 hectares and 58499 hectares respectively against 51314 hectares during 95-96. Current fallow is higher more in Alappuzha district during 95-96, 96-97 and 97-98 with respect to the geographical area of the district. The larger portion of the area under current fallow is in Palakkad district when the state is considered and the same is less in Thiruvananthapuram district.

2.9 Net area sown

The net area sown during 95-96, 96-97 and 97-98 were 2264842 hectares, 2268613 hectares and 2270593 hectares respectively. About 58% of the geographical area of the state come under this category. Kottayam, Eranakulam, Alappuzha, Kasaragod, Kozhikode, Kannur, Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Malappuram, Wayanad, Thrissur, Palakkad, Idukki, Pathanamthitta are the districts in descending order of net area with respect to the geographical area of corresponding districts. Within the total net area in the state most portion is in Kannur during 95-96 in Idukki during 96-97 and Palakkad during 97-98 and less in Pathanamthitta during these three years with respect to the total area under this category in the state.

2.10 Area sown more than once

The estimated area under the category Area sown more than once were 802383 hectares 752611 hectares and 698409 hectares for 1995-96, 96-97 and 97-98 respectively, which is 20.65%, 19.37% and 17.97% to the total geographical area of the state. Area sown more than once is greater in Alappuzha district and less in Idukki district during 1995-96 with respect to the area of the district. The same is greater in Wayanad district and less in Kasaragod district during 1996-97 and 1997-98.

2.11 Total Cropped Area

Total cropped area is the sum of net area sown and the area sown more than once. The same for the entire state is estimated as 3067225,3021224, and 2969002 hectares respectively during 95-96,96 - 97 and 97-98. The district wise distribution of total cropped area is given in the following table.

Most portion of the total cropped area is in Palakkad district and less in Pathanamthitta district. As compared to the geographical area of the district, larger cropped area is in Alappuzha district followed by Kottayam district and less in Pathanamthitta district.

3.0 Area under Crops

3.1 Classification of area under crops according to seasonal annual and perennial crops

Crops are classified as seasonal, annual or perennial according to the duration of each crop. Crop which are harvested during the period of four months in this season are defined as the seasonal crops of the respective season. The crops which have a duration of more than one season and less than one year are called annual crops and crops standing for more than an year will be treated as perennial crops. The district wise distribution of area under crops classified in to seasonal, annual and perennial is furnished in the table given below.

4.5 Parity Index

The index of parity measures the variation in the economic prosperity of the farmer in relation to changing farm prices, farm cultivation cost and domestic expenditure as compared to the position in the base period. This is defined as the ratio of the index of prices received and the index of prices paid by farmers expressed as a percentage.

The index of prices received by farmers is a measure of relative changes in respect of a farmer from important agricultural products as a result of changes in farm prices. The changes are measured based in the prices prevailed in the base year 1952-53. The weighted average of the price relative of the current farm prices to those of the base year is defined as the index of prices received. For the construction of the index the following crops are considered.

- 1) Paddy, (2) Coconut, (3) Arecanut, (4) Cashew nut, (5) Tapioca (6) Ginger (7) Pepper (8) Banana (9) Sugar cane.

The index number of the prices paid by the farmer for farm cultivation cost and domestic consumption as a result of changes in wage rates, cost of implements, cost of manure, cost of maintenance of the live stock and prices of consumer goods as compared to the situation in the base year.
