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PREFACE

Wage structure survey is designed to study the fluctuations in the wage rates in trade, commerce and construction sectors. The wage rates of different categories of workers such as skilled and unskilled men and women are collected for each quarter of the year to study their impact in the economy. Since construction is a major economic activity in the state, the study of the wage trends of the workers engaged in this sector is of paramount importance. In trade and commerce sector, the wage rates of workers engaged in wholesale and retail trade are collected as per National Industrial Classification. The study of the wage rates in different sectors of the economy is very useful for the formulation of policies.

This report is the fifth in the series on wage structure survey. It presents details of wage rates in the construction, trade and commerce sectors for the period from 1982-92. An inter-sectoral comparison of wage rates between agriculture, construction, trade and commerce sectors is also given.

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REPORT ON WAGE STRUCTURE SURVEY

(1982-92)

INTRODUCTION

The wage structure survey was started in 1963-64 by the Department of Economics and Statistics and is being continued on a regular basis. The survey aims at studying the trend in the wage rates of the workers both skilled and unskilled in the construction sector and the paid employees in the trade and commerce sector over the years.

The wage structure survey for the period 1982-92 was also conducted as a sample survey. It covered the entire State. The stratified sampling technique was followed for the conduct of the survey with districts as the strata. The Corporation/Municipalities selected in the urban area and the Panchayats in the rural areas were the first stage sampling units. The construction units and the shops chosen from the selected Corporation/Municipal Wards and the Panchayats formed, the ultimate sampling units for the survey.

Fresh samples were selected at the beginning of the survey for the collection of the wage details. The urban as well as rural samples selected are proposed to be retained for the 5 years period of survey from 1982-83 and 1987-88. The first stage sampling units were selected at the Directorate by using random sampling technique. In the urban area all the district headquarters and one more Municipality from each district were selected using simple random method. Three Panchayats each were selected in the rural area. The wards and the ultimate sampling units were selected in the district offices concerned.

The construction units for the urban and rural samples were fixed as 5 and 3 respectively. Accordingly from 10 construction units in the urban area and 9 units in the rural area in a district, were selected and the daily wages of building labour were collected. In the case of trade and commerce sector, with an intention to cover the entire trading activities 2 shops each from the Corporation/Municipal Wards and the Panchayats in the following 10 categories of trading activity according to N.I.C. 1970 were selected.

SECTION II

Objectives.— The main objective of the survey is to study the trend in wages in the construction, trade and commerce sectors in the various districts of the state.

Construction Sector

The wage rates of both skilled and unskilled workers relating to this sector are collected for the survey. In certain cases the wage details of skilled workers like painters, plumbers, sawyers and electrical wireman could not be collected, from the selected samples since such items of work were not undertaken at the time of the survey. In such cases, the rate prevailing in the centres concerned have been collected. Now-a-days traditional sawyers are only rarely depended on for construction work and hence it is difficult to collect this wages from some of the selected centres. In such cases the prevailing wage rates of the sawyers in the Saw Mills in the centres concerned have been collected and analysed. Tables 1 and 2 show the trend in the wage rates of the workers (skilled and unskilled) in the construction sector during the period 1982-83 to 1991-92.

The wages of both the skilled and unskilled workers indicate that the rates were increasing steadily and continuously. There was not much difference in the wages of the carpenter and mason both in the urban and the rural areas for the ten years (i.e. from 1982-83 to 1991-92). During the period under report, the urban wages of all the skilled and unskilled workers engaged in the construction activities were relatively higher than their real wages.

Wage Indices

A comparison of wage indices of labours engaged in the construction sector will be useful for the Planners and Administrators to ascertain the trend in the wage rates and the wage differentials in respect of different types of labour. The wage indices of both the skilled and unskilled workers in the construction sector is worked out taking 1977-78 as the base year and is represented in Table 3 to 5.

The above tables shows that there is a significant rise in the wage indices of the unskilled construction workers both in the urban and rural areas during the period under report.

Trade and Commerce Sector

As an improvement over the earlier rounds, this round of the survey has covered all the trading activities as per the N.I.C. 1970. Accordingly the wage details of the paid employees engaged in the ten selected groups of trading activity have been collected.

Tables 6 and 7 present a picture of the wage rates of the Shop Assistants and the Shop Attenders for the period 1982-92 in the wholesale trade and retail trade in the urban sector. It is seen that both the Shop Assistants and Shop Attenders employed in the wholesale shops, trading in all types of machinery equipments including transport and electrical equipments were paid maximum wage rate in all the ten years of the present report.

The average wage rate for the Shop Assistant for the period 1982-87 in the wholesale shops ranged from Rs. 476 to Rs. 669 while in the case of Shop Attenders it ranged from Rs. 387 to Rs. 498.

As regards the retail shops in urban areas the wage rate of the Shop Assistants for the period 1982-87 were maximum in textile trade and minimum in the trade of others like medical stores, book, stationery, building materials, transport equipments, petrol etc. The shop attenders employed in the Restaurants and Hotels are seen paid highest wage rate as far as the urban retail shops are concerned.

During the period 1987-92 the average wage rate for the Shop Assistants in the urban wholesale shops ranged from Rs. 887 to Rs. 1170. While in the case of Shop Attenders it ranged from Rs. 725 to Rs. 838. In the case of retail shops in towns, the wage rates for the Shop Assistants were maximum in the restaurants and hotels and minimum in the trade of food and food articles in Table 8.

With respect to the coverage of the data on the wages of the Shop Assistants in the retail shops in the Panchayat area it may be pointed out that the availability of such category of employees in the majority of the selected trade groups in the district was inadequate. The Shop Assistants had the maximum wage rates in the retail shops trading in textiles and minimum wage rates in fuel and other household utilities trading in the rural sector during the period under report. The Shop Attender employed in the restaurants and hotels in the rural sector are seen paid the maximum wage rate.

SECTION III INTER - SECTORAL COMPARISON

The trend in the wage rates in the Construction Sector and the trade and commerce sectors was explained in the forgoing paragraphs. In this context, the inter-sectoral comparison of the wage rates will also be of much use. The workers under the various sectors like industry, agriculture are paid wages on the basis of the legislations enacted. The payment of Wages Act and the Minimum Wages Act are the two among such legislations which may prevent the exploitation of the wage earners. Though there is no legislation at present to fix the wage rate for the construction sector, the wages paid to such workers are relatively high in Table 9.

The wage rates of the workers engaged in the three different sectors for the 10 years beginning from 1982-92 were compared in the above table. In the first 2 years of the period under review the wage rates of both skilled and unskilled workers higher in the construction sector than in agricultural sector. But the wage rates paid to both the skilled (Carpenter and Mason) and unskilled workers (Men) in the construction and agricultural sectors during the year 1984-85 were more or less same. During the period 1985-86 and 1986-87 the wage rates prevailing in agriculture sector was slightly higher than that in the construction sector. Thereafter the wages in the construction sector increased in Table 10 to 12.

The district-wise comparison of the wage rates of the workers in the agricultural and construction sectors is shown in Table 10 to 12. Both in the case of urban and rural, the average wage rate for the year 1991-92 in respect of the Carpenters and Masons in the Construction Sector was higher in Idukki district while in agricultural Sectors, the wage was maximum in Kottayam District.

SECTION IV

WAGES AND COST OF LIVING INDICES

The inter-relationship between the wages of the workers and the prices of consumer goods is worth mentioning in this context. The rapid rise in the prices of goods and services leads to the demand for the increase in wages by the workers for the purpose of adjusting themselves to the rise in cost of living. In this context it may be noted that there is relationship between the real wages, money wages and cost of living.

Deflated Money Wages

Table 13 and 14 shows the money wages and the estimated real wages of both the skilled and the unskilled workers in the construction sectors for the period 1982-92. The real wages are estimated using the formula

$$R = \frac{M}{C} \times 100$$

Where R = Real Wages

M = Money Wages

C = Cost of living Index

From the above tables it is revealed that there were fluctuations in the estimated real wages of the workers during the period 1982-92. The periods 1990-91 and 1991-92 marked a slight decline in the real wages of both the skilled and unskilled workers in Tables 15 (A) and 15 (B).

As regards the retail shops in urban, the real wage rate of the Shop Assistant for the period 1991-92 were maximum in textile trade and minimum in the trade of others. The Shop Attenders had the maximum real wage rate in retail shop trading in restaurant and hotels while minimum in the trade of others in Table 16 - 18.

Table 16 – 19 represent the index of wage rate of Shop Assistant and the Shop Attender. Both in the Urban and Rural Sector in field of Trade and Commerce Sector for the period from 1982-92.
